KANSAS' WIN...

- Made KU 4-1 or better in Big 12 play for the 16th-straight season, beginning in 2006-07.
- Made Self 744-225 all-time, including 537-120 while at Kansas.
- Made Kansas 2,338-873 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas shot 47.1 percent (8-of-17) from beyond the arc, a season-best on the road this season.
- Kansas grabbed 11 offensive rebounds on Tuesday. KU has secured 10+ offensive rebounds in 11 games this season, including five of the last six contests.
- Kansas held a 34-32 advantage at the half. Kansas is 13-1 when leading at the half this season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Redshirt-sophomore Jalen Wilson had game highs of 16 points (6-of-10 shooting) and eight rebounds, along with two assists in 35 minutes. Wilson has scored in double figures in four games this season, including three of the last four contests.
- Junior Christian Braun hit the go-ahead three-pointer with 10.9 seconds remaining to give the Jayhawks a 65-62 lead. Braun finished with 15 points on 5-of-8 (62.5 percent) shooting (3-5 3FG) and four rebounds in 33 minutes.
- Senior Ochai Agbaji contributed 10 points and five rebounds in 32 minutes of action. He now has 1,259 career points which puts him at 35th on the all-time KU scoring list.
- Agbaji started his 94th consecutive game and has now played in 100 games at KU. He is eighth on the all-time list for consecutive starts at KU. His 200 career three-point field goals put him in a tie for eighth on the all-time KU list with Terry Brown.
- Super-senior Mitch Lightfoot added nine points on 4-of-5 (80.0 percent) shooting and a season-high-tying six rebounds in 14 minutes off the bench.
