- Kansas' all-time record goes to 588-653-58.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Senior receiver Andrew Parchment finished with six catches for 65 yards and a touchdown. Parchment now has at least one catch in all 16 of his career games. Parchment has 11 catches for 197 yards and three touchdowns in two career games against West Virginia.
- Jacob Borcila connected on a 41-yard field goal on the first drive of the game. It marked the second straight road game Kansas has scored on its opening possession.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Kansas collected 10 pass breakups Saturday. The 10 pass breakups are the most in a game by the Jayhawks since they had 14 against Iowa State in 2014.
- The 10 pass breakups also tie Boston College for the most in a game this season nationally.
- Elijah Jones (3), Ricky Thomas (2) and Karon Prunty (2) all registered new career highs in pass breakups.
- The Jayhawks finished with a season-high 11 tackles-for-loss Saturday. It marks their highest total since collecting nine last season against Coastal Carolina. It's the team's highest total in a conference game since posting 10 TFLs at West Virginia in 2018.
- Dru Prox registered a new career high in TFLs with three.
- Redshirt freshman defensive lineman Marcus Harris had three TFLs Saturday, marking the first three TFLs of his career. He has played in six career games.
- Senior safety Ricky Thomas collected a career-high six tackles Saturday. His previous best was four.
- Not only did Elijah Jones set a career high in pass breakups, he also had 11/2 tackles-for-loss, establishing a new career best.
- Junior defensive lineman Marcus Lee picked off the first pass of the season for Kansas and the first of his career.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Pooka Williams Jr., had a 92-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the fourth quarter. It marked the first kick return for a touchdown by a Jayhawk since 2016 when Laquionte Gonzalez had a 99-yard kick return for a score against Ohio.
- Redshirt freshman Jacob Borcila had a 41-yard field goal in the first quarter. It marked his third career field goal and second-longest. He is 3-of-4 on the season now.
