THE STARTING FIVE

1. Series History

MSU leads the all-time series against Kansas, 7-6, including a 2-0 record in the Champions Classic ... The last meeting between the teams was a 92-70 Kansas win in the second round of the 2017 NCAA Tournament ... The teams played in the 2015 Champions Classic in Chicago with MSU edging out KU, 79-73, behind a triple-double from Denzel Valentine (29 points, 12 rebounds, 12 assists).

2. The Last Meeting

After a dominating Spartan win over Miami in the opening round of the 2017 NCAA Tournament, Kansas ended MSU's season with a 92-70 win in the second round ... Then-freshman Miles Bridges scored 22 points to lead the Spartans, while current MSU juniors Nick Ward and Joshua Langford added 13 points and 10 points, respectively.

3. Champions Classic

Michigan State is 3-4 all-time in the Champions Classic ... The Spartans, ranked No. 2 in the country entering the 2017-18 season, lost to then-No. 1 Duke, 88-81, in last year's Champions Classic at United Center in Chicago ... In 2016-17, Michigan State, then No. 13 in the country, lost to No. 2 Kentucky, 69-48, at Madison Square Garden in New York City ... Kenny Goins and Cassius Winston led the Spartans with nine points each ... In 2015, Denzel Valentine put on a dazzling display with 29 points, 12 rebounds and 12 assists as No. 13 MSU defeated No. 4 Kansas, 79-73 ... In 2014, No. 19 MSU fell to No. 4 Duke, 81-71, as Branden Dawson paced the Spartans with 18 points and nine rebounds, while the Blue Devils shot 54.0 percent from the field ... In 2013, No. 2 MSU defeated No. 1 Kentucky, 78-74, in Chicago, behind 22 points, eight assists and eight rebounds from Keith Appling, and 20 points from Gary Harris ... The Spartans defeated No. 7 Kansas, 67-64, in 2012 in Atlanta behind 19 points from Appling and 18 points from Harris ... In the inaugural classic, No. 6 Duke defeated MSU, 74-69, in New York's Madison Square Garden. Appling led MSU with 22 points ... Kentucky has a 4-3 record in the Champions Classic, Duke is 4-3 & Kansas is 3-4.

4. MSU No. 10 in Preseason Polls

Michigan State's men's basketball team is ranked No. 10 in the country in the Associated Press Preseason poll and the USA Today Coaches poll ... The Spartans, who finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 5 in the AP poll, received 1,024 total points ... This is the seventh-straight year the Spartans have opened a season ranked among the preseason top-25 and the 11th time in the last 12 years ... Under Head Coach Tom Izzo, Michigan State has been ranked in the preseason 19 times.

5. Ward, Winston Named to Preseason All-Big Ten Team

Michigan State juniors Nick Ward and Cassius Winston were selected to the Preseason All-Big Ten Team at the league's media day on October 11 ... Ward and Winston were among 10 players selected to the all-league team and Michigan State was one of only two schools with multiple players selected ... This is the second-straight year that Ward has been named to the Preseason All-B1G team.





ABOUT KANSAS

Kansas enters the 2018-19 season as the No. 1 team in the country in both the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls ... Kansas returns two starters and six letterwinners from the squad that claimed the Jayhawks' 14th-consecutive Big 12 regular-season title, the Big 12 Championship title and advanced to school's 15th Final Four ... Junior center Udoka Azubuike is KU's leading returning scorer (13.0 ppg) and rebounder (7.0) ... Lagerald Vick is the lone senior on the KU roster and averaged 12.1 ppg last season ... Junior forward Dedric Lawson was one of six listed on the Associated Press Preseason All-America Team. Lawson is also the Preseason Big 12 Newcomer of the Year and is on the preseason All-Big 12 First Team ... Azubuike was an honorable mention preseason all-conference member, while Quentin Grimes was the Preseason Big 12 Freshman of the Year and honorable mention all-league.

AGAINST KANSAS

MSU leads the all-time series against Kansas, 7-6, including a 2-0 mark in the Champions Classic ... The teams have met four times in the last six seasons, with Michigan State winning two of those meetings ... Kansas won the last meeting, 92-70, during the 2017 NCAA Tournament ... The last time the teams played in the Champions Classic, at the start of the 2015-16 season in Chicago, Denzel Valentine recorded a triple-double with 29 points, 12 rebounds and 12 assists in a 79-73 MSU win ... MSU has a 4-3 advantage over KU in games played at neutral sites.

WHAT'S BACK

MSU returns 59.4 percent of its scoring from last season, including three of its top five scorers and six of its top nine ... The Spartans also return nearly 60 percent of its rebounding and assists ... Seven returning players have combined for 188 starts, including 156 starts from juniors Joshua Langford, Nick Ward and Cassius Winston.

