KANSAS' WIN ...

- Gave Kansas its 47th consecutive season home opening victory, a streak which started in 1973-74.
- Made Kansas 1-1 for the eighth time in the Bill Self era.
- Made the KU-UNCG series 2-0 in favor of the Jayhawks.
- Made the Jayhawks 94-13 in games following a loss under Bill Self and 43-5 since 2013-14.
- Made KU 14-0 against current members of the Southern Conference.
- Gave Kansas its 22nd straight home win, including 21 in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Marked the 292nd consecutive sellout in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Made KU 789-113 all-time in Allen Fieldhouse, including 251-13 under Self.
- Improved Self to 474-107 while at Kansas and 681-212 for his career.
- Made Kansas 2,275-860 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas' 36-32 lead at the break marked the first time this season that Kansas took a lead into the half. Kansas is now 384-31 when leading at the break in the Bill Self era.
- Kansas opened the second half on a 12-2 run taking a 48-34 lead with 16:02 to play. The Jayhawks wouldn't let its lead dwindle under 10 from this point. The Jayhawks
- largest lead would come after a rim-rattling dunk by Azubuike, giving Kansas a 64-43 lead with 8:54 to play.
- Kansas improved its record to 434-17 when leading at the 5:00 mark in the Self era.
- Kansas tallied 74 points on the night as it improved its record to 149-20 when scoring between 70-79 points in the Self era.
- The Jayhawks outrebounded their opponent for the second time this season. KU is now 1-1 in those contests with a record of 352-46 in the Self era.

• Kansas finished the night with a 46% mark from the field while holding UNCG to 39%. The Jayhawks are now 441-38 when shooting better than their opponent from the field.

OPPONENT NOTES

• Isaiah Miller's seven makes from the field in the first half marked the most by an opponent in a half against Kansas since Phil Booth made eight in the second half for Villanova on December 15, 2018.

Malik Massey's 0-for-7 night is the most field goal attempts without a make by an opponent since Ty Groce of Eastern Michigan went 0-for-7 on December 29, 2018.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Senior Udoka Azubuike

• Azubuike finished the night with a team high 10 rebounds marking the first time the senior has pulled down 10+ rebounds since he grabbed 11 against Vermont on November 12, 2018.

· Azubuike tallied 10 points to go along with his 10 rebounds marking the ninth double-double in his career.

Freshman Isaiah Moss

• In his Kansas debut, the senior tallied eight points while adding three rebounds.

Sophomore Devon Dotson

• Notched a career high in free throws made and went 8-for-8 on the night.

• Finished with a team high 22 points adding eight rebounds and six assists while committing just one turnover. His performance marked the third 20+ point night in his career.

- Scored in double-figures for the 26th time in his career.
- Dotson took a career high 14 shots from the floor, surpassing his previous high of 13 which he set twice, the latest against lowa State on March 16, 2019.

Freshman Tristan Enaruna

Posted nine points while grabbing five rebounds and dishing two assists in 20 minutes of play.
