FIRST PITCH

- >> The Privateers participated in the Andre Dawson Classic for the fifth time in seven seasons of Blake Dean's tenure. Under Dean, the Privateers are 12-3 in the Classic. The offfense in those games has been especially effective, scoring 10+ runs in six of those wins.
- >> For the first time in the Blake Dean era, the Privateers had backto-back run rule victories against Grambling and Alabama State. The five runs allowed was the fewest in a weekend since the then named MLB Urban Youth Invitational in 2017.
- >> New Orleans was selected to finish third in the Southland Conference which is their highest preseason projected order of finish since joining the conference in 2014. The Privateers were the 2-seed in last year's conference tournament and had the best record of remaining Southland teams.
- >> Six pitchers return who threw at least 25 innings last season. Among them are Brandon Mitchell who pitched 71.1 innings last year, second most on the team.
- >> It will be a new look offense in 2022 for the Privateers after five starters graduated off of last year's team. New Orleans is projected to have newcomers in at least four different positions, mostly on the infield.
- >> The Privateers had six all-conference selections at the end of the 2021 season. It was the most postseason all-conference picks for a Privateers squad since the last team to make an NCAA Regional (2008).
- >> After the first weekend, the Privateers were the only team in the Southland Conference without a loss to their name. The pitching staff posted a 1.88 ERA while the lineup hit .337 over the opening weekend.

NEW ORLEANS BASEBALL **NEWS & NOTES**

>> Pearce Howard is on the brink of breaking into the top 10 in a multitude of categories in program history. Howard is one double, five home runs and six RBI away from moving into the top 10 in those respective categories.

LENGTHENING STRIDE

>> Brandon Mitchell began to eat up innings on a consistent basis in the final month of the 2021 season. In a stretch of seven starts from Apr. 1 to May 15, 2021, Mitchell went at least 6.0 innings in five of those starts with a career-long 8.1 innings against UIW. Mitchell threw 71.1 innings, second-most on the team last year.

WINNING THE HIT COLUMN

The Privateers were 22-2 last season when they out-hit their opponents last year. New Orleans was fourth in the 13-team Soutlhand last year in total hits with 499. In conference-only games, the Privateers were first in the league in hits.

>> Dax Norris and Ryan Fineman are new to the coaching staff as pitching coach and volunteer assistant. Norris most recently spent byears at FIU and the Golden Panthers led Conference-USA in ERA in 2019. Fineman was a four-year starter as a catcher at Indiana and played in 206 games.

INSTANT IMPACT

>> Anthony Herron Jr. has already been tabbed by the Southland Conference and Perfect Game for their preseason all-conference teams. In addition, Herron was named to the Preseason Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award Watch List along with his teammate, Pearce Howard.

FRESHMEN NO MORE

Three Privateers who were true freshmen that got significant playing time last year are expected to feature again in 2022. Travis Gober hit .343 with runners in scoring position while playing mostly first base. Issac Williams had 7 of his 12 RBI with two outs. Tyler LeBlanc had nine starts in 2021 and recorded 23 strikeouts in 291 innings.

BY THE DOZEN

> New Orleans will play series against two Big 12 opponents this year when they face Kansas and Oklahoma. In Coach Dean's tenure, the Privateers have played series against 3 Power 5 opponents: Texas, Michigan State and Pittsburgh. The Privateers are 6-6 in 12 games combined against those opponents. New Orleans is 14-34 all-time against current Big 12 members.

WORLD CHAMPS

New Orleans alum, Brian Snitker guided the Atlanta Braves to the World Series in 2021. Snitker became the first Privateer student-athlete to win a World Series as a manager. Randy Bush has also won World Series rings as a player (Minnesota Twins) and as an executive (Chicago Cubs).

TRAIL BLAZER

>> Megan Steinmetz also joined the staff as the program's new Director of Operations during the summer of 2021. Steinmetz, at the time of her hiring, was 1 of just 8 female baseball operations directors at Division I institutions.

KNOCK KNOCK KNOCKING ON THE MLB DOOR>> Eric Orze catapulted through the minor league ranks in his first professional season in 2021. Orze started the year in the Mets organization at Single-A Brooklyn and moved all the way up to Triple-A Syracuse by the end of the minor league season. Orze is attempting to become the first Privateer to make it to the Majors started before Computable (in the respect of in ML B) and 2017 with since Johnny Giavotella (last appeared in MLB in 2017 with

>> Jorge Tejeda has been erasing base runners who have threatened to steal while he's behind the plate. Last season, Tejeda erased nearly 36 percent of base runners attempting to steal (5 runners caught in 14 attempts). In the COVID-shortened 2020, Tejeda threw out posely 24 percent of runners attempting to extend the covid attempting to th out nearly 34 percent of runners attempting to steal.

FEELING A DRAFT

>> Eric Orze's selection marked the fourth consecutive year a Privateer was drafted. The draft picks in the Blake Dean era have all been pitchers. Orze was selected in the fifth round last summer by the Mets. Shawn Semple (2017-Yankees), Bryan Warzek (2018-Dodgers), and Reeves Martin (2019-Mariners) were also selected.

BIOGRAPHY

Blake Dean has completed six seasons as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. In that span, he is 162-147-1. Dean picked up his 100th win against Louisiana on Mar. 12, 2019.

In 2021, Dean's crew had six all-conference members in the postseason, tied for the most since 2008. Pearce Howard also earned All-LSWA honors and New Orleans had their highest seed in the Soutlhand Tournament (#2).

The Privateers started getting hot in 2020, winning 11 of 14 games before the season was shut down due to the coronavirus pandemic. New Orleans swept Arkansas State in that span, won series against UConn and Nicholls, and defeated Tulane in the first game of the Pelican Cup.

