Team Notes

- Kansas drop to 11-3 overall and 0-3 in Big 12 play while TCU improves to 11-3, 2-1 on the season.
- KU went with the same starting five of Thomas, Mitchell, Franklin, De Carvalho and Helgren. With that lineup the Jayhawks are 11-3.
- Kansas' biggest lead came early in the first quarter with a three-point advantage.
- KU outscored TCU in the third quarter, 16-14, ending the quarter down by three, 51-48.
- The bench produced 16 points, which all came for from freshman guard Holly Kersgieter. TCU notched seven.
- Kansas edged TCU by four in points for the paint, 28-24.
- KU had four score in double-figures, Mitchell (16), Kersgieter (16), Thomas (14) and Franklin (11).
- The battle of the boards was a deadlock with both team producing 35 each.

Individual Notes

Freshman Guard Holly Kersgieter

- Kersgieter's 16 points tied for the most for Kansas as she shot 5-of-8 (38.5%) from the field.
- Shooting 4-of-8 (50.0%) from the three-point line, Kersgieter has made at least four threes on three separate occasions.

Sophomore Guard Brooklyn Mitchell

- Mitchell was the co-leader in scoring finishing with 16 points on 7-of-11 (63.6%) shooting from the field.
- She also went 2-of-3 (66.7%) from beyond the arc.

Sophomore Guard Aniya Thomas

- Finished with 14 points, which marks Thomas' ninth game scoring in double-digits.

Freshman Guard Zakiyah Franklin

- Franklin scored 11 points on 5-of-12 (41.7%) shooting from the field.
- Led the team in assists finishing with six, which ties her career-high.
- Led the team in steals coming away with three.
