KANSAS' LOSS...

- Make Kansas 10-3 overall, its first 10-3 record since the 2013-14 season when KU was 9-4.
- End Kansas' 11-game Big 12 record-tying conference road winning streak.
- Make KU 4-2 in games not played in Allen Fieldhouse this season, including 2-1 in true road games.
- End Kansas' five-game winning streak against Oklahoma State, making the all-time series 118-60 in favor of KU.
- Tie the series meetings in Gallagher-Iba Arena at 36-36.
- Make Self 511-112 while at Kansas, 718-217 all-time and 22-14 against Oklahoma State, 21-11 while at KU.
- Make Kansas 2,312-865 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas is now 7-1 this season and 15-1 for his career when Ochai Agbaji makes three or more 3FGs in a game. Agbaji finished 4-of-9 from beyond the arc on Tuesday.
- The Jayhawks fell behind to their largest halftime deficit of the season, trailing 35-46 at the break. Kansas' biggest halftime deficit was against Texas (29-37) and Gonzaga (46-54).

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Kansas junior Ochai Agbaji registered his 60th career start on Tuesday, all of which are consecutive. Agbaji has started all 13 games this season.
- Agbaji registered his 34th career game in double figures, scoring 14 points. Agbaji's output marked his 12th game this season in double figures.
- Freshman Bryce Thompson made his first appearance after missing the last three games. Thompson finished with two points in 13 minutes.
- Junior forward David McCormack registered his third double-double and fourth of his career on Tuesday, scoring a season-high 24 points while recording 12 rebounds. McCormack also registered double-doubles against West Virginia and Omaha this season.
- McCormack's 24 points mark his seventh game in double figures this season. It was his third-straight game with 10+ points and his second game with 20+ points this season.
- McCormack pulled down five rebounds in the first half alone in Stillwater. McCormack finished with 12 total rebounds. It marked his ninth game this season with five or more rebounds in a game and his third game with 10+ boards in a single contest.
- McCormack blocked three Cowboys' shots on the night, setting a new season high and tying his career high, previously set vs. Texas Tech (2/1/2020).
- Senior Marcus Garrett scored 12 points, marking his fourth double digit scoring effort this season, with three of those coming against Big 12 opponents. Garrett's output marked his 18th career double-digit scoring effort.
