KANSAS' LOSS...

- Made Kansas 12-7 overall and 6-5 in Big 12 play.
- Made KU 4-5 against ranked foes this season.
- Ended a five-game winning streak against West Virginia and made the all-time series 15-6 in favor of KU.
- Made Bill Self 513-116 while at Kansas, 720-221 all-time and 15-6 against West Virginia, all while at KU.
- Made Kansas 2,314-869 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- The lineup of Marcus Garrett, Christian Braun, Jalen Willson, Ochai Agbaji and David McCormack started for the 16th time this season on Saturday.
- Five Jayhawks scored in double figures on Saturday, marking the third time this season KU has had five players with 10+ points. Kansas is 2-1 in those games.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Kansas junior David McCormack started his 50th career game on Saturday, including his 19th start this season.
- Senior Marcus Garrett notched his seventh game of the season with 10+ points, including his 31st of his career, scoring 18 points on 7-of-14 from the field on Saturday.
- Sophomore Christian Braun scored 11 points, registered his 12th career double digit scoring performance and his seventh this year.
- Junior David McCormack's 17 points marks his 24th career game with 10+ points, including his 11th of the season and fourth straight.
- Junior Ochai Agbaji tallied 13 points on 5-of-11 from the field, marking his 39th career double digit game in double figures and his 17th of the season. Agbaji has scored in double figures in 13 of his last 14 games.
- Agbaji connected on 3-of-6 from beyond the arc, marking his 10th game this season and 18th of his career with three or more 3-pointers in a game.
- Redshirt freshman Jalen Wilson scored 16 points on Saturday, marking his 13th career game in double figures. Paired with 14 rebounds, Saturday also marked Wilson's fourth career double-double. Wilson's career high of 15 rebounds came against North Dakota State on Dec. 5, 2020.
- Senior Mitch Lightfoot drew his eighth charge of the season on Saturday, which leads the team.
