Team Notes

- Kansas' all-time record goes to 589-662-58.
- Kansas won the coin toss and deferred to the second half. Texas Tech elected to receive the opening kickoff.
- Head coach Lance Leipold moved to 1-5 with the Jayhawks, and 147-44 in his career.
- Kansas falls to 1-11 against Texas Tech in games played in Lawrence, while Tech holds the all-time series advantage at 21-2.

Offensive Notes

- Freshman running back Devin Neal recorded his first-career reception on Saturday, on a 7-yard pass play from quarterback Jason Bean.
- Luke Grimm recorded a 14 yard touchdown in the fourth quarter, his first touchdown of the year and third of his career.
- Lawrence Arnold recorded a 13 yard touchdown on a pass from Miles Kendrick, marking Arnold's third touchdown of the year and fourth of his career.
- Super-Senior Miles Kendrick finished the day with two touchdowns.

Defensive Notes

- Safety Kenny Logan Jr., recorded his first interception of the season, his third career interception. Logan returned the interception for 22 yards.
- In the fourth quarter, Ra'Mello Dotson forced a Texas Tech fumble, recovered by Edwin White-Schultz. Kansas has forced a fumble in every game this year.
- Rich Miller led the team with seven tackles on Saturday, the second game this season he led the team in the category.

Special Teams Notes

- Jamahl Horne's 26-yard kick return to start the second half was a season long.
