### KANSAS' WIN...

- Made Kansas 2-0 for the second-straight season and ninth time in head coach Bill Self's 16 seasons at KU
- Gave Kansas its 46th-consecutive home opening victory, a streak which started in 1973-74
- Made Kansas 18-3 in the NIT Season Tip Off
- Made Kansas 2-0 all-time versus Vermont
- Made Kansas 773-113 all-time in Allen Fieldhouse, including 235-13 under Self
- Made Self 449-96 while at Kansas and 656-201 overall
- Made Kansas 2,250-849 all-time.

### TEAM NOTES

- KU's 81-66 victory over Vermont marked the Jayhawks' 46th-consecutive regular season home opener in Allen Fieldhouse, a streak that dates back to the 1973-74 season.
- Lagerald Vick (32) and Udoka Azubuike (23) combined 55 points are the most points by a Jayhawk duo since Devonte' Graham (35) and Vick (20) scored 55 against Syracuse on Dec. 7, 2017.
- Quentin Grimes and Azubuike's double-doubles marked the first time a pair of Jayhawks notched double-doubles since playing West Virginia in the Big 12 Tournament last season. Devonte' Graham posted 18 points and 13 assists and Silvio De Sousa had 16 points and 10 rebounds (3/10/18).
- The Jayhawks' 63.2 percent (12-19) clip from 3-point range was the team's best since hitting 69.2 percent (9-13) against New Mexico State in the first round of the NCAA Tournament on March 20, 2015.
- Combing the final 1:49 of the first half and the first 6:25 of the second half, the Jayhawks outscored the Catamounts 20-4, going 9-13 from the field and 2-3 from beyond the arc.

### INDIVIDUAL NOTES

#### Senior guard Lagerald Vick

- Senior guard Lagerald Vick's eight 3-pointers mark a career-high for treys made in a single game.
- Vick's eight treys set a Kansas record for most 3-pointers made without a miss in KU history. Ben McLemore previously held the record going 6-for-6 from the 3-point line against Iowa State in 2013.
- His eight threes tie Mario Chalmers (3/16/08 vs. Texas) and Billy Thomas (1/10/98 vs. Texas) for the second-most 3-pointers made in a single game in Kansas basketball history.
- Vick's 32 points on 12-of-14 shooting, surpass his previous career high set last season.
- Vick's 32 points are the most points scored by a senior since Devonte' Graham scored 35 points against Syracuse (12/2/17).

#### Junior center Udoka Azubuike

- Azubuike notched 23 points and 11 rebounds for his first double-double of the season and eighth overall of his career

#### Freshman guard Quentin Grimes

- Quentin Grimes' 10 points and 10 assists mark the freshman's first double-double as a Jayhawk.
- His 10 assists are the most dished out by a freshman since Tyshawn Taylor against Jackson State (12/6/08).

#### Redshirt-junior Dedric Lawson

- After being held scoreless, going 0-for-6 from the field, Monday night marked the first game in Dedric Lawson's career, now at 67 games that he was held without a point.