FOR OPENERS

Michigan State is 94-25 all-time in openers, winning 37 of the last 41 ... The only four losses in the last 41 years came in 2012 to Connecticut in the Armed Forces Classic in Germany, to No. 1 North Carolina in the 2011 Carrier Classic, on the deck of the USS Carl Vinson in Coronado, Calif., in November 2005, when MSU fell at Hawai'i, 84-62, and in November 2016, a 65-63 loss to Arizona in the Armed Forces Classic in Hawaii ... Prior to that, the Spartans' last loss in an opener came on Nov. 29, 1976, when they fell to Central Michigan, 81-76 ... Tom Izzo is 19-4 in season openers.

MSU IN NOVEMBER

Michigan State has an all-time record of 131-36 in games played in the month of November ... This includes an 85-3 mark at home ... The last team to beat MSU at home in November was a David Robinson-led Navy squad that bested the Spartans, 91-90, in overtime on Nov. 29, 1986 ... Tom Izzo is 63-0 all-time at home in November, 93-29 for the month ... The Spartans went 5-1 in November last year, beating then-No. 9 North Carolina in the championship game of the PK80 Invitational and returning home on Nov. 30 to beat then-No. 5 Notre Dame, 81-63.



MSU VS. NUMBER ONE

Michigan State is 4-20 all-time against teams ranked No. 1 in The Associated Press Top 25, although the Spartans have won three of their last seven against No. 1 ... MSU defeated No. 1 Indiana State in the 1979 NCAA Championship game, No. 1 Wisconsin on Feb. 20, 2007 in East Lansing, No. 1 Louisville in the 2009 NCAA Elite Eight and, most recently, No. 1 Kentucky on Nov. 12, 2013, in the Champions Classic in Chicago.

WARD, WINSTON NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN TEAM

Michigan State juniors Nick Ward and Cassius Winston were selected to the Preseason All-Big Ten Team at the league's media day on October 11 ... Ward and Winston were among 10 players selected to the all-league team and Michigan State was one of only two schools with multiple players selected ... This is the second-straight year that Ward has been named to the Preseason All-BIG team ... Ward was a Big Ten honorable mention selection by the coaches and a third team honoree by the media last season ... He appeared in all 35 games, starting, 34, and finished third on the team in scoring with 12.4 points and led the team with 7.1 rebounds, adding 1.3 blocks per game in 18.9 minutes ... He led the team with eight double-doubles and has 20 games with double figure scoring ... Winston was an All-Big Ten Third Team honoree last season and was selected to the United States Basketball Writers Association All-District V team ... He finished second on the team in scoring with 12.6 points per game and led the team with 6.8 assists per game and in 3-point field goal percentage, connecting on 49.7 percent of his shots from long distance (75-of-151). Winston led the Big Ten, and was No. 8 in the country, in assists per game.

WARD, WINSTON EARN NATIONAL ACCOLADES

Michigan State juniors Nick Ward and Cassius Winston also earned national accolades ... Ward was selected to the watch list for the 2019 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame today ... He was one of 21 players selected to the watch list, recognizing the nation's top big man ... Winston was named one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2019 Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award ... Named after Class of 1971 Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic and Holy Cross guard Bob Cousy, the annual honor, now in its 16th year, recognizes the top point guards in Division I men's college basketball.

LANGFORD, MCQUAID NAMED CAPTAINS

Junior guard Joshua Langford and senior guard Matt McQuaid were selected as captains for the 2018-19 season, announced by Head Coach Tom Izzo ... The Spartans held their first day of practice for the 2018-19 season on Sept. 27, when Izzo made the announcement ... Langford finished fourth on the team in scoring last year, averaging 11.7 points per game, while adding 3.0 rebounds and 1.5 assists ... He was fourth on the team in 3-point field goals (44) and hit 40.4 percent of his shots ... McQuaid ranked sixth on the team in scoring, averaging 6.0 points off the bench. He started two games, including scoring a career-high 20 points against DePaul last year, and was fifth on the team in minutes played, averaging 20.5 per game ... Langford and McQuaid were the co-recipients of the team's John E. Benington Defensive Player of the Award last year.

