Team Notes

- Kansas improves to 12-4 overall and 1-4 in league play, while Texas Tech also drops to 12-4 on the year and 1-4 in the league.
- Kansas breaks Texas Tech's three-game win streak over KU as Kansas adds one to the win column.
- KU recorded 10 steals, the most in Big 12 play. TTU recorded seven.
- The Jayhawk won each quarter against the Lady Raiders.
- KU is now 11-3 when opponents shoot 49% or less. Kansas held Texas to 29.5% shooting overall.
- Kansas outscored the Lady Raider in four speciality stats: 34-20 points in the paint; 13-6 points off TOs, 12-5 fast breaks points and 24-14 bench production.
- Kansas will play the first of its two-road game stint against Texas inside the Frank Erwin Center in Austin, Texas, on Wednesday, Jan. 22, at 7 p.m.

Individual Notes

Senior Foward Mariane De Carvalho

- De Carvlho has started her 16th game this season, KU is 12-4 with her as a starter.
- Led KU with a game-high 16 points on 6-of-14 (42.8%) shooting.
- De Carvalho posted her eighth game scoring 10+ points and fourth game leading KU in scoring.
- De Carvalho record her third charge drawn of this season.

Junior Foward Tina Stephens

- Back from a two-game hiatus (due to injury), Stephens poured in 14 points on 60% (6-of-10) shooting.
- Stephens has scored 10+ point in seven contests.
- On the night, Stephen was a +12 with her effort on the court.
- Stephen remains in league with KU's top scorers as she is averaging double figue points, 10.5 ppg.
