KANSAS' WIN...

- Make Kansas 24-6 overall and 13-4 in Big 12 play
- Gives Kansas 24 or more wins in a single season for the 16th time in the Self era, missing 2004-05 (23-7) and 2020-21 (21-9).
- Gives Kansas 13 league wins for the 15th season under Self.
- Make the Kansas-TCU series 22-4 in favor of Kansas and keeps Kansas undefeated against TCU when in Allen Fieldhouse (11-0).
- Make Kansas 14-1 in Allen Fieldhouse this season, 829-116 all-time in the venue, including 291-16 under Self.

TEAM NOTES

- Today's game marks the 26th time that there has been a tie at half during the Self era, Kansas is now 21-5 when tied.
- There have now been 25 games this season when three or more players have scored 10 or more points. Kansas is 20-4 when that happens.
- Kansas was plus-19 on points off turnovers, which is the team's second best mark this season, sitting behind Iona.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior Ochai Agbaji now has made a 3FG in the past 53 games played, adding to the longest active streak in the NCAA D1. Jeff Boschee sits in second place in program history with 36.
- Making two 3FGs, Agbaji now sits at sixth in all-time Kansas history, passing Sherron Collins.
- Agbaji has started in his last 106 games played.
- By stepping onto the court, super-senior Mitch Lightfoot has played in 158 games as a Jayhawk, the most in Kansas history. Danny Manning (1985-88) sits in second at 147.
- With his 22 points tonight, Agbaji passed Tony Guy and Bud Stallworth and now sits at 23 on the all-time scoring list. He now has 1,506 points during his career.
- Agbaji has now recorded 17 games this season where he has 20 or more points, which leads the Big 12.
