SERIES INFO: Kansas leads, 22-3 (10-0 exhibition)

KANSAS' WIN...

- Improved Kansas to 91-9 all-time in exhibition games.
- Extended KU's home exhibition winning streak to 53 games dating back to the 1994 season.
- Gave Kansas its 32nd-consecutive exhibition victory.
- Improved Kansas head coach Bill Self to 59-2 in exhibition play while at KU, including 35-0 in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Made KU 64-5 in exhibition games in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Was the 13th straight victory against Emporia State dating back to 1992, with all of those being played in Allen Fieldhouse.

TEAM NOTES

- The Jayhawks shot a perfect 11-of-11 (100%) from the free throw line.
- Four Jayhawks finished in double figures (Agbaji - 17, McCormack - 16, Martin - 15, Braun - 10).
- Kansas held a 45-34 advantage on rebounds, with 10 of them coming on the offensive glass.
- The Jayhawks scored 37 points off the bench and had a +23 margin in bench points.
- Kansas ended the first half on a 16-3 run over the final 5:06.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Junior Ochai Agbaji scored a team-high 17 points, including a 71.4% (5-of-7) clip from beyond the arc in 23 minutes of action.
- Senior David McCormack finished with 16 points on 5-of-8 (62.5%) shooting and a game-high eight rebounds in 15 minutes.
