KANSAS' WIN...

- Made Kansas 15-2 and 4-1 or better in Big 12 play for the 13th-straight season beginning in 2006-07
- Gave Kansas a 32-8 all-time series record against Texas, including a 17-1 record in Lawrence (15-1 in Allen Fieldhouse)
- Improved KU's record to 27-0 when playing on ESPN Big Monday inside Allen Fieldhouse under Bill Self (since 2003-04).
- Made KU 28-7 against Texas in the Big 12 era
- Gave Kansas its 14th-straight win in Allen Fieldhouse, including 10-0 this season
- Made KU 782-113 all-time in Allen Fieldhouse, including 244-13 under Bill Self
- Made Self 462-98 while at Kansas, 669-203 overall and 22-8 all-time versus Texas (22-6 while at KU)
- Made Kansas 2,263-851 all-time

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas tied its lowest turnover total in a half with 0, since the Jayhawks committed no turnovers in the second half against Wofford (12/4/18).
- The Jayhawks trailed for the sixth time this season at the half. Kansas has a 5-1 record in those games.
- Spanning the final :30 seconds of the first half and the first 2:09 of the second half, the Jayhawks went on a 10-0 run turning a 40-38 Texas lead into a 45-40 Kansas lead. Texas never regained the lead.
- The Jayhawks four turnovers for the game marked their fewest since posting just three giveaways also against Texas on Jan. 24, 2015.
- Since 2016, in Big 12 regular season games decided by 10 points or less, KU is 37-3.
- The teams combined for just 10 turnovers which marks the fewest by the Jayhawks and an opponent. The record was previously 12 in a game at Texas (1/24/15).
- Kansas capitalized on Texas' six turnovers turning them into 15 points.
- For the second straight game, Kansas shot over 50% from the field (53.7). KU is now 246-9 under Bill Self when shooting 50% or better, which includes and 8-0 mark this season.
- Kansas' 12 fouls were the lowest committed by the Jayhawks in a conference game since KU recorded nine against Texas on Feb. 26th, 2018.
- Kansas was outrebounded for the fifth time this season. The Jayhawks are 4-1 in those games.
- With Vick and Garrett each surpassing the 20 point mark, Kansas has now seen multiple 20 point scorers in five contests this season (Michigan State, Vermont, Stanford, Villanova, Texas).

TEAM NOTES (CONT.)

- The two-point margin of victory is KU's smallest this season.
- Kansas is 7-0 since the start of the 2017-2018 season in games decided by three points or less.
- The Jayhawks and Longhorns combined for just 10 turnovers marking the fewest combined giveaways in a game since the 1988-1989 season on Jan. 24th, 2015 (KU 3, UT 9).

OPPONENT NOTES

- Texas went 0-for-0 from the free throw line in the first half marking the lowest made and attempted by a KU opponent since Marquette was held without a free throw make or attempt (11/21/18).
- Texas' two steals were the fewest by a Jayhawk opponent in conference play since Iowa State swiped two Feb. 13th, 2018.
- Texas' six turnovers is the fewest in a conference game since Oklahoma turned it over six times on Feb. 26th, 2011.
- Texas' 7-7 clip from the charity stripe is the first time a conference opponent has been perfect from the free throw line since Texas Tech on Feb. 18th, 2012 (8-8).
- This is the first time a KU opponent has been perfect from the free throw line this season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Senior guard Lagerald Vick

- Tallying 18 points on the day, Vick moved past Thomas Robinson (1,026) in the list of 1,000 point scorers in the Bill Self era and sits 55th all-time. Vick finished the night with 1,022 points as a Jayhawk.
- Connecting five times from deep, Vick moved past Rex Walters (151) and Kevin Pritchard (154) with threes made in a career. Vick now sits 15th all-time.
- In his last two outings, Vick has connected on 11-of-16 (69%) of his 3-point tries. In the five contests prior, he was 9-of-36 (25%).
- He has connected from deep scoring five or more 3-pointers in five games this season.

RS-Junior forward Dedric Lawson

- Finished with 17 points marking the 15th time he's scored 10+ at KU, the 71st overall in his career.
- Following a season low 3 rebounds against Baylor, the redshirt-junior grabbed 8 boards in the Jayhawk victory.
- Since the start of Big 12 play, Lawson has shot 36-of-59 from the field (61%).

Sophomore guard Marcus Garrett

- The Texas native had a night to remember, posting a career high 20 points, 17 of which came in the first half. Garrett finished the first half 7-7 from the field including a 3-3 mark from deep.
- His three 3-pointers tied a career high. He also hit three triples against Texas Southern on Nov. 21, 2017.

Freshman guard Devon Dotson

- Dotson tallied his second-straight double digit performance as the freshman finished the night with 10 points, 5 rebounds and 4 assists.
