The Marquette University men's basketball team (3-1, 0-0 BIG EAST) heads to the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York, to participate in the NIT Season Tip-Off. The Golden Eagles will open play at 6 p.m. CT against No. 2/2 Kansas (3-0, 0-0 Big 12) on Wednesday, Nov. 21 and ESPN2 will feature the television coverage, with Tom Hart (play-by-play) and Fran Fraschilla (analyst) calling the action. Based on Wednesday's results, MU will face No. 5/5 Tennessee or Louisville on Friday night at 6 or 8 p.m. CT.

MU Making Third Trip To NIT Tip-Off

Marquette is making its third appearance in the NIT Season Tip-Off, which has been played in New York City every year since 1985 and will be hosted by the Barclays Center for the fourth-straight season in 2018.

While it's been almost 20 years since the program was in the event's field, the Golden Eagles did find success in their recent trip to the Barclays Center, winning the title at the 2015 Legends Classic. MU downed No. 22 LSU and Ben Simmons in the semifinals before claiming an overtime win against Arizona State in the title game.

MU fell to No. 6 Duke 87-74 to open the 1990-91 campaign and 10 years later came up short against South Alabama, 67-54, in the 2000-01 season lidlifter.

Kansas Series Includes Memorable Years

While Marquette and Kansas have met on just seven occasions all-time, two of the matchups have come during a pair of Marquette's best season in school history.

The Golden Eagles are 1-6 all-time against Kansas, with the most recent coming in New Orleans in the 2003 Final Four. The No. 6 Jayhawks were able to claim the victory in the final game of Dwyane Wade's collegiate career.

Marquette's lone win over Kansas came in the 1974 national semifinals when No. 3 MU downed No. 6 Kansas, 64-51, in Greensboro, N.C. Marquette fell to NC State in the championship game, but would return in 1977 to claim the national title in Al McGuire's final game as head coach.

The Golden Eagles have met Louisville nearly 70 times and were at one point fellow members of the BIG EAST Conference, Conference USA and others. Marquette has claimed five of the eight all-time matchups with Tennessee, most recently downing the Volunteers in the 2014 Old Spice Classic in Coach Wojciechowski's first season.

Chartouny Helps MU Pull Away From Blue Hose

Entering Saturday's game against Presbyterian, graduate transfer guard Joseph Chartouny had scored a total of just four points over the course of the first three games, all at the free throw line.

The Montreal, Quebec, native scored 13 of his personal-best 16 points in the second half against the Blue Hose, helping key a late run that allowed MU to pull away for the victory. He finished 6-of-7 from the floor, including 3-of-4 from long distance, and also found time to dish out five assists and grab five rebounds in almost 24 minutes of action.

Offense Finds Rhythm Late In Home Win

Through the first 27 minutes of the team's matchup with Presbyterian, Marquette's offensive attack had managed a total of just 37 points and the team trailed 43-37 after a pair of Blue Hose free throws.

Fortunately for MU, over the course of the final 13 minutes the Golden Eagles would outscore Presbyterian 37-12 to pull away for the 19-point victory. Joey Hauser, Joseph Chartouny and Markus Howard knocked down treys on three-straight possessions and Marquette took a lead it wouldn't surrender the rest of the afternoon.

Joey Hauser Making A Name For Himself

While Marquette fans are very familiar with junior forward Sam Hauser and his ability, freshman forward Joey Hauser is quickly making a name for himself with the Blue & Gold faithful.

The Stevens Point, Wisconsin, native has posted impressive numbers in each of the team's outings this year, especially the last two. Against Indiana and Presbyterian, Hauser averaged 15.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game while shooting 13-of-13 from the charity stripe. He netted a personal-best 18 points at Indiana and was a result was rewarded with his first career start on Saturday afternoon.

Dexter Akanno Newest Family Member

Marquette added prep guard Dexter Akanno to the roster for the 2019-20 campaign.

