SERIES HISTORY: KU leads, 17-6

KANSAS' WIN:

- Make Kansas 22-4 overall and 11-2 in Big 12 play
- Gave Kansas 22 wins for the 32nd time in the last 33 seasons dating back to 1989- 90
- Gave Kansas 11 league wins for the 28th-consecutive season, a streak which started in 1995 and is the longest active streak in NCAA Division I
- Made Kansas 10-3 in games not played in Allen Fieldhouse this season and 6-2 in true road games
- Made the Kansas-West Virginia series 17-6 in favor of KU and narrow the meetings in Morgantown to 6-4 in favor of WVU
- Made Bill Self 750-227 all-time, 544-122 while at Kansas and 17-6 all-time against West Virginia (all while at KU)
- Made Kansas 2,345-875 all-time.

TEAM NOTES:

- Kansas led 33-27 at halftime. The Jayhawks improve to 18-1 when leading at the half this season.
- The Jayhawks out-rebounded the Mountaineers, 49-32, marking the second-most rebounds for KU this season. Kansas secured a season-high 50 rebounds against Oklahoma State on January 4.
- Kansas' 38 defensive rebounds marked a new season high. The previous high of 35 was set against Baylor on February 5.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES:

- Senior guard Ochai Agbaji made his 102nd career start on Saturday, all of which were consecutive.
- Super-Senior Jalen Coleman-Lands appeared in his 154th all-time game, which ranks tied for fourth in the NCAA among active players.
- Super-Senior Mitch Lightfoot appeared in his 154th game all-time, which is tied for 11th on the same list. Lightfoot holds the KU school record for most games played, previously held by Danny Manning (147, 1985-88).
- Agbaji scored 23 points on 8-of-15 from the field, scoring in double-figures in all 26 games so far this season. He has now scored in double-figures in 71 career games and has scored 20 or more points in 14 game this season and 21 games in his career.
- With his 23 points, Agbaji surpassed 1,400 career points, becoming the 27th player in KU history to accomplish the feat. Agbaji now has 1,421 career points.
- Senior forward David McCormack scored 19 points on 7-of-12 shooting on Saturday, marking his 15th game in double-figures scoring this season. McCormack added 11 rebounds, his seventh of the season with 10 or more. McCormack's performance marked his seventh double-double of the season and the 14th of his career.
- Redshirt sophomore Jalen Wilson scored 10 points, paired with 11 rebounds. marking his third double-double of the season and 12th of his career.
