TIP-OFF

- After its 68-66 loss to No. 4 Duke on Nov. 5, Kansas is 0-1 for only the second time in the Bill Self era with the other being in 2016-17. KU went on to go 31-5 that season and advanced to the Elite Eight.
- The last time KU entered its home opener 0-1 was 1981-82 under head coach Ted Owens. That season Jayhawks lost to North Carolina in Charlotte, N.C., before defeating Arizona State the following game in Lawrence.
- KU has won a mind-boggling 46-consecutive regular-season home openers in Allen Fieldhouse, a streak which started in the 1973-74 season.
- Kansas 93-13 following a loss in the Bill Self era, including 8-1 last season. Since the 2013-14 season, KU is 43-5 following a loss.
- KU went 17-0 in home games last season, including a 16-0 record in Allen Fieldhouse. KU has gone undefeated in Allen Fieldhouse 20 times, including seven seasons since 2007-08.
- Kansas' 21-game home court winning streak enters 2019-20 as the fourth longest active in NCAA Division I.
- Kansas and UNGC have met just once with KU winning 105-66 on Nov. 22, 2002. KU went on to play in the 2003 Final Four, finishing runner-up and posting at 30-8 record under head coach Roy Williams.
- Kansas entered the season ranked No. 3 in both the preseason Associated Press and USA TODAY Coaches' top-25 polls. The Jayhawks have been ranked fifth or higher in each of the last seven preseason AP polls and the last six coaches' polls.
- KU has been ranked in each of the last 201 AP polls dating back to 2008-09. The 201-consecutive weeks in the polls is the longest active streak in the nation. KU holds the same streak in the coaches' poll at 210.
- Senior Udoka Azubuike was named the Big 12 Preseason Player of the Year by the league's coaches. He is the ninth Jayhawk to claim preseason Big 12 honors as the top player and the seventh in the Bill Self era.

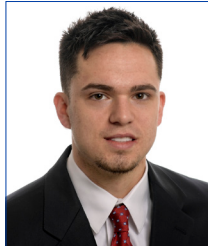

ABOUT KANSAS

No. 3 Kansas is looking to bounce back from a 68-66 loss to No. Duke at the Champions Classic on Nov. 5 at Madison Square Garden in New York, N.Y. The Jayhawks are 0-1 for the first time since the 2016-17 season.

Kansas returns three starters and eight letterwinners from last season's 26-10 team which opened the season No. 1 in the national polls, won the NIT Season Tip Off, finished 12-6 in the Big 12, reached the Big 12 Tournament title game and advanced to its NCAA record 30th-consecutive NCAA Tournament.

Senior center Udoka Azubuike was named the 2019-20 Preseason Big 12 Player of the Year by the conference coaches and was joined on the preseason all-league team by sophomore guard Devon Dotson. Azubuike had eight points and eight rebounds against Duke, while Dotson led all scorers with 17 points in the season opener.

Sophomore guard Ochai Agbaji scored 15 points in the season opener, including going 2-for-3 from 3-point range. He also had a team-high four steals in the contest. Agbaji started 22 of 16 games for KU last season with an 8.5 ppg and 4.6 rpg.

Guard Marcus Garrett had 12 points and a team-high five assists with two steals against Duke. A lock down defender, Garrett averaged 7.3 points and 4.2 rebounds per contest in 2018-19.

Sophomore forward David McCormack led all rebounders with 13 boards against Duke. He scored six points in the contest and had two steals. McCormack started the final 13 games of last season.

The top KU newcomers include freshman guards Chris Braun from Burlington, Kansas, freshman guard/forward Tristan Enaruna from Flevoland, Netherlands, and freshman forward Jalen Wilson from Denton, Texas. Enaruna had five points, two rebounds and a steal in 16 minutes in the opener. Braun played four minutes and Wilson two against Duke.

