KANSAS' LOSS...

- Dropped its record to 4-3 in games against AP ranked opponents this season.
- Made Self 748-227 all-time, including 541-122 while at Kansas.
- Made Kansas 2,342-875 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas shot 58.3 percent (28-of-48) from the field at Texas. That is the highest shooting percentage on the road since KU shot 64.0 percent (32-of-50) at #23 Texas on Feb. 29, 2016. The Jayhawks have shot 50.0 percent or better in 12 games this season.
- Kansas had four players finish in double figures for the third time in conference play this season (Wilson - 18, McCormack - 16, Braun - 13, Agbaji - 11).

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Redshirt-sophomore Jalen Wilson recorded his second double-double of the season with a team-high 18 points on 6-of-10 (60.0 percent) shooting, a team-high 11 rebounds and two assists in 32 minutes. Wilson has scored in double figures eight times this season, including on six occasions in the last eight games.
- Senior David McCormack contributed 16 points on 6-of-10 (60.0 percent), seven rebounds and two blocks in 30 minutes of action.
- Junior Christian Braun had 13 points on 5-of-8 (62.5 percent) shooting in 33 minutes.
- Senior Ochai Agbaji posted 11 points and six rebounds in 38 minutes. He now has 1,367 career points which puts him at 30th on the all-time KU scoring list. His 214 career three-point field goals have him at seventh on the all-time KU list.
