### FIRST PITCH

- Kansas will continue its stretch of 15 consecutive games on the road with a three-game series at Indiana State.
  - The Jayhawks are 4-4 through the first eight games.
  - Prior to the cancellation against Cincinnati, the stretch of 16 straight games away from Lawrence would have been tied for the second-longest stretch in program history, since data is available (1925). The longest came in 2019 when the first 24 games were played away from Hogle Ballpark. The other 16-game stretch came during the 1983 season.
- Kansas has drawn 10+ walks in consecutive games for the first time since May 5-6, 2017 vs. Texas Southern. The Jayhawks had 11 walks vs. Michigan State and 10 walks at Missouri State.
- In Sunday's 13-7 win vs. Michigan State in Greenville, S.C., Kansas:
  - Scored a season-high-tying 13 runs (March 9 at Charleston Southern).
  - Drew a season-high 11 walks, its most since March 23, 2021 at Lafayette (14).
  - Struck out a season-low-tying four times (Feb. 20 vs. Illinois).
- SS **Maui Ahuna** ranks 6th in the nation in batting average (.483), tied for 18th in on-base percentage (.559), 24th in slugging percentage (.845), tied for 20th in hits (28), tied for 5th in triples (3) and tied for 32nd in total bases (49).
  - Big 12 Rankings:
    - 1st – batting average (.483), on-base percentage (.559), slugging percentage (.835), triples (3)
    - 2nd – hits (28), total bases (49)
    - T-5th – home runs (3)
    - T-6th – doubles (6)
    - T-8th – RBI (18)
  - Ahuna has nine multi-hit performances through the first 15 games, including five contests with three hits.
  - Ahuna has reached base safely in 24 consecutive games dating back to last season.
  - Career-high 5 RBI on March 13 vs. Michigan State
  - He was named to the Cambria College Classic All-Tournament Team after hitting .600/.667/1.100 (6-for-10), with a 3B, grand slam and 4 RBI.
  - His grand slam on March 6 vs. Illinois was the first by a Jayhawk since Brett Vosik on April 26, 2019 at Furman.

## TEAM NOTES

### ROAD TRIPPIN'

Kansas plays 21 of its first 22 games on the road in 2022. This included an 11-day, 7-game road trip from March 3-13 and a stretch of 17 of 18 days away from Lawrence. KU will play 15 straight games away from home between March 4-March 27. The Jayhawks will play in 10 states this season (Kansas, Colorado, Indiana, Louisiana, Minnesota, Missouri, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Texas and Nebraska).

### MIDWEEK MASH

Kansas completed a two-game midweek series sweep at Charleston Southern on March 8-9. On March 9, the Jayhawks won by a score of 13-1 and hit five home runs in the contest, its most since Feb. 23, 2019 vs. Texas Southern (5).

2B **Tavian Josenberger** and OF **Chase Jans** each hit two home runs in the game. They were the first Kansas duo to have two home runs in the same game since at least 2000. Jans was making his first career start.

Josenberger homered as a righty and a lefty. He was the first Jayhawk with home runs from both sides of the plate since Josh Dimmick vs. Oklahoma State on April 3, 1996.

Jans and Josenberger hit back-to-back home runs in the fifth inning. They were the first pair with back-to-back blasts since James Cosentino and Skyler Messinger at Belmont on Feb. 16, 2020.

### ROLLING ON A 'HIGH'

Redshirt sophomore Ryan Vanderhei is 3-1 this season in his first year in the starting rotation. Vanderhei has recorded a team-high 26 strikeouts and posted a 4.03 ERA. His 26 strikeouts are eighth most in the conference. The Goodyear, Arizona, native struck out a career-high nine batters against Illinois on Feb. 19 and he pitched a career-high 6.1 innings at New Orleans on Feb. 26.

### U-GONE

Redshirt senior **Jonah Ulane** has turned into one of the best closers in the country over the last three seasons. He was selected to the NCBWA Preseason All-America second team on Feb. 1. Ulane finished last season with a 3-0 record, 1.44 ERA and a team-high 11 saves. The 11 saves ranked second in the conference and tied for 12th in the country.

Ulane currently has 25 career saves and ranks fourth on the all-time saves list at KU. The top six career save leaders at KU have all been under the leadership of Ritch Price.