ABOUT UNCG

Located Greensboro, N.C., with an enrollment of 20,196, UNCG is 1-0 on the season after its 83-50 win against North Carolina A&T on Nov. 5 in Greensboro, N.C. The Spartans are coached by Wed Miller who is 142-117 in his ninth season at UNCG and his ninth season overall. UNCG is the preseason No. 2 pick in the Southern Conference, trailing only East Tennessee State, Kansas' Nov. 19 opponent.

UNCG returns three starters and 10 letterwinners from last season's 29-7 team which finished second in the Southern Conference with a 15-3 league record and advanced to the postseason NIT. Junior guard Isaiah Miller is the Preseason SoCon Player of the Year having earned all-conference first team and defensive player of the year honors last season. Miller had 13 points, six rebounds, three assists and three steals in the opener against North Carolina A&T.

Other returning starters include senior forward Kyrin Galloway and senior forward James Dickey. Galloway had five points, five rebounds, three blocked shots and two steals in the opener and averaged 9.4 points and 4.3 rebounds last season with 38 blocked shots. Dickey also had three blocked shots and two steals in the opener to go along with four points and four rebounds. He averaged 7.5 ppg and 8.0 rpg last season.

Sophomore guard Kaleb Hunter led UNCG with 17 points and seven rebounds in the season-opening victory. He averaged 5.7 points last season. Other Spartans who scored in double figures in the opener were sophomore forward Angelo Allegri (11 points) and sophomore guard Michael Hueitt Jr. (10 points). Allegri is from Kansas City, Mo., and attended St. Thomas Aquinas High School before finishing his prep career at Link Year Prep in Branson, Mo.

THE SERIES

Kansas and UNCG have met once in men's basketball with Kansas winning 105-66 on Nov. 22, 2002, in Allen Fieldhouse. Kansas was led by senior All-America Nick Collison who scored 25 points on 10-of-13 shooting with eight rebounds. Sophomore Keith Langford scored 24 points, while senior Kirk Hinrich had 23. Sophomore Wayne Simien led all rebounders posting a double-double with 18 points and 10 boards.

UNCG will be the first of two teams from the Southern Conference Kansas will face this season. KU will host East Tennessee State on Nov. 19 in a home contest for the Maui Jim Maui Invitational. KU is 13-0 all-time against the SoCon: 3-0 vs. Chattanooga, 3-0 vs. ETSU, 3-0 vs. Western Carolina, 1-0 vs. The Citadel and 1-0 vs. UNCG.

DUKE LEFTOVERS

- Duke's win broke a three-game losing streak against Kansas. It was the Blue Devils first win over the Jayhawks since the 2011 Maui Invitational.
- Kansas fell to 0-1 for the second time in the 17 years under coach Bill Self with the other in 2016-17.
- The loss ended a Kansas three-game winning streak in the Champions Classic, making KU 4-5 in the event. KU is 2-1 versus Duke in the Champions Classic.
- The Jayhawks committed 28 turnovers for the game, the most by a KU team since Kansas tallied 29 against Colorado on February 15, 1992.
- KU dropped to 98-50 vs AP Top-25 teams in the Self era, 40-21 with those teams being ranked in the Top-10. The loss was also just the third in KU's last 25 regular-season match-up against an AP top-10 opponent.
- Junior Marcus Garrett dished a team high five assists, matching his career high which he's met three times, the last against Oklahoma (12.19).
- Sophomore guard Ochai Agbaji swiped a career high four steals.
- Agbaji scored 15 points on a 6-for-10 shooting night from the field while adding six rebounds. His 2-of-3 clip from beyond the 3-point line marked the sixth time in his 23-career appearances that he has connected on multiple triples in a game.
- Sophomore guard Devon Dotson scored a team high 17 points going 5-of-9 for the game.
- Sophomore forward David McCormack grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds, replacing a previous high of nine which he set against Texas (3.14.19).

BOUNCING BACK

Since Bill Self took the helm of the Jayhawks in 2003, Kansas has been stellar at bouncing back following a loss. Over the last 16 seasons, Kansas is 93-13 in games coming off a defeat, which is the best winning percentage in NCAA DI in that span.

