TEAM NOTES

- Kansas scores 46 points in the second half over Wright State's 31 points.
- Kansas held Wright State under 20 points in each quarter (18, 14, 16, 15).
- Kansas out scored thier opponnent in every category in miscelleaneous stats with the most notable being points in the paint (38-24).
- For the fifth consecutive game, the Jayhawks had at least two players record double-figure scoring efforts.
- KU recorded a season-best 15 assist with Aniya Thomas leading with five.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Freshman Guard Zakiyah Franklin

- Franklin led the team with 19 points, surpassing her previous career-high 16 point in her Jayhawk debut game vs Indiana State (11.7.19)
- Franklin was just one assist shy of her career-high (6).
- Franklin's second game where she played 35 minutes.
- The freshman attempted 16 field goals and connected on four and was 2-for-5 from the three. She also shot 5-for-6 from the charity stripe.

Sophomore guard Aniya Thomas

- Thomas tallied 15 points for the second time this season. She now has four games where she had posted double-digits
- Thomas posted a career-high of five assist.

Freshman Guard Holly Kersgieter

- Kersgieter scored 14 points on 4-for-7 shooting and 2-for-4 from beyond the arc. She sank six free throws to round out her 14 points.
- Kersgieter grabbed five rebounds to add to her career total of 32 in six games.
