



# Extra Benefits

A student-athlete (or his/her friends or relatives) may not receive any benefit and/or arrangement that is not also available to the general student body

## **Impermissible benefits include but are not limited to:**

- Money, loans, bond, or co-signing of loans
- Free transportation (use of a car, airline tickets, bus tickets, etc.)
- Free storage
- Free merchandise (clothes, tattoos, video games, etc.)
- Free Entertainment (sporting events, movies, concerts, etc.)
- Free meals
- Discounted merchandise because of status
- Free use of a credit card, calling card, etc.
- Free use of the athletic department copy machine, fax, mail, etc.
- Selling KU equipment and apparel for cash or free/reduced services

Accepting benefits of any kind will jeopardize your intercollegiate athletics eligibility.

**Red Flag:** Being offered anything at a reduced rate that is not available to the general public.



# Autographs, Memorabilia & Awards

- Try to personalize autographs (ask for names while signing or prior to signing)
- You may not sell or trade any of your KU memorabilia
  - Includes all gear and equipment
- You may not sell or trade any awards provided by KU, Big 12 or NCAA
  - Blankets, framed jerseys, championship rings, etc.