SPARTANS CRUISE PAST NORTHERN MICHIGAN IN EXHIBITION

Junior forward Nick Ward scored 24 points and had nine rebounds and junior guard Cassius Winston added 13 points and seven assists as No. 10 Michigan State jumped out to a 30-point halftime lead en route to a 93-47 win over Northern Michigan in an exhibition game at the Breslin Center on Oct. 30 ... Ward and Winston led four players in double figures as junior guard Joshua Langford added 12 points and freshman forward Marcus Bingham Jr. finished with 11 points ... Michigan State went into the break with a 43-13 lead, with Winston (11) and Ward (10) pacing the way ... The Spartans connected on 48.1 percent of their field goals (13-of-27) and scored 20 points in the paint and 25 on fast breaks ... The Spartans out-scored the Wildcats, 22-0 over the next eight minutes and took a 31-7 lead on a 3-pointer from Winston at the 8:05 mark ... MSU took its biggest lead of the half, 31 points (43-12) on a pair of free throws from Ward with two minutes left to play in the half ... The Green & White took their biggest leads, 49 points (85-36) on a layup from sophomore forward Xavier Tillman with 4:04 to play in the game ... Ten different players scored for Michigan State.

MSU PLAYS GONZAGA IN SCRIMMAGE

Michigan State played No. 3 Gonzaga in a closed scrimmage at the Target Center in Minneapolis on Oct. 25 ... The teams played a pair of 20 minute periods and two 5-minute periods ... Junior forward Nick Ward finished with 22 points and 12 rebounds during the combined 20-minute periods, while sophomore forward Xavier Tillman added 16 points and five rebounds, junior guard Cassius Winston added 16 points and eight assists and junior guard Joshua Langford chipped in 11 points, six rebounds and four assists.

BACKCOURT STRENGTH

In the backcourt, the Spartans will look to a trio of players who have combined for 244 games and 115 starts between them ... Junior guard Cassius Winston (6-1, 185) averaged 12.6 points and 6.9 assists in 35 games, with 34 starts ... He was an All-Big Ten Third Team selection last year and in conference play connected on 56.1 percent of his 3-point field goals (37-of-66) ... Winston has appeared in 70 career games with 39 starts ... Junior guard Joshua Langford (6-6, 210) started all 35 games last year and averaged 11.7 points and 3.0 rebounds ... Like Winston, Langford has appeared in 70 career games, but has the most starts returning of any player with 60 ... McQuaid, a co-captain with Langford, is the team's most experienced player with 104 games played (14 starts) ... He was a key reserve last year, averaging 6.0 points and 1.9 rebounds.

SPARTANS SHARE THE BALL

Unselfishness is a trademark of all Tom Izzo teams ... That has been especially true over the last five seasons as MSU established school record for assists during that span ... Last year, MSU led the country in assists per game (19.1) and handed out 670, the second-best mark in program history ... The Spartans recorded an assist on 67.6 percent of their field goals last year ... In 2015-16, MSU tallied a school record 719 assists, good for the 22nd-best total in NCAA history ... MSU's nation's-best assist average of 20.5 was the 23rd-best average in NCAA history ... The Spartans recorded an assist on a nation's-best 71.3 percent of its field goals ... In 2014-15, MSU totaled 646 assists (16.6 apg), after recording 637 (16.8 apg) in 2013-14.

FROM BEYOND THE ARC

The Spartans ranked third in the Big Ten last year, connecting on 290 3-pointers, an average of 8.3 shots from long distance per game ... MSU was second in the Big Ten in 3-point percentage, connecting on 40.0 percent of their shots, and return several threats from beyond the arc in 2018-19 ... Cassius Winston led the Big Ten in 3-point field goal percentage last year, connecting on 49.7 percent of his shots (75-of-151) from long distance, including an outstanding 56.1 percent (37-of-66)

FIVE NEWCOMERS MAKE UP FRESHMAN CLASS

The Spartans welcome five freshmen to the 2018-19 team ... The class includes forwards Marcus Bingham Jr., Gabe Brown, Aaron Henry and Thomas Kithier, as well as guard Foster Loyer ... Bingham was a two-year letterwinner at Grand Rapids Catholic Central ... A starter his last two years and captain as a senior, he was a 2018 Detroit Free Press Class B First Team selection and Detroit News Class B First Team selection ... He averaged 21.0 points, 11.0 rebounds, four blocks and two assists during his senior year ... Brown was a 2018 Detroit News Class A First Team honoree and All-West First Team selection, as well as a 2018 Detroit Free Press Class A First Team selection ... He averaged 18.5 points, 5.7 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.2 blocks to help Belleville reach the Class A regional finals ... Henry was a four-year starter and captain at Ben Davis in Indianapolis ... He was selected to the Supreme 15 by the Indiana Basketball Coaches Association and an Associated Press All-State First Team selection ... He led Ben Davis to a sectional title as a senior while averaging 17.0 points, 8.8 rebounds and four assists per game ... Kithier averaged 21 points, 12 rebounds, five assists and three blocks as a prep junior at Macomb Dakota ... He transferred to Clarkston High School for his senior year and did not play ... Loyer was a four-time All-American and four-time Academic All-American ... He was the recipient of the Michigan Hal Schram Mr. Basketball Award as a senior, averaging 27.0 points, 7.0 assists, four rebounds and three steals while guiding Clarkston to a 26-1 record and a second-straight Class A state title.

