Team Notes

Kansas' all-time record goes to 588-654-58.

Offensive Notes

- Wide receiver Ezra Naylor II recorded his first stats of the season with a 12-yard catch in the second quarter. Naylor finished with four catches for 40 yards.
- Sophomore tight end Mason Fairchild made his first catch of the season in the second quarter for 27 yards, the longest reception
 of his career. His previous long of 23 yards came in 2019.
- Fairchild set a career high in catches with two and yards with 38. His previous best of one came twice in 2019, most recently at TCU.
- Freshman quarterback Jalon Daniels scored the first touchdown of his Kansas career with an eight-yard rush in the second quarter. The touchdown was the fifth of the season for the Jayhawks.
- Freshman quarterback Jalon Daniels started his third-career game on Saturday, throwing for a career high 207 yards on 22-of-39 passing.
- Daniels also rushed for a career-high 27 yards on 17 carries.
- Wide receiver Kwamie Lassiter II led the Jayhawks in receptions on Saturday, recording seven catches for 58 yards. Six of the senior's catches came in the first half alone.
- In the fourth quarter, senior wide receiver Kameron McQueen recorded his first-career reception for a gain of seven yards.
- Luke Grimm, a true freshman wide receiver for the Jayhawks, made the first catch of his Kansas career in the fourth quarter, good for 28 yards.
- Freshman wide receiver Steven McBride had three receptions for 17 yards, with a long catch of the day being for seven yards. His
 previous career high was one catch at West Virginia last season.
- Velton Gardner carried the ball 16 times for the Jayhawks, a new career best, surpassing his 14 rushes earlier this season at Baylor. He was the leading rusher for Kansas on the afternoon, accumulating 72 yards.

Defensive Notes

- Redshirt freshman Steven Parker recorded his first tackle for loss of his Kansas career on Saturday. Parker set a new career high with five tackles, with his previous high of four coming against Oklahoma State this season.
- · Redshirt freshman Marcus Harris recorded 2.5 tackles for loss, after recording his career high of 3.0 last week at West Virginia.
- Senior defensive tackle Sam Burt was credited with 0.5 tackle for loss in the third quarter, marking his first tackle for loss of the season.
- · Senior linebacker Kyron Johnson's sack in the fourth quarter was his first since last season, and his fourth-career sack.
- Johnson and Kenny Logan Jr., led the defense with six total tackles each. Logan's season total of 40 tackles leads the team.
- · Johnson registered a career-high 2.0 tackles for loss on Saturday, surpassing his high of 1.0, which he had set eight times.
- Duece Mayberry was credited with a fumble recovery, his second in as many games.

Special Teams Notes

- Donovan Gagen registered his first punt of the season in the first quarter of Saturday's contest, punting 32 yards. Gagen punted three times for 110 yards in the game.
- Freshman Reis Vernon punted for the first time of his college career, registering a 32-yard punt in the second quarter.
- In the third quarter, Jalon Daniels recorded the first punt of his career, picking up 34 yards.
