### MISCELLANEOUS:

- Coin Toss: Oklahoma won the toss and deferred. Kansas will receive and defend the north goal.
- Weather delay: The start of the game was delayed 24 minutes due to weather. The game officially kicked off at 11:30 a.m.

### TEAM NOTES

- Kansas' all-time record is now 587-644-58.

### OFFENSIVE NOTES

- With three touchdown passes vs. Oklahoma, senior QB **Carter Stanley** moved into a tie for fifth place on KU's all-time chart for touchdown passes with 25 in his career.
- Junior WR **Stephon Robinson** had a career day for KU, posting a personal best 131 yards receiving, while tying a career-high with five receptions.
- Robinson eclipsed the 100-yard receiving mark for the first time in his KU career and is the second Jayhawk to accomplish the feat in 2019, as junior WR **Andrew Parchment** has three to his credit.
- Robinson set a career-high with two receiving touchdowns in the game vs. Oklahoma. He now has three in his time as a Jayhawk.
- Sophomore RB **Pooka Williams Jr.**, recorded his fifth-career 100-yard rushing game with a season-high 137 yards on the ground on a career-high 23 carries vs. the Sooners. It marked his second 100-yard rushing game of 2019.
- Williams has had a lot of success running the ball against the Sooners, combining for 389 yards on 38 carries during his two games against OU. Williams had 252 yards rushing in Norman in 2018.
- With his 137 rushing yards against Oklahoma, Williams eclipsed the 1,500 yard mark in just his 16 career games. He now has 1,570 career rushing yards and needs just 27 yards to break into KU's top 20 all-time rushers.
- Kansas scored on a 98-yard drive to open the day's scoring, marking its longest scoring drive by yards since traveling 98 yards for a score against Texas in 2012.
- The Kansas offense got on the scoreboard first, handing the Sooners their first deficit of 2019.

### DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Senior HAWK **Najee Stevens-McKenzie** recorded his second-career interception, picking off Oklahoma QB Jalen Hurts on the first play of the fourth quarter.
- Sophomore S **Davon Ferguson** recorded his first-career sack, bringing down Oklahoma QB Jalen Hurts for a 23-yard loss late in the second quarter.
- The Jayhawks defense was able to keep Oklahoma's high-powered offense at 545 yards, 123 yards under its FBS-leading season average.
