KANSAS' WIN ...

- Made Kansas 90-9 all-time in exhibition games.
- Extended KU's home exhibition winning streak to 52 games dating back to the 1994 season.
- Gave Kansas its 31st-consecutive exhibition victory.
- Made KU 13-0 against Pittsburg State, including 9-0 in exhibition games.
- Improved Kansas head coach Bill Self to 58-2 in exhibition play while at KU, including 34-0 in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Made KU 63-5 in exhibition games in Allen Fieldhouse.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas opened the night on a 24-4 run with buckets from six different Jayhawks. KU took a double digit lead with 15:00 remaining and never let the lead fall under 10 from that point on.
- Kansas' 18 three point attempts in the first half would have been the most by KU since the Jayhawks shot 18 against Baylor on February 10, 2018.
- KU's 102-42 marked the most points by a Jayhawk team in exhibition play since Kansas defeated the Italy All-Stars 118-74 on August 6, 2017.
- The Jayhawks 60-point victory was the largest in season exhibition play since Kansas topped Emporia State 120-51 on November 4, 2000.
- Pittsburg State's 42 points marked the fewest by a KU season exhibition opponent since Fort Hays State was held to 41 on November 13, 2001. It also marked the seventh time Kansas has limited its exhibition opponent to under 50 points since the 1978-79 season.
- Kansas' 10 makes from three in the second half would have marked the most by the Jayhawks since Kansas hit 10 in the first half against Texas A&M on January 27, 2018. In addition, the 20 attempts from beyond-the-arc in the second half would have been the most by Kansas since the Jayhawks launched 20 against Texas in the second half on December 29, 2017.

OPPONENT NOTES

- Kansas held Pitt State's Ray Elliott to an 0-for-12 mark from the field, which would have marked the most opponent field goal attempts in a game with none made in the last 31 seasons.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Senior Udoka Azubuike

- Grabbed a team high 12 rebounds while adding a perfect 4-for-4 night from the field scoring 8 points.

Junior Silvio De Sousa

- Grabbed 10 rebounds which would have marked the fourth time in his career grabbing 10 or more rebounds.

Sophomore Ochai Agbaji

- Scored a team high 19 points going 7-for-8 from the field.
- Agbaji would have matched his career high in makes from deep at 5, a mark he's set twice, most recently against Oklahoma State on February 9, 2019.
- Dished what would have been a career high 6 assists, surpassing his current mark of 4 he tallied against Baylor on March 9, 2019.

Sophomore Devon Dotson

- Scored an exhibition career high with 12 points on a 4-for-13 performance from the field.
- Matched what would have been his career high in field goal attempts with 13.
- Dished a team high 7 assists.

Sophomore David McCormack

- Scored 13 points with an efficient 6-of-7 night from the field while grabbing 5 rebounds.