Akanno averaged 15.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists as a senior at Valencia (Calif.) High School in 2017-18. The Vikings advanced to the semifinals of the CIF-SS Division 2A playoffs and Akanno was named All-Santa Clara Valley First Team. He is currently attending prep school at Blair Academy in New Jersey this season.

As a junior, Akanno earned Foothill League Co-Player of the Year accolades after averaging a team-best 13.8 points, 5.2 rebounds and 3.7 assists per game in league play. He helped guide his team to a share of the league title in 2016-17.

2018-19 Features Aggressive Non-League Schedule

Head coach Steve Wojciechowski builds his non-conference schedule to prepare the team for the rigors of BIG EAST play and 2018-19 is no exception.

In non-league play alone, the Golden Eagles will play at least six teams either currently ranked in the *Associated Press* Top-25 poll (including three in the top-15) or receiving votes. Kansas (2/2), Tennessee (5/5), Kansas State (12/12), Buffalo (22/25) and Wisconsin (25/rv) are rated among the nation's best and Indiana is just outside the top-25.

Howard, Hauser One Of Top Returning Trio Duos

In 2017-18, guard Markus Howard (111) and forward Sam Hauser (95) combined to make 206 3-pointers, which was the seventh-best total among collegiate duos.

Courtesy of former guard Andrew Rowsey's 125 treys, Marquette also claimed the first (Rowsey/Howard) and fourth (Rowsey, Hauser) spots on that list.

Along with Howard/Hauser, the only returning tandem with more 3-pointers last season was Wofford's Fletcher Magee and Nathan Hoover (218).

Howard, Hauser Claim Preseason All-League

Junior Markus Howard was selected to the Preseason All-BIG EAST First Team, while classmate Sam Hauser earned second team honors and MU was pegged second (the highest preseason poll position for the Golden Eagles since they were tabbed for first in 2013-14) in the league's annual preseason coaches' poll.

Howard was an All-BIG EAST Second Team selection after averaging 20.4 points and shooting 40.4 percent from 3-point range.

Teammate Sam Hauser was third in the nation in 3-point shooting, making 48.7 percent. The junior forward averaged 14.1 points and 5.7 rebounds.

Newcomers With Unique Paths To Campus

Marquette is expected to receive significant contributions this year from newcomers Brendan Bailey, Joseph Chartouny, Joey Hauser and Ed Morrow and while 2018-19 will mark each of their respective first seasons on the court, that is where the similarity in their respective path to Marquette ends.

Bailey committed to Marquette in November of 2015 and after concluding his high school career he completed a Mormon mission in Washington, D.C. before officially joining the team in the summer of 2018.

Chartouny was developed into an all-conference performer in three seasons at Fordham and has been among the nation's leaders in steals the past two years. He graduated in the spring of 2018 and is enrolled in graduate school at Marquette, where he will work toward his degree while competing his NCAA eligibility.

Hauser, who was going to miss his senior year of basketball due to a foot injury, decided to graduate early from SPASH and enroll at Marquette. He joined the team in January of 2018 to focus on his rehabilitation and utilized a redshirt year.

Morrow spent two seasons at Nebraska and developed into one of the top rebounders in the Big Ten. He decided to transfer after his sophomore year and redshirted in 2017-18 in accordance with NCAA rules.

Howard Member Of NCAA Oversight Committee

Junior guard Markus Howard was named to the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee as a non-voting member during the 2017-18 campaign.

The committee is comprised of coaches and administrators from across the country, including BIG EAST Conference Commissioner Val Ackerman and University of Kansas Head Coach Bill Self. The only other student-athlete in the group is Kevin Vannatta of UNC Asheville.

The Men's Basketball Oversight Committee will ensure that appropriate oversight of men's basketball is maintained, will enhance the development and public perception of the sport and make recommendations related to regular-season and postseason men's basketball. The committee will prioritize enhancement of the student-athlete educational experience (academically and athletically), and in doing so, promote student-athletes' personal growth and leadership development.

Steve Wojciechowski

Head Coach | Fifth Season
Duke, 1998

The 2018-19 campaign will mark the fifth at Marquette University for head coach Steve Wojciechowski, who has enjoyed a wealth of success in collegiate basketball as both a player and a coach.

