KANSAS' WIN...

- Makes Kansas 27-6 on the season
- Makes KU 5-1 in neutral-site games this season
- Makes Kansas 15-6 in Big 12 Championship semifinals
- Advances Kansas to the conference tournament finals for the 15th time in Big 12 history and 23rd time overall
- Improves Kansas to 79-28 in league tournament play and 49-12 at the Big 12 Championship
- Makes Kansas 45-10 all-time at the T-Mobile Center, including 3-0 this season
- Makes Bill Self 755-229 all-time, 549-124 at Kansas and 44-12 all-time in league tournaments (35-8 at Kansas)
- Makes Kansas 2,350-877 all-time

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas forced three shot clock violations in the first half and another in the second half. The Jayhawks now have forced 27 this season.
- Kansas improved to 22-3 this season when leading at halftime.
- Kansas improved to 20-0 this season when holding its opponent under 70 points.
- The Jayhawks shot 50 percent (30-60) from the floor, improving to 14-2 this season when shooting 50% or better.
- The Jayhawks are 2-1 all-time in the postseason against TCU.
- Kansas has won five-straight Big 12 Tournament semifinal games with its last loss coming in 2014 against Iowa State.
- The Jayhawks have led their two opponents in the Big 12 Tournament -- West Virginia and TCU -- for a total of 75 minutes and 21 seconds out of a possible 80 minutes. Kansas has trailed for just 3 minutes and 58 seconds total through two games.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior Mitch Lightfoot played in the 161st game of his career, which is the most games played in Kansas history, and tied for 11th in NCAA Division I history. Lightfoot has now been a part of 164 wins at Kansas. The record is 165.
- Lightfoot finished with a career-high 15 points in the win. His previous career high was 14, set twice prior. Lightfoot had five rebounds for the second-straight game. He has pulled down five or more rebounds seven times this season.
- Senior Ochai Agbaji scored 22 points, giving him his 18th 20-point game of the season, which leads the Big 12 Conference.
- Super-Senior Remy Martin scored 10 points, reaching double figures for the first time since Dec. 18, 2021 vs. Stephen F. Austin.
- Jalen Coleman-Lands appeared in the 165th game of his career, which ranks tied for third in NCAA Division I. Iowa's Jordan Bohannon has appeared in the most games ever at 174.
