CONFERENCE NOTES

- The Big 12 is tied for the nation's most with three top-10 teams in the DI Baseball Top 25. No. 4 Texas Tech, No. 5 Oklahoma State and No. 7 Texas are the Conference's ranked teams.
- Entering the week, the Big 12 has seven schools ranked 51st-or-better in the RPI, including four programs in the top-25.
- Four Big 12 teams rank in the nation's top-20 for average attendance and six Conference schools are in DI's top 50.
- The Big 12 is 137-68 (66.8%) in non-conference games this season, which ranks third among all leagues.
- Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas hosts the 2022 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship, May 25-29. Tickets are on sale at TexasRangers.com/Big12.
- WVU's Austin Davis (.688 avg, 10 R, 2 SB, 1.675 OPS) was selected as Big 12 Player of the Week, UT's Pete Hansen (1-0, 9.0 IP, 2 H, 0 ER, 12 K) earned Pitcher of the Week, plus TTU's Andrew Morris (1-0, 7.0 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 9 K) and OSU's Roc Riggio (.353 avg, 2 HR, 1.332 OPS) were Co-Newcomers of the Week.
- Baylor has three players with long on-base streaks; Tre Richardson is at a career-high 22 games, Jared McKenzie is at a career-high 18 and Jack Pineda is at 14 games.
- Kansas secured its first three-game series sweep of the season by defeating Illinois State April 8-10. The Jayhawks scored 29 runs in the three games.
- Kansas State boasts two of the Big 12's leaders in multi-hit games, as Dominic Johnson ranks second with 18 and Dylan Phillips ties for fifth with 15.
- Oklahoma has scored at least seven runs in 15 of its last 20 games. OU only averaged 3.5 runs per game before that stretch.
- Oklahoma State rallied from a five-run, seventh-inning deficit to defeat Oklahoma April 9. Taking two-of-three, OSU has now won seven of the last nine Bedlam Series.
- TCU's Tommy Sacco has reached base in nine consecutive plate appearances, dating back to April 9.
- Texas' Pete Hansen has allowed just four hits and a single run in his last 22.2 IP (0.40 ERA). He has retired the side in order in 16 of those 23 innings. He leads all active Division I starting pitchers with a 1.74 career earned run average.
- Texas Tech's Jace Jung hit a walk-off home run to complete a three-run ninth-inning Red Raider comeback and grab the series sweep over K-State on April 10.
- West Virginia won all three games against Baylor April 8-10, marking the first Big 12 sweep for the Mountaineers since the 2016 series against Texas.
