First time starters at KU

- Offense: Luke Grimm

Team Notes

- Kansas' all-time record goes to 588-656-58.
- Oklahoma won the coin toss and deferred to the second half. KU received the opening kickoff.

Offensive Notes

- Luke Grimm forced the first fumble of his career on the Oklahoma INT return. Earl Bostick Jr., recovered the fumble for Kansas, his first fumble recovery.
- Grimm's forced fumble was the first by an offensive player since Josh Ford, a wide receiver, forced a fumble against Rice (9-8-2012).
- Grimm set a career high with 61-receiving yards, besting his 53-yard performance vs. Iowa State on four receptions, while adding two rushing attempts for 12 yards.
- In the third quarter, freshman Daniel Hishaw Jr., recorded a 47-yard rush, which was a career-long for him. It was the second-longest rush by a Jayhawk this season and the longest rush that didn't result in a touchdown.
- Hishaw also set new career highs in rushing yards (73) and attempts (10). His previous bests were six rushes (accomplished on two occasions) and 51 yards.
- Amauri Pesek-Hickson tallied career-highs in rushing attempts (10) and rushing yards (43).
- Will Huggins scored his first career touchdown on a 20-yard pass from Miles Kendrick as time expired.

Defensive Notes

- Kyron Johnson recorded his fifth-career sack in the first quarter, taking down Oklahoma quarterback Spencer Rattler for a loss of four yards. Johnson recorded his second sack of the day and sixth in his career in the second quarter for a loss of nine yards.
- Johnson also forced a fumble on his first quarter sack, his fourth forced fumble of his career and first since last season against West Virginia.
- Johnson's 24 sack yards this season are more than any Jayhawks from last season's team. Johnson's nine-yard sack in the second quarter topped both Azur Kamara (3.5-22) and Dru Prox (2.0-22) 2019 totals.
- Johnson is the first Jayhawk since Daniel Wise to record two sacks in a game. Wise completed the feat at West Virginia (10-6-2018).
- Johnson also collected seven total tackles (four of the solo variety) against the Sooners, which was a new season high. His previous high of six had occurred twice: at Baylor and at K-State).
- Kenny Logan Jr., intercepted an OU pass in the first quarter, his second INT in as many games.
- With his interceptions in back-to-back games, Logan becomes the first to accomplish such a feat since 2018, when Shakial Taylor recorded interceptions in consecutive games against Texas (11-17-2018) and Oklahoma (11-23-18).
- With the forced fumble by Kyron Johnson and interception by Kenny Logan Jr., it marks the second time this season Kansas has a forced fumble and an interception in the same game. KU completed the same feat against West Virginia.
- The Jayhawks recorded two forced fumbles in a game since playing at Boston College (9-3-2019).
- Nate Betts set season and career highs in tackles against the Sooners with eight (three solo). His previous high came against Oklahoma State earlier this season (10-3-20), when he tallied six tackles.
- Caleb Taylor made his first appearance and recorded his first stats as a Jayhawk, collecting two total tackles.
- Ricky Thomas tallied a new career-high eight tackles against Oklahoma, surpassing his previous high of seven, which he set at West Virginia (10-17-20) and vs. Iowa State (10-31-20). Thomas also tied a career-high four solo tackles, duplicating the mark he set at West Virginia this season.
- Karon Prunty recorded his first-career tackle-for-loss (TFL) against the Sooners in the third quarter. In addition, he broke up two passes thrown by the OU quarterbacks.
- Steven Parker matched his season and career-best five tackles (initially set at K-State, 10-24-20) as well as TFLs, with 1.0 for the third-consecutive game.

Special Teams Notes

- Jacob Borcila made a 32-yard field goal to end the first half of play, making the score 3-31 in favor of the Sooners. The successful attempt tied his career high of FG made in a game, set on three previous occasions, most recently at West Virginia (10-17-20).
- Kyler Pearson tied a season-high two kick return attempts and set a new single-game high with 36 return yards.
- Kenny Logan Jr., recorded a career-high five kick returns, topping his previous career-high four returns against Baylor (11-30-19).
- Reis Vernon set new career marks in punts (9) and punt yards (331), besting his five kick and 258 yard performance vs. Iowa State (10-31-20). Vernon also tallied five punts at Kansas State (10-24-20).
