

GAMBLING AND SPORTS WAGERING

- Gambling is the act of wagering anything of value (e.g., money, a free meal, free services, receiving a trophy, etc.) on the outcome of a sporting event
 - You cannot gamble on any sport that an NCAA institution sponsors regardless if the event/sport is being played on the professional, collegiate, or amateur level
- Gambling activities to avoid:
 - Bets with friends or bookies
 - Fantasy leagues (Including daily fantasy)
 - Online pools & contests



- A student-athlete or institutional staff member that engages in any activity to influence the outcome of a contest will be permanently ineligible for intercollegiate competition or terminated
 - This includes any point shaving or manipulation of competition or competition related scores
