KANSAS' WIN...

- Made Kansas 5-1 or better for the eighth straight season, starting in 2012-13, and for the 15th time in the 17-year Bill Self era.
- Made the KU-BYU series 4-1 in favor of the Jayhawks.
- Made Kansas 17-6 all-time in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational, including 14-6 in games at Lahaina Civic Center.
- Gave KU its fifth-straight win in the Maui Invitational.
- Gave Kansas its third-straight Maui Invitational Championship game appearance.
- Gave the Jayhawks their 13th-straight in-season tournament victory.
- Improved Self to 478-107 while at Kansas and 685-212 for his career.
- Made Kansas 2,279-860 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas took a slim 29-27 lead into the break marking the fifth time in its six outings this season that KU has led at the half. The Jayhawks are 5-0 in those contests with a 388-31 record in the Self era.
- KU's 29 first-half points were the fewest by the Jayhawks in a half this season. The opening stanza point total also marked the fewest by Kansas in the Maui Invitational since KU tallied 26 in the first half against Vanderbilt on Nov. 25, 2015.
- Kansas used a 9-0 run early in the second half to grab a 42-31 lead with 13:23 remaining.
- The Jayhawks outscored BYU 42-18 in the paint, marking the fourth-straight game that Kansas has outscored its opponent by 20 or more points in the paint.
- Kansas limited BYU to just one free throw attempt in the second half, the fewest by a Jayhawk opponent since West Virginia attempted one charity shot on Jan. 19, 2019.
- KU's 10 fouls committed marked the fewest by the Jayhawks since KU committed eight against Kansas State on Feb. 25, 2019.
- The Cougars four free throw attempts were the fewest taken against Kansas since West Virginia had just two attempts on Feb. 17, 2018.
- BYU's five offensive rebounds were the fewest by a Jayhawk opponent since Oklahoma grabbed three on Mar. 5, 2019.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Senior Udoka Azubuike

- With 11 points and 10 rebounds on the night, Azubuike tallied his second double-double of the season and his 10th of his career.
- After going 5-of-6 from the field, has shot 84.4 percent from the field in his last four outings via a 27-of-32 clip.

Sophomore Devon Dotson

- Attempted a career-high 16 shots from the floor, replacing his old mark of 14 set on Nov. 18, 2019 against UNC Greensboro.
- Finished with 13 points going 3-for-3 from the free throw line. Dotson is now 32-of-36 from the charity stripe this season.
- Tied his career high with eight assists, a clip he's hit twice previously. The most recent came against West Virginia on Feb. 16, 2019.

Sophomore David McCormack

- Finished the night with 16 points, just two shy of his career high on a 7-for-9 shooting performance.
