KANSAS' WIN...

- Made Kansas 14-3 overall.
- Improved KU to 4-1 or better in Big 12 play for the 13th-straight season and 16th time in the Bill Self era.
- Gave Kansas three-straight Big 12 road wins for the first time since the 2017-18 season.
- Made Kansas 4-1 in true road games this season and 8-2 in games not played in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Made the Kansas-Texas series 34-9 overall in favor of KU, 11-7 in Texas meetings with all in the Erwin Center.
- Improved Self to 487-109 while at Kansas, 694-214 for his career and 24-9 against Texas, 24-7 while at Kansas.
- Made Kansas 2,289-862 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas opened the second half on a 10-2 run, with Udoka Azubuike scoring eight points during that stretch.
- The Jayhawks found themselves trailing by eight points, marking the third time in its five conference contests that it has trailed by eight points or more. KU is now 2-1 in those games.
- KU limited the Longhorns to 57 points, marking the 10th time this season the Jayhawks have held their opponent to under 60 points. KU is now 9-1 in those games and 177-2 in the Bill Self era.
- KU connected on just two 3-pointers on the day, the second-fewest for the Jayhawks this season and the fourth time they have been held to 3 or fewer triples. KU is 3-1 in those games.
- Kansas' 10 3-point attempts were its fewest of the season and the fewest by a Jayhawk squad since KU shot eight threes against TCU on March 12, 2015.
- Marcus Garrett and Devon Dotson scored the Jayhawks' final 20 points, all over the final 9:10 of the game. Garrett tallied nine points, and Dotson added the other 11.
- After Texas tied the game at 54-54 with 4:50 to play, Kansas closed the contest on a 12-3 run.
- KU limited the Longhorns to just nine free throw attempts, five of which UT was able to convert. It marked the fourth-straight game a KU opponent has attempted nine or fewer free throws.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Senior Udoka Azubuike

- Scored eight of his 17 points in the opening five minutes of the second half.
- Pulled down nine rebounds, marking the seventh-straight outing he has had seven or more boards. He is averaging 10.9 rebounds per game in that span.
- Tallied one block, and has now posted at least one rejection in Has now had a block in 12 of his 17 outings this season.

Sophomore Devon Dotson

- Hit the 20-point plateau for the fifth time this season.
- Went 8-of-9 from the free throw line. It marked the fourth time this season he has connected on eight or more charities.

Junior Marcus Garrett

- Led the team with a career-high-tying seven assists. He is averaging five assists per game in his five Big 12 outings this season.