SS **Mau Ahuna** returned for his sophomore season after hitting .314/.413/.422 (58-for-185), with 11 2B, 3 3B, 1 HR, 25 RBI and 33 R in 50 games. Ahuna was named to the Big 12 Championship All-Tournament team a season ago. He also received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

### COUNT ON ME

RHP **Cole Larsen** is the lone KU starter who returned to the rotation in 2022. Larsen typically gets the nod on Fridays. A season ago, Larsen was slotted into the Sunday spot of the rotation.

Larsen finished with a record of 5-5 and a 3.87 ERA last year. He led the team in innings pitched (95.1) and strikeouts (86). Larsen threw two complete games (at Florida Gulf Coast on 2/28/21 and at Omaha 3/13/21) and started for KU in the first round of the Big 12 Championship against West Virginia in 2021.

Larsen has thrown a team-high 23.0 IP through the first three weeks of action.

### LOCAL KID

INF/OF **Tavian Josenberger** was named to the Preseason All-Big 12 team by Perfect Game. Josenberger hit .316 (62-for-196), with 8 2B, 4 3B, 1 HR, 31 RBI and 39 R in 52 games last season. In 2021, he received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention and All-Big 12 Freshman team.

### TELL ME WHERE YOU NEED ME

INF **Dylan Ditzenberger** has been a consistent name in the batting order and around the field since arriving at KU. Ditzenberger has batted in every spot in the order over the last three seasons and has played 1B, 2B, 3B, LF, RF. Last year, he received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention. This season, Ditzenberger is expected to settle into the third base position.

### LOOKING TO MAKE THEIR MARK

C/1B **Nolan Metcalf** and OF **Casey Burnham** return this season after missing a portion of last season due to injuries. Both guys finished with a slugging percentage of .400 or better last season despite the limited action. Metcalf will be returning to his high school position of catcher this season, while Burnham will once again play center field.

Metcalf and Burnham have each started 14 games in 2022 and are both hitting over .300 to begin the season. Metcalf has also been named to the Buster Posey National Collegiate Catcher of the Year Watch List.

**Tavian Josenberger** made his mark on the KU baseball program in his first season. The Kansas City, Missouri, native completed a feat that no other Jayhawk has in program history, rattling off six hits against a Big 12 opponent. Josenberger went 6-for-6 with a double and triple against Oklahoma on April 10, 2021. The six-hit performance tied a program record for hits in a game with current Jayhawk assistant coach Ritchie Price, who belted six hits against Oakland on Feb. 26, 2004.

Josenberger also matched a program record with a 24-game hitting streak from March 23-May 2 last season. Jared Schweitzer accomplished the feat during the 2005 season. Josenberger also reached base safely in 29 straight games last year, the longest reached base streak by a Jayhawk since Connor McKay had a 39-game on-base streak in 2015.

**ABOUT SKIP ...**

Known for being a tireless worker and enthusiastic recruiter, Ritch Price enters his 20th season directing the Kansas baseball program in 2022. Price has instilled an atmosphere of camaraderie and competitiveness within his program during his tenure.

That unprecedented work ethic by the Jayhawks' skipper, since being hired on July 1, 2002, has rewarded the program with three trips to the NCAA Tournament (2006, 2009 and 2014), which is more than the combined number of appearances the program achieved in its first 112 seasons before Price.

The 33rd head baseball coach at Kansas has propelled himself to the top of the record books, becoming the all-time winningest coach in the history of the program on March 4, 2017, with an 11-7 win over Northwestern State. That 439th win on that day broke a record that stood 35 years, nine months and 27 days by legendary head coach Floyd Temple (438).

Entering 2022, Price's 561 wins at Kansas accounted for over 28 percent of the program's 1,981 victories spanning 131 seasons. He enters the 2022 campaign as the longest-tenured coach in the Big 12 Conference and has managed in more league games than any of the other eight head coaches.

In his 19 seasons holding the reins at KU, Price has mentored players to 109 all-conference selections, 147 academic all-conference honorees, 75 professional contracts, two Big 12 Newcomers of the Year (Jordan Piché in 2013 & Ben Krauth in 2015), two All-Americans (Don Cxyz in 2006 & Tony Thompson in 2009) and one National Stopper of the Year (Cxyz in 2006).

**2008 USA BASEBALL NATIONAL TEAM**

• Ritch Price was an assistant coach on the 2008 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team and helped lead the Americans to a perfect 24-0 record during its 2008 tour. The squad won the Harlem Baseball Classic and its third straight FISU World Championship. Price also helped Team USA defeat Cuba twice during the summer, marking the first time an American team accomplished the feat. The 2008 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team is the only group to ever go undefeated.
