#### TEAM NOTES

- Kansas' all-time record improved to 583-631-58
- The last time the Jayhawks had 300+ yards in the first half was
- The Jayhawks' first-quarter touchdown marks the longest scoring drive by time on the season at 3:54.
- The game marks Les Miles' 200th game of his career.
- The last time Kansas had a 100+ yard rusher and a 100+ yard receiver was in 2017 vs. Oklahoma State: Ke'aun Kinner with 145 yards rushing and LaQuivionte Gonzalez with 106 yards receiving.
- Prior to tonight, the last time Kansas had two players rush for 100+ yards was in 2014 against Iowa State with Tony Pierson (102) and Corey Avery (104).
- Kansas' 47 points marks the most scored by the Jayhawks since last season (2018) when they tallied 55 against Rutgers.

#### OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Junior tight end **Jack Luavasa** recorded his first-career touchdown on a 19-yard catch in the first quarter with 3:27 remaining.
- Senior fullback **Hudson Hall** had his first-career rush for one yard and recorded his first-career touchdown at the beginning of the second quarter.
- Junior wide receiver **Andrew Parchment** made the longest reception of his Kansas' career for 37 yards in the first quarter.
- **Parchment** scored his first-career touchdown in the second quarter for four yards.
- Before **Parchment's** second receiving touchdown in the second quarter, the last time Kansas had a player with two touchdowns in a game was Pooka Williams Jr., against TCU in 2018 with two touchdowns for 102 yards off of seven receptions.
- Senior **Khalil Herbert** recorded the longest rush of his career for 82 yards. It was the second-longest non-scoring play in Kansas football history.
- **Herbert's** 187 yards against the Eagles moved him to 16th on the KU career rushing list with 1,708.
- Junior wide receiver **Kwamie Lassiter II** set career highs in receptions (5), yards (67) and longest reception (21).
- Senior quarterback **Carter Stanley's** 238 yards passing moved him to 11th on the Kansas career passing list.
- Freshman tight end **Mason Fairchild** made his first-career reception for nine yards in the third quarter.

#### DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Sophomore linebacker **Jay Dineen** made his first-career tackle-for-loss for three yards in the first quarter and finished with a career-high four tackles.
- Senior defensive tackle **Jelani Brown** had a career-high four tackles in the game.
- Freshman cornerback **Kenny Logan Jr.**, made his first-career tackle and finished with three in the game.
- Junior linebacker **Dru Prox** had his first-career forced fumble.
- Senior safety **Nate Betts** had a career-high two tackles.
- Senior defensive end **Codey Cole III** matched his career of two tackles in the game.
- Sophomore safety **Davon Ferguson** matched a career high with three tackles.
- Sophomore cornerback **Elmore Hempstead Jr.**, set a career high in pass breakups with two.
- Junior HAWK **Kyron Johnson Jr.**, tallied seven tackles to set a career high.
- Freshman linebacker **Gavin Potter** had a career-high five tackles.
- Sophomore defensive tackle **Caleb Sampson** recorded a career-high two tackles.
- In his first start as a Jayhawk, senior HAWK **Najee Stevens-McKenzie** made a career-high five tackles.
- In his Kansas debut, freshman linebacker **Steven Parker** made his first-career tackle.
- Sophomore defensive lineman **Malcolm Lee** matched his career-high 0.5 tackles-for-loss and 0.5 sacks.
- Redshirt junior defensive lineman **Reuben Lewis** made his first tackle as a Jayhawk.
- Redshirt junior cornerback **Kyle Mayberry** had a career-high two pass breakups.
- Senior defensive end **Willie McCaleb** made two tackles to set a new career high.
- Senior safety **Jeremiah McCullough** had two pass breakups to set a career high.
- Sophomore wide receiver **Takulve Williams** made his first-career tackle.
- Senior wide receiver **Daylon Charlot** had a career-high three tackles.
- Redshirt freshman wide receiver **Jamahl Horne** recorded one tackle to match his career high.
- Sophomore wide receiver **Hunter Kaufman** made his first-career tackle.

#### SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Redshirt freshman **Jamahl Horne** had a career-long kick return in the first quarter, taking it back against the Eagles for 37 yards.
- Junior punter **Kyle Thompson's** first punt of the night went 49 yards and landed on the three-yard line
