Team Notes

- Head coach Brandon Schneider nets his 450th win in his career as a head coach.
- Schneider is now 34-17 in the months of November and December while coaching Kansas.
- KU dominated in the paint outrebounding (39-36) and outscoring Saint Louis in the paint, 36-26.
- KU wins its first overtime game of the season and increases winning streak to 10-0.
- SLU is ranked 30th in RPI and the 68-60 win on the road marks the first top-30 win (RPI) for the Jayhawks.

Individual Notes

Freshman Guard Zakiyah Franklin

- Leading KU in points, Zakiyah tied her career-high with 19 points.
- Franklin shot over 50% from the field connecting eight times on 14 tries.
- Her 2-for-3 effort from behind the arc gave her a 66.7% shooting mark on the night.

Sophomore Guard Brooklyn Mitchell

- Mitchell poured in nine of her 15 points in overtime to help KU to an eight-point win.
- Mitchell found success with scoring on the field with a 6-for-8 (75%) effort inside the arc.
- Seven times have Mitchell walked away scoring in double-figures.

Sophomore Guard Aniya Thomas

- Finished with 15 points, including a clutch three-point in the fourth quarter that helped the Jayhawk to victory.
- This is Thomas' eighth game scoring in double-digits.
- Thomas put KU on the board first with an easy lay-in in the first 30 second of first quarter. On four other occasions, Thomas has scored the first points for the Jayhawks.
