## Conference Notes

- No. 2 Texas leads four Big I2 teams in the DIBaseball Top 25, along with No. II Oklahoma State, No. I7 Texas Tech and No. 2I TCU.
- Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas hosts the 2022 Phillips 66 Big I2 Baseball Championship, which is slated for May 25-29.
- Texas' Ivan Melendez (.450 avg, I.628 OPS, 4 HR, II RBI) was Big I2 Player of the Week, Texas Tech's Brandon Birdsell (6.0 IP, 0 H, 0 BB, 0 ER, I5 K) was Big I2 Pitcher of the Week and Oklahoma's David Sandlin (8+ IP, 2 H, I ER, I BB, 6 K) was Newcomer of the Week.
- Big I2 Preseason Player of the Year Jace Jung (Texas Tech) leads I9 student-athletes from the Conference who have been picked Preseason All-America. A complete listing is on Page 5.
- Texas was the unanimous favorite to win the Big I2 in a vote of the league's coaches.

  The Longhorns received all eight possible votes, and were followed by Oklahoma State. Texas Tech and TCU.
- Jared McKenzie hit Baylor's first inside-the-park home run since March 19, 2011 when he scampered around the bases March 13 against Columbia.
- Maui Ahuna (Kansas) has reached base in 23 consecutive games, dating back to 2021. He has nine multi-hit games this season.
- Kansas State has homered in seven consecutive games, and nine of its last II games.
- Oklahoma is coming off of a three-game sweep of UTSA March I2-I3. OU's weekend rotation combined to throw 2I.O IP, allowing IO H, 3 ER and I4 K.
- OSU's Justin Campbell, Kale Davis and Trevor Martin combined to rack up 19 strikeouts against BYU March II, falling one shy of the Big I2 record for a nine-inning game.
- TCU had back-to-back walk-off wins during a March I2 doubleheader, marking the first time since 2019 the Horned Frogs walked off consecutive games.
- Texas is 4-0 in games that open a weekend, largely on the strength of Pete Hansen, who leads active Division I starting pitchers with a 1.72 career ERA.
- Texas Tech is a perfect 8-0 at Rip Griffin Park this season, and has the longest active home win streak in the Big I2.
- West Virginia has won four games in the ninth inning or later this season, including walk-off wins against Rider and Ohio State last week.
