Head Coach Brandon Schneider

On the beginning of the game....

"I thought we got off to a good start with it being 25-10. Then the next 12 minutes I thought Texas State kind of took control and went on a run. Part of that was them playing better, part of that was us getting out of character and us not being near as disciplined defensively as what we started."

On the message coming out of halftime....

"I thought we played tougher. We wanted to try and get control of the game on the defensive end, and we only allowed 18 points in the second half."

On having five players on the court who can shoot the three....

"It's not something we've practiced near enough. We have a package we can run but we didn't look very comfortable in it so we just need a lot more practice time with that particular line-up in."

On the fouling during the game....

"We gotta be more disciplined. We committed some fouls today because we were out of position and that's something that can be improved through practice and through film work."

On her performance to start the game.....

"Especially in the beginning, it was something I wanted to work on because in the past games I've been starting not as good as I wanted to so I was focusing on the start."

On playing the center position....

"It is definitely something we work on in practice so I was comfortable. It is better for me to play the five because then I have more space to shoot the three."

On the mentality going into the second half after foul trouble in the first half....

"I always like to think I have 20 minutes left to work so even though I only played two minutes [in the second quarter] I still knew I had 20 minutes to play."
