

and a 74-yarder by Coan, hoisted Kansas out of a 7-0 halftime lead and set the stage for a championship battle with unbeaten Missouri a week hence. These two runs mounted a 21-0 lead and the second and third units sent Fullback Norm Mailen in twice to climax 27 and 70-yard advances against a Buffalo unit which was missing seven regulars because of injury. KU's rushing offense reached a new Mitchell-era high of 352 net yards, while the Jayhawker's mobile line was limiting CU to 67 yards overland and holding the Herd outside the Kansas 29 until quarterback Gale Weidner stirred up a passing storm in the final minutes. Kansas nailed its 7-0 halftime lead largely through a pass interference penalty at the one when Halfback Ed Coleman shoved Andy Graham as he chased an overthrown John Hadl flip. Fullback Jim Jarrett rammed home on the first punch Smith and Coan broke the dam on KU's first two possessions of the second half. Weidner marshaled CU 70 yards for its lone score, passing 34 yards to End Gary Henson 1:52 before the final gun. In December Kansas was ordered to forfeit this victory by the Big Eight after it found the Jayhawkers guilty of recruiting violations in the transfer of Bert Coan from TCU to Lawrence.

**Kansas 23, Missouri 7
 (Official score: KU 0, MU 1)**

Kansas finally caught up with the nation's No. 1-ranked football team, in this case, arch-rival Missouri, stunning the

unbeaten, untied Tigers 23-7, November 20, before the biggest throng ever to watch America's fifth-oldest grid rivalry, 43,000 in Columbia. The Jayhawkers did it with an astounding defense that reduced MU's vaunted power sweeps to 61 rushing yards and held it without a first down through the first 40 minutes of play. By then, Kansas was sailing on a 10-0 lead, erected by Roger Hill's 46-yard field goal and a 19-yard John Hadl to Bert Coan pass. Hill's cross-country boot, just one yard off the Big Eight record, broke a 0-0 halftime tie which had seen each team fumble away opportunities. The Jayhawkers rumbled 69 yards for their third score, Coan setting it up with a 37-yard sweep, and scoring from the two on a dive. Missouri followed with its touch-down, as Halfback Mel West hauled the kickoff 54 yards to KU's 36. A pair of passes from quarterback Ron Taylor accounted for most of the ensuing yardage, the sawed-off signal-caller flipping 17 yards to West out of a fourth and 14 situation for the counter. This came with 5:24 left, but Kansas had one more shot in the gun-barrel. Fullback Doyle Schick picked off a Taylor pass at the MU 23 to set the stage. Six plays later, McFarland jump-passed to End Sam Simpson, just :37 before the finish. Immediately after the game Missouri was tendered, and accepted a bid to the Orange bowl, since Kansas, on NCAA probation, could not accept. For a month the Jayhawkers enjoyed their first undisputed league football crown since 1930. Then Kansas was ordered by the Big Eight to forfeit this game, and the Colorado game, after the conference found Kansas guilty of illegal recruiting of Bert Coan, who played in both contests following the NCAA probationary ruling. Thus the Tigers ascended to the league throne, Colorado mounted second and Kansas dropped to third in the final official standings.