Incredibly, KU has been even more efficient over the last six seasons, amassing a record of 42-5 after losses. This includes an 8-1 mark last season.

KANSAS STREAKING AT HOME (AGAIN)

Going 17-0 at home in 2018-19, the Jayhawks are once again building an impressive winning streak on their home court, something that has been a common occurrence in Lawrence over recent decades.

KU has won 21-straight home games, 20 of which have come at Allen Fieldhouse (the Dec. 8, 2018 win at Sprint Center considered a home game). The streak currently ranks as the fourth-longest active among NCAA DI schools. KU's last home loss came to Oklahoma State on Feb. 3, 2018. In 2018-19, the Jayhawks wrapped up their 20th undefeated season at Allen Fieldhouse and their first since 2015-16.

Since Bill Self took the reins in 2003-04, Kansas as posted seven unblemished records in a season on James Naismith Court. The Jayhawks have won more Big 12 regular-season titles (14) than have lost home games (13) in that span.

Kansas has now posted home-court winning streaks of 20 games or more 15 times, with 11 of those streaks coming at Allen Fieldhouse. The program record is 69-straight home wins from Feb. 7, 2007, to Jan. 22, 2011. That streak is a Big 12 record and the 11th-longest in NCAA DI history.

KANSAS NO. 3 IN PRESEASON USA TODAY COACHES' PRESS POLL

Like the preseason Associated Press poll released Oct. 21, the Kansas men's basketball team is ranked No. 3 in the preseason *USA TODAY* Coaches' Poll released Oct. 24.

This is the sixth-straight year the Jayhawks have opened the season in the top-five and KU is ranked in the preseason for the 28th time in time in the 31-year history of the poll. With the preseason ranking, Kansas has appeared in each of the last 210 coaches' polls, which is the longest active streak in coaches' poll history.

The No. 3 ranking marks the 10th time KU has been preseason No. 3 or higher in the coaches' poll. Additionally, it is the 14th time in the Bill Self era the Jayhawks have been preseason seventh or higher, including each of the last eight seasons. In 2018-19 Kansas opened the year No. 1 in the preseason coaches' poll and ended No. 16.

Kansas could potentially play eight games against teams ranked in the coaches' preseason poll this season. Those include: No. 1 Michigan State (potential in Maui Invitational), No. 4 Duke, No. 10 Villanova, No. 12 Texas Tech (twice), No. 18 Baylor (twice), and No. 25 Tennessee.

KANSAS NO. 3 IN PRESEASON ASSOCIATED PRESS POLL

For the seventh-consecutive season, Kansas men's basketball enters the preseason ranked fifth or higher as KU is No. 3 in the 2019-20 preseason Associated Press poll released Oct. 21. Kansas has been ranked in the Associated Press polls for 201-consecutive weeks, which is the longest active streak in the nation.

Kansas received three first-place votes among the 65-member voting panel and trails Michigan State and Kentucky, respectively, in the 2019-20 preseason AP poll. Duke is No. 4 and Louisville fifth to round out the AP's top five.

Last season, Kansas entered the preseason ranked No. 1 nationally in the Associated Press poll for the third time in school history and ended at No. 17. The Jayhawks were ranked in the AP Top 10 for 12 weeks in 2018-19. In KU's 2018 Final Four run, the Jayhawks were preseason No. 4 by AP. Kansas was No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16 and No. 5 in 2014-15 and 2013-14. It is also the 10th time in the last 11 seasons that the Jayhawks have entered the season No. 7 or higher by the AP.

Under 17th-year and Hall of Fame head coach Bill Self, this is the 14th time that Kansas enters the season ranked seventh or higher in the Associated Press preseason poll and historically, the No. 3 ranking marks the 22nd time since the 1992-93 season that Kansas will enter the season seventh or higher.

