KANSAS' LOSS...

- Made Kansas 10-5 overall, its first 10-5 record since the 2005-06 season when KU was also 10-5.
- Made Kansas 4-4 in league play for the first time since the 1987-88 season when KU was 3-5 in its first eight Big Eight contests.
- Gave KU three-consecutive league losses for the first time since losing three straight in the 2012-13 season (2/19/13 at OU, 2/6/13 at TCU and 2/2/13 vs. OSU).
- Made KU 2-3 in true road games this season and 4-4 in games not played in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Made the Kansas-Oklahoma series 151-69 in favor of KU, including 53-45 in games played in Norman as well as 20-20 in the Lloyd Noble Center.
- Made Bill Self 511-114 while at Kansas, 718-219 all-time and 23-8 against Oklahoma, 23-6 while at KU.
- Made Kansas 2,312-867 all-time.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Today marked junior Ochai Agbaji's 62nd-straight start as a Kansas Jayhawk.
- Redshirt-freshman Jalen Wilson scored eight of Kansas' first 11 points, starting the day shooting 4-for-4, 2-for-2 from 3-point range.
- Wilson recorded his 10th game in double-digits this season, finishing the game with 13 points.
- With his 10 points at halftime, senior Marcus Garrett scored in double-digits for the fifth time this season, 29th in his career. Garrett finished the game with 21 points, his second-best outing of the season. He was just a point shy of his season-high 22 points vs. Gonzaga (11/26) in the season-opener, and three short of his career-best 24 points.
- Today was Garrett's third game this season making multiple 3FGs (2 vs. Gonzaga on 11/26 and 3 vs. WVU on 12/22).
- Garrett also pulled down 12 boards, earning this second double-double this season, third of his career. It marked his seventh game this season with 5+ boards and second with 10+ rebounds, fifth of his career.
- Garrett's 12 rebounds all came on the defensive end of the court, which set a new season high for the Jayhawks. The last time a Jayhawk pulled down 12 defensive rebounds was Udoka Azubuike against Baylor on February 20, 2020.
- David McCormack set a season high and tied his career high with four assists.
- Junior Ochai Agbaji continues to make progress toward cracking the top 20 in most 3-point field goal attempts and in most 3-point field goals made in Kansas history, shooting 2-for-6 from 3FG today. He has 110 career threes made, which is 27 from the top 20 and 306 threes attempted.
- Agbaji scored 10 points, marking his 14th game this season scoring in double figures and the 26th of his career.
- Redshirt-freshman Dajuan Harris Jr., made his third 3-pointer this season at the 4:23 mark of the second half. Harris finished the game with five points, which is his second-best output this season. He set his season/career high of seven points at TCU (1/5).