AHRENS BACK FROM INJURY

Perhaps a key player for the Spartans this season will be redshirt junior Kyle Ahrens, who missed all of last season with a foot injury ... Head Coach Tom Izzo has been very pleased with the progress of the athletic guard/forward since his return to the floor ... Ahrens is a strong, tough wing player who is a good offensive rebounder ... He started four games in 2016-17 and appeared in 34, averaging 2.6 points and 1.1 rebounds.

THE GRADUATES

The Michigan State roster features two players who have already completed their undergraduate academic requirements in redshirt junior Conner George and redshirt senior Kenny Goins ... George graduated in three years, earning his bachelor's degree in communication ... He is currently pursuing a Master of Arts in education ... Goins, a fifth-year senior, earned his bachelor's degree in advertising management and is pursuing a master's degree in communication.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

In total, the 2018-19 schedule is highlighted by 15 games against teams that appeared in the 2018 postseason, including 11 against 2018 NCAA Tournament teams ... Eight opponents appeared in the 2018 NCAA Tournament, including non-conference opponents Kansas, UCLA, Texas, North Carolina and Florida, as well as conference foes Michigan, Ohio State and Purdue ... Four opponents played in the 2018 National Invitation Tournament, Florida Gulf Coast, Louisville, Nebraska and Penn State.

SPARTANS IN THE NBA

Michigan State had a Big Ten-best seven players on NBA opening day rosters, including Denzel Valentine (Chicago Bulls), Gary Harris (Denver Nuggets), Bryn Forbes (San Antonio Spurs), Draymond Green (Golden State Warriors) and Zach Randolph (Sacramento Kings), along with rookies Miles Bridges (Charlotte Hornets) and Jaren Jackson Jr. (Memphis Grizzlies).

SPARTANS IN THE POLLS

The Michigan State University men's basketball team is ranked No. 10 in the country in the USA Today Coaches' Preseason poll and the Associated Press Preseason poll ... The Spartans received nine first-place votes and had 747 points in the USA Today poll ... In the AP poll, MSU received 13 first-place votes ... MSU is one of four Big Ten teams ranked in both polls, joined by Minnesota (15/15), Northwestern (19/20) and Purdue (20/21) ... The last time MSU was ranked No. 2 in both polls (AP and USA Today) was 2013-14.

COACHING STABILITY

Michigan State has had just two basketball coaches in the last 42 seasons and three in the last 49 ... Tom Izzo is in his 24th season, having taken over from his mentor Jud Heathcote, who

spent 19 years as head coach (1976-95) ... Before Heathcote, Gus Ganakas spent seven seasons as head coach. Ganakas provided commentary on Spartan radio broadcasts for 31 seasons.

Coach Izzo

In his 24th year, Tom Izzo (Northern Michigan, '77) is 574-225 (.718), and 272-122 (.690) in the Big Ten, as the head coach of the Michigan State basketball program. He ranks as the winningest coach in Michigan State history, having passed his mentor Jud Heathcote with his 341st career victory on Nov. 28, 2009. In his 23 seasons as a head coach, Izzo has captured eight National Coach of the Year awards, including the Clair Bee Award in 2005 and NABC honors in 2001 and 2012. In 1999, Izzo was named National Coach of the Year by Basketball Times, while earning similar honors from The Associated Press, Basketball News and the USBWA in '98. He also earned National Coach of the Year accolades from CBSSports.com in 2012. He earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors in 1998, 2009 and 2012. Izzo was enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on September 9, 2016, cementing his status as one of the game's all-time greats.

Among The Big Ten's Best

Tom Izzo's .690 winning percentage in Big Ten games ranks third all-time among league coaches with at least 10 years of service, behind former Wisconsin coach Bo Ryan (.717), and former Indiana coach Bob Knight (.700), and ahead of former Purdue coach Ward Lambert (.685). In all games, Ohio State's Thad Matta ranks first at .748, followed by Ryan (.737), Knight (.734), Izzo (.718), Wisconsin's Walter Meanwell (.712), and Lambert (.709). With 272 conference victories, Izzo ranks second all time.

Izzo Among Best Ever

Through his first 23 seasons, Tom Izzo won 574 games, ranking fifth in college basketball history for most wins by a college coach in his first 23 years.

Final Fours

Tom Izzo led MSU to seven Final Four appearances between 1999 and 2017, becoming just the fourth school in college basketball history to do it in any 17-year span, including just the third since the tournament field expanded to 64 teams in 1985. Izzo's seven Final Fours are the most by any coach since his first season in 1996 and he ranks fifth all-time, including tied for fifth among active coaches. The seven Final Fours are also the most by any Big Ten coach.