KANSAS VS. TOP-25 TEAMS

Kansas went 8-4 against top-25 teams in 2018-19. Under Bill Self, KU is 98-50 against AP-ranked opponents. In his first 16 seasons, Self's Jayhawks have collected four wins or more over top-25 ranked foes in 13 of those seasons, which includes a 43-21 record from 2014-present.

KU's record against top-10 ranked opponents is even more impressive. KU is 18-6 against foes ranked inside the top-10 of the AP poll since 2013-14, including 2-1 in 2018-19 and 4-1 in 2017-18. Since Bill Self's first season, the Jayhawks are 13-3 against AP top-10 teams inside Allen Fieldhouse, which includes KU's current streak of nine-straight home victories against top-10 foes.

AZUBUIKE'S, DOTSON'S PRESEASON HONORS GROW

Kansas senior Udoka Azubuike and sophomore Devon Dotson have received numerous preseason honors heading into the 2019-20 season. Earlier this week, both were named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 and the Naismith Trophy and NABC Player of the Year watch lists. On Oct. 22, the Associated Press listed the KU duo as receiving votes when it announced its preseason All-America men's basketball team. A total of 21 players were recognized, voted on by a 65-member media panel. Kansas was the only school with two players listed.

Earlier in October, Azubuike was named the Preseason Big 12 Player of the Year and Preseason All-Big 12 by the conference coaches. He was also named one of 20 on the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year watch list. Dotson joined Azubuike on the Preseason All-Big 12 team and was one of 20 on the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year watch list.

Azubuike played in nine games in 2018-19 before an injury sidelined him for the season. The 7-foot-0, 270-pound center from Delta, Nigeria, averaged 13.4 points and 6.8 rebounds while shooting 70.5 percent from the field last season. As a sophomore in leading Kansas to the 2018 Final Four, Azubuike led the nation with a 77.0 field goal percentage, which ranks second-best for a season in NCAA history and set the KU and Big 12 single-season records. He averaged 13.0 points and 7.0 rebounds while being named an All-Big 12 Third Team selection. Azubuike is a two-time Academic All-Big 12 selection.

Kansas is 3-0 all-time in games on Nov. 8

Kansas opened the 2013-14 regular season with an 80-63 win against Louisiana Monroe in Allen Fieldhouse. Freshman Andrew Wiggins led KU with 16 points, while Perry Ellis and Andrew White III scored 12 each. Ellis led all rebounders with eight boards while senior Tarik Black pulled down seven and scored eight points. The victory was Kansas' 700th in Allen Fieldhouse and the Jayhawks' 41st consecutive home-opening win. Kansas would go on to post a 25-10 record in 2013-14 and finish first in the Big 12 regular season with a 14-4 record.

As a freshman, Dotson (6-foot-2, 185) started every game for Kansas in 2018-19 and ranked 12th in the Big 12 in scoring at 12.3 points per game. The Charlotte, N.C., guard was a member of the 2019 All-Big 12 Third Team and the league's all-freshman team. Dotson also ranked sixth in the conference in assists (3.5), 11th in field goal percentage (48.2), tied for ninth in steals (1.4) and ninth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.6). He averaged 15.7 points, 4.0 rebounds and 4.3 assists in leading KU to the Big 12 Tournament title game and was named to the event's all-tournament team.

PRESEASON BIG 12 POLL

For the ninth-straight season and 19th time in the 24-year history of the league, Kansas tops the men's basketball Big 12 Coaches Preseason Poll. The Jayhawks received eight of a possible nine first-place votes by the coaches in 2019-20 poll. The coaches were not allowed to vote for their own team.

KU has won 18 outright or shared Big 12 regular-season championships in the previous 23 years since the inception of the league in 1996-97. Included was an NCAA-record 14 consecutive from 2005-18. KU's 61 overall conference titles is also an NCAA record.

Historically, the other 18 times Kansas has been named the preseason favorite, the Jayhawks won the Big 12 regular-season on 15 occasions. This includes the first preseason poll in 1996-97 in which only a media poll was conducted.

