KANSAS' WIN...

- Made Kansas 3-1 in the 2020-21 season
- Improved KU to 3-0 in Allen Fieldhouse in the 2020-21 season
- Made Schneider to 57-98 while at KU, 458-236 overall
- Made Kansas 840-667 all-time
- Made Kansas 15-1 over Oral Roberts in the series history. Oral Roberts last victory over Kansas was five years ago on Dec. 22, 2015 when the Golden Eagles defeated the Jayhawks, 63-70.
- Made Kansas 3-1 or better for the 3rd straight season beginning in 2017-18

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas outscored ORU 39-3 in the second quarter, shooting 81% (71.4% from 3), forcing ORU to use three of their four timeouts.
- 39 points is the highest points KU has scored in a quarter this season.
- KU held ORU scoreless in the second quarter until Ariel Walker made a FT for ORU making the score 51-20 with 1:52 left in the half.
- KU scored 60 points in the first half, scoring more than 50 points in a half for the first time since 11/22/17 against Delaware.
- KU only had 1 turnover in the second quarter.
- The Jayhawks only trailed 0:51 in the game, which all came in the first quarter.
- The Jayhawks had 21 assists in the game, making this their first game KU had 20 or more assists since 12/30/19 against Wofford when KU had 23 assists.
- The Jayhawks had 66 rebounds in the game, making this their first game KU had 60 or more rebounds since 12/8/93 vs Morgan State when KU had 70 rebounds.
- KU had 6 players score in double-figures (Stephens with 14, Thomas with 13, Chatzileonti with 11, Kersgieter with 12, Vuksic with 13, and Brosseau with 25), the last time KU had 6 players score in double figures was 12/28/11 against Sam Houston State.
- KU scored 37 field goals, making this their first game KU had 30 or more field goals since 2/2/20 against Oklahoma when KU made 30 field goals.
- KU scored 100 points, making this their first game KU scored 100 points since KU scored 105 against Texas Southern on 12/12/13.
- The Jayhawks had 0 turnovers in the 3rd quarter.
- KU's largest lead today was 54 points.
- KU scored more points in the first half (60) than ORU did in the entire game (59).

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Junior Brooklyn Mitchell has her first start of the season, putting up 5 points overall and going 2-for-6 on the court.
- Senior Tina Stephens puts up 14 points, a season high, making this her third game this season scoring double figures. Stephens reeled in 5 rebounds and shot 6-of-10 from the court.
- Freshman Mia Vuksic had a career scoring high with 13 points overall and going 5-of-7 on the court.
- Graduate Transfer Julie Brosseau led the team and had her season high in scoring with 25 points, going 7-of-14 on the court and 8-for-8 in free throws.
- Freshman Ioanna Chatzileonti had her first career double-double with 11 points and 14 rebounds.
- Sophomore Zakayah Franklin had a career high of 11 assists.