That did not stop the streak Dean has been on in helping to produce draft picks. Eric Orze was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 Draft by the New York Mets. That marked the fourth consecutive year a Privateer

has been drafted

In 2019, Reeves Martin had an All-American season under Dean and was named as such in three publications (Collegiate Baseball Foundation, NCBWA, Collegiate Baseball). Martin continued the trend of pitchers getting drafted after being selected in the 21st round by Seattle.

The Privateers won the Pelican Cup from Tulane for a second consecutive year in '19 and swept the Green Wave in the three-game series. It was only the second time in school history New Orleans swept a season series of at least three games against Tulane

2019 also saw the Privateers produce a Rawlings/ABCA Gold Glove winner in Salo Iza. The Privateers had two other all-conference mentions: Gaige Howard (third team) and Collin Morrill (honorable mention).

In 2018, the Privateers advanced to the championship game of the 2018 Southland Tournament as the No. 8 seed, defeating No. 1 Sam Houston State University and No. 4 Houston Baptist University (twice) to get there. The pitching staff, anchored by junior Bryan Warzek, finished 21stin the nation with 9.4 strikeouts per nine innings. Warzek was drafted in the sixth round of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft by the Los Angeles Dodgers after earning Southland Conference First Team, ABCA and All-LSWA honors. The inaugural revised Pelican Cup went to the Privateers after New Orleans took the season series over Tulane University 2-1.

Following that season, Dean received a two-year contract extension to remain on the Lakefront.

Dean was named the University of New Orleans' seventh head coach in its 45 year history during the summer of 2015 following a brief stint as the school's interim head coach following the retirement of Ron Maestri. In his first season at the helm, UNO saw a 17-game turnaround, the eighth-best in Division I in 2016, while the team was one of 17 to increase their winning percentage by .200, boasting the fourth-highest improvement at .285.

The Privateers' 31-26 record marked the first winning record for the baseball program since 2008 and qualified for the Southland Conference for the first time since joining the league prior to the 2013-14 academic year. The Privateers set eight-year highs in batting average (300), total hits (600), doubles (77), on base percentage (.368) and fielding percentage (.966) saves (15), strikeouts (400) and the lowest opponent batting average in the span (.286).

Nationally, UNO finished eighth in triples per game with a 0.44 average and 10th in total triples with 25 while Dakota Dean cracked the top 25 individually with six on the season, the 22nd-most.

UNO's resurrected offense led the Southland Conference in triples, while finishing second in in hits, batting average, third in RBI, fewest batters struck out (328) and fourth in slugging percentage (.416).

Under Dean's guidance, five Privateers were named to All-Southland Conference Teams with Hezekiah Randolph, a first team honoree after finishing in the top 10 of the conference in runs scored (49), runs batted in (45), doubles (16) hits (71) and slugging percentage (,502), garnered America Baseball Coaches Association/Rawlings South Central Region second team distinction, Kyle Bracey(first team), Dakota Dean(second team), Aaron Palmer(second team) and Daniel Martinez(honorable mention) all gained recognition from the league.

The Privateers took on the top Louisiana programs in the country during the 2016 campaign taking two from eventual NCAA Tournament participant Southeastern in their regular season series before dropping a decision to the Lions in the Southland Conference Tournament while splitting a two-game series with Tulane and besting Louisiana Tech, both qualifying for the national tournament.

Following two years working under the legendary Ron Maestri, Dean was initially tabbed the interim head coach before officially becoming the Privateers' seventh head coach on June 30, 2015. Prior to assuming his current position, Dean worked his way up the ladder starting as a volunteer assistant in 2014 before being promoted to a full-time position the following year.

During his time on the Lakefront, Dean was instrumental in Samuel Capielanoand Randolph claiming Freshman All-America status in 2014 while helping several Privateer hitters improve their production at the plate.

As the team's hitting coach in 2015, the Privateers saw their average rise 20 points from the 2014 campaign and three of the five returning position players saw significant increases in their respective batting averages.

Highlights on the diamond, however, are nothing new for Dean as the native of Crestview, Florida, has experienced success at every stop of his baseball career to date

As a prep star at Crestview High, Dean was a four-year all-state honoree and was a member of the USA Baseball Youth National Team. Following his senior season, he claimed Louisville Slugger All-America recognition and was named to Baseball America's Top 300 High School Players of 2006.

From there, he packed his bags for Baton Rouge where he helped LSU post a combined 175 wins, three trips to the NCAA Super Regionals and a pair of berths in the College World Series – including a National Championship in 2009.

As they had done during his high school career, honors came in by the handful for Dean in college. As a rookie, he was named Freshman All-SEC, Louisiana Freshman of the Year and Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American.

One year later, Dean was tabbed first-team All-American by Baseball America, second-team All-South Region by the American Baseball Coaches Association and Louisiana Hitter of the Year by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association. He also claimed SEC Tournament MVP and Baton Rouge Regional Most Outstanding Player recognition during the Tigers' march to Omaha.

Dean claimed first-team All-SEC as a junior and was a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in 2010.

Along the way, he finished second in school history in hits (332), RBI (260) and total bases (575), fourth in home runs (56) and fifth in runs scored

Dean was drafted twice during his time at LSU, going in the 10th round to the Minnesota Twins in 2009 and in the eighth round by the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2010.

He played two seasons professionally in the Dodgers' organization, suiting up in Rookie League for the Ogden Raptors in 2010 and the Class A Great Lakes Loons in 2011 before returning to LSU to finish his degree.

ean completed his bachelor's degree in sports administration from LSU in 2013

After his two years of pro ball, the Crestview, Fla. native spent one season as a volunteer assistant coach at his alma mater where he earned his degree in sports administration before joining the Privateer coaching staff in 2014.