PRESEASON STARTING FIVE

Kansas is well represented on the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame's Starting 5 awards released Oct. 14-18. Of the five awards announced, which consisted of 20 candidates per category, Kansas is listed on two of the watch lists. Sophomore guard Devon Dotson is up for the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award for the second straight season. Senior center Udoka Azubuike for the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award, also for the second-consecutive year.

Historically, Kansas has had numerous student-athletes named as candidates and finalists, including last year with Dedric Lawson for the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year Award. In 2017, Frank Mason III was the recipient of the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award.

BORDER SHOWDOWN TO REIGNITE

Kansas Athletics announced Oct. 21 that an agreement has been made with the University of Missouri to reignite the Border Showdown rivalry that will feature six men's basketball games, with the first match-up slated for next season on December 12, 2020 at Sprint Center in Kansas City. Until 2012, the Border Showdown was known as the longest continuous rivalry west of the Mississippi River.

The Kansas-Missouri basketball series dates back to 1907, when the Jayhawks and Tigers met on back-to-back days in Lawrence on March 11-12, both MU wins. Those contests were the first of 269 meetings between the border rivals over the next 105 years, with the Jayhawks building a 174-95 edge in the all-time series. Kansas is 89-33 at home vs. Missouri, including 42-14 in Allen Fieldhouse, 65-53 in Columbia and the series is tied at 4-4 in Mizzou Arena.

CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Kentucky is second with 54 and Penn third at 37. KU's 14-straight league titles, all under head coach Bill Self, is the longest streak in NCAA Division I and in school history.

TOP-10 TRIUMPHS

The Jayhawks have been stellar when taking on a top-10 team in the regular-season during the Bill Self era. The Jayhawks have lost only three regular-season contests against top-10 teams in its last 23 tries. One of those losses came at then-No. 8 Kentucky last season, a game result which ended an astounding 13-game regular-season winning streak against top-10 foes.

Kansas is an incredible 20-3 in its last 23 regular-season contests against top-10 ranked squads. Since Bill Self took the reins of the Jayhawks in 2003, KU is 40-21 against top-10 teams, a number which includes postseason play.

- Kansas has 2,274 all-time victories, second most in NCAA Division I history (Kentucky - 2,291).
- From the 2008-09 season to the present (11 seasons) Kansas has held 378 of its 406 opponents under 50 percent shooting.
- KU has held opponents to fewer than 100 points in 593 of its last 595 games. The last team to score 100 on Kansas in a 40-minute game was Oklahoma (100-78) on Feb. 27, 1990.
- Kansas has been ranked in the Associated Press top-25 poll for 201-consecutive weeks (as of 3/18/19). The next closest active streak is North Carolina at 101-straight weeks ranked. KU's current stretch began on Feb. 2, 2009.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN 2019-20

- Kansas has won 21-straight home games and enters the season No. 4 on the active home court winning streak. Last year, KU went 17-0 at home, including 16-0 in Allen Fieldhouse. Buffalo and Tennessee are tied for the NCAA Division I lead at 26, with Gonzaga at 22 and Kansas at 21. Nevada is fifth at 18.
- The 2019-20 Jayhawks are looking to put the finishing touches on the winningest decade in program history. KU IS 304-67 record during the 2010s. The .819 win percentage this decade trails only the run in the 1990's that saw the Jayhawks win 82.7 percent of its games at 286-60.
- Kansas has won five straight in-season tournaments after claiming the 2018 NIT Season Tip-Off last season in Brooklyn, N.Y. Included in the run was the 2015 Maui Jim Maui Invitational, an event KU will compete in Nov. 25-27, in Lahaina, Hawaii.
- Kansas ranks second all-time in wins with 2,274. The Jayhawks are 26 victories from No. 2,300.
- Kansas is 788-113 all-time in Allen Fieldhouse and is 12 shy from win No. 800 in the historic venue.
- KU head coach Bill Self has a 473-107 record in 16 seasons at Kansas. He is 27 wins shy of 500 while at KU.
- Overall, Self is 680-212 in 26 seasons as a head coach, 20 shy of 700 all-time wins.
- Senior center Udoka Azubuike entered 2019-20 with a career field goal percentage of 74.4. The current KU career field goal percentage record is 62.0 percent by Mark Randall (1987, 89-91). The Big 12 career field goal percentage record is 63.7 by Ricardo Ratliffe of Missouri (2010-12).
- Senior Mitch Lightfoot enters the season tied for 20th on the KU career blocked shots list with 98. He is 49 blocks from the KU top 10. Lightfoot announced Nov. 2 that he will redshirt 2019-20.
- Senior transfer Isaiah Moss is 94 points from 1,000 for his career. In three seasons at Iowa, Moss accumulated 906 points.