Wojciechowski (pronounced woe-ju-HOW-skee) was introduced as the program's 17th head coach on April 1, 2014 by Marquette University President Dr. Michael R. Lovell.

From the moment he arrived on campus, Wojciechowski established his "Win Every Day" philosophy as the foundation for the Marquette program. That approach has been extremely successful on the recruiting trail, where the MU staff assembled back-to-back nationally ranked recruiting classes in 2015 and 2016.

The Golden Eagles competed in the postseason for the second-straight year in 2017-18, advancing to the quarterfinals of the National Invitation Tournament (NIT). MU finished with a 21-win season and the roster featured all-conference performers Markus Howard and Andrew Rowsey. Marquette's offensive attack was one of the top performers in the country and among the numerous records to fall was the program's all-time 3-point field goals made mark.

Marquette returned to the NCAA tournament in 2016-17, thanks in large part to one of the most productive offensive attacks in the country. The roster featured a pair of all-conference honorees (Howard and Rowsey) and the campaign was highlighted by the program's first-ever regular season win over the top-ranked team (Villanova).

The Golden Eagles collected a 20-win campaign in 2015-16 under Wojciechowski and advanced to the quarterfinals of the BIG EAST Conference Tournament. The team's on-court success was led by Henry Ellenson, the league's freshman of the year and first-round NBA Draft selection by the Detroit Pistons. Ellenson was the program's first

McDonald's All-America honoree in over 30 years and a top-10 rated prospect.

The Golden Eagles claimed their first win under Wojciechowski in the season opener in 2014-15. The 79-63 win over UT Martin at the BMO Harris Bradley Center was his first as a head coach at the NCAA Division I level. The season also produced wins over Georgia Tech, Tennessee and Arizona State.

Wojciechowski, 42, had previously served as an assistant coach at Duke since the 1999-2000 season and was promoted to associate head coach in the summer of 2008. As a player and coach, he was a part of Duke's winning tradition, serving on the coaching staff for two NCAA tournament champions. During his tenure, the Blue Devils posted an incredible 441-92 record and competed in the NCAA tournament every year.

Wojciechowski also served as court coach and scout for the USA Basketball Men's National Team. He helped lead on-court duties as well as game preparation from 2006-12, including the program's gold-medal performance at the 2008 Beijing Olympics and 2012 London Olympics. The Olympic teams included NBA greats such as Marquette alumnus Dwyane Wade, Kobe Bryant and LeBron James.

Earning national titles

In 2001, in his second year as an assistant at Duke, Wojciechowski and the Blue Devils won the national championship. The team also captured the Atlantic Coast Conference regular season and tournament crowns and posted a 35-4 record.

Wojciechowski saw one of his former teammates and pupils, Shane Battier, earn the consensus National Player of the Year award in 2001 as well as National Defensive Player of the Year for the third consecutive season.

Wojciechowski achieved repeated success at the highest level with an NCAA title in the 2009-10 season as associate head coach. On the road to the championship, the Blue Devils also won the ACC

Tournament, the ACC Regular Season and NIT Season Tip-Off titles. Defense and rebounding were key for the Blue Devils who had one of the nation's top defenses, holding opponents to 61.0 points per game, and ranked 14th out of 334 teams in rebounding margin.

As a player, Wojciechowski (who was often referred to as "Wojo,") was named the top defensive player in the country his senior year, a two-time All-ACC choice and honorable mention Associated Press All-America. He appeared in 128 career games for the Blue Devils and earned 88 starting assignments.

Wojciechowski is a native of Severna Park, Md., and a first-generation college student, having earned a bachelor's degree in sociology from Duke in 1998.

He and his wife Lindsay have two sons, Jack and Charlie

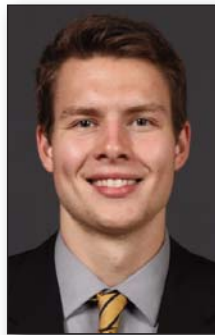