NOTES

- Bill Self was named the eighth coach in Kansas basketball history on April 21, 2003.
- In September 2017, Self was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Massachusetts.
- Self won his 600th career game on Dec. 6, 2016, with KU's 105-62 win against UMKC. He became the 46th coach in NCAA Division I to accomplish the feat and the ninth fastest.
- While at Kansas, Self has won a national championship, a KU- and NCAA-record 14-straight regular-season Big 12 Conference titles and eight league tournament championships.
- At Kansas, Self has won more regular-season league titles (14) than he has home losses (13) in Allen Fieldhouse. With KU's win versus Siena (11/18/16), Self became the winningest coach in Allen Fieldhouse, posting his 207th victory in the venue.
- In his first trip to the Final Four in 2008, Self's team won the title. Self is one of 11 active coaches in NCAA Division I to have won a national title. Kansas' 14-straight conference titles (2005-18) is the longest streak in NCAA Division I history.
- In Self's first 15 seasons at Kansas, he has coached 11 NBA Lottery selections including Andrew Wiggins and Joel Embiid, the No. 1 and No. 3 overall selections in the 2014 NBA Draft. Wiggins was the second-ever Jayhawk to go No. 1 with the other being Danny Manning in 1988.
- Self has guided his teams to 21-straight 23-win seasons dating back to 1998-99.
- Self's teams have won 18 league crowns in the last 21 years. His teams have never finished lower than third in the conference.
- Kansas' four-straight 30-win seasons from 2009-10 to 2012-13 are the most consecutive 30-win seasons in NCAA history (note: Memphis did it from 2006-09 yet later vacated the 2008 season).
- Self was the head coach for Team USA's U18 team that competed and won gold at the 2018 FIBA Americas Championship held in St. Catherine's, Canada, in the summer of 2018.
- Self is one of five coaches in NCAA Division I history to have led three different teams - Tulsa, Illinois and Kansas - to the NCAA Elite Eight, including seven times with KU (2004-07-08-11-12-16-17). The other coaches are: Gene Bartow, John Calipari, Rick Pitino and Eddie Sutton.
- A 1985 graduate of Oklahoma State, Self began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Kansas in 1985-86 under head coach Larry Brown. He then returned to his alma mater as an assistant for seven seasons under coaches Leonard Hamilton and Eddie Sutton. His first head coaching job was at Oral Roberts in 1993-94, then Tulsa (1997-98), Illinois (2000-03) and Kansas (2003-present).

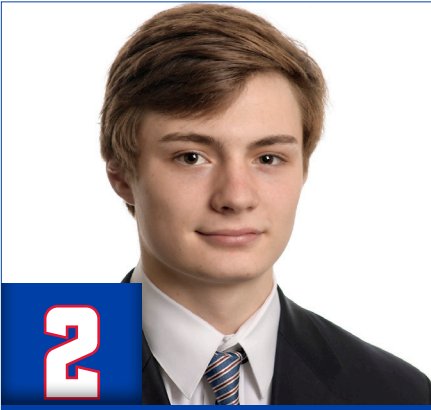
