FIRST PITCH

- ▶ Oklahoma (22-13, 4-5 Big 12) returns to Big 12 conference play with a three-game road series at Kansas (16-20, 2-7 Big 12). Game times are scheduled for 6 p.m. Friday, 2 p.m. Saturday and 1 p.m. Sunday at Hoglund Ballpark in Lawrence, Kan.
- ► The Sooners were on conference bye last weekend, and won two of three games against Pacific and Lamar. OU has won four of its last five games, including a neutral-site victory over Texas Tech on April 12 and a win over Wichita State at L. Dale Mitchell Park on Tuesday. Kansas has won six of its last nine, including two wins over Texas Southern this week.
- ► The games will be televised via Big 12 Now on ESPN+ and will be broadcast on the Sooner Radio Network (locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM KREF, Sportstalk1400.com and the Varsity Network app anywhere), and streamed live on SoonerSports.tv, with Taylor Maples on the call.
- Live stats will be available at OUStats.com.

LEADING OFF

- ▶ Through the first nine weeks of the season (35 games), the Sooners are 12-9 against the RPI top 100, including six top-50 wins (6-8) and five top-25 wins (5-5). OU's overall strength of schedule is ranked ninth in the country while its non-conference SOS is ranked 35th nationally.
- ▶ Oklahoma is hitting .289 as a team and averaging 6.7 runs, 9.3 hits and 2.7 extra base hits per game (62 doubles, 26 home runs). The pitching staff has compiled a 5.46 ERA, 310 strikeouts to 134 walks and 333 hits in 313.1 innings and has allowed a .272 opponent batting average.
- ► Kansas is hitting .266 as a team. The Jayhawks average 6.1 runs, 9.3 hits and 3.1 extra base hits per game (64 doubles, 34 home runs). The pitching staff has compiled a 6.83 ERA, 264 strikeouts to 151 walks and 355 hits in 309.2 innings and has allowed a .287 opponent batting average.
- ▶ Oklahoma is in its fifth season under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson** (including the 2020 season that was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic). Johnson, who spent the 2017 season on staff as an assistant coach, has led the Sooners to a 134-93 record since taking over as head coach prior to the 2018 season.

SERIES HISTORY VS. KANSAS

- ▶ Oklahoma leads the overall series against Kansas 142-78-1, and holds a 51-35 advantage in Lawrence.
- ▶ The Sooners have won seven of the last eight against the Jayhawks, including all three meetings in 2019 and two of three last year in Norman.
- ► Kansas won two of three games during the 2018 series, the last time OU and KU met in Lawrence. The Jayhawks won three straight series between 2016 and 2018. Oklahoma won the final game of the 2018 series and the Big 12 tournament meeting that season.

BASE-SNATCHERS

- ▶ The Sooners have registered 85 stolen bases in 109 attempts through 35 games this season. OU surpassed its total from all of last year (46 steals) in the 18th game of this season. The last time Oklahoma completed a season with at least 80 steals was in 2010 (98).
- ▶ Oklahoma ranks sixth nationally in stolen bases (85) and steals per game (2.4). Both figures rank second in the Big 12, only to West Virginia's 115 steals and average of 3.4 steals per game.
- ▶ OU's most steals over the last 12 seasons was 98, in 2010. Over the last 30 years (1993-2022), OU has finished a season with more than 80 steals nine times: 2010 (98), 2007 (96), 2006, (85), 2003 (91), 2000 (87), 1997 (86), 1996 (104), 1995 (93), 1993 (83).
- ▶ Peyton Graham leads OU with 14 stolen bases, while Tanner Tredaway and Kendall Pettis each have 13 steals. Blake Robertson

has nine steals and catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has eight steals. The last time OU had at least one player with 13 steals at the end of a season was 2013 (16 by **Craig Aikin** and 13 by **Matt Oberste**). A total of 14 players have recorded at least one stolen base this season.

- ▶ Oklahoma has registered at least 10 steals in a game twice this season. OU went off for 11 steals against Wichita State on Feb. 22 and stole 10 bases on April 16 vs. Pacific.
- ► Three players Graham, Pettis and Tredaway each had three stolen bases in the Feb. 22 game vs. Wichita State. Graham notched three steals again vs. Texas on April 2. It was the fourth time a single player has registered three steals in a single game this season.
- ▶ Prior to Feb. 22, no single Sooner had stolen three bases in a game since **Erik Ross** against Hartford in 2012. Oklahoma (3-1) finished the Wichita State game one steal shy of the school record of 12, set in 1937 against East Central (Okla.) University.

RECAPPING THE LAST WEEK

- ▶ Oklahoma defeated Wichita State 9-5 on Tuesday after taking two of three last weekend (won vs. Pacific 7-3 and 10-2 and fell to Lamar 14-11).
- ▶ OU scored seven runs in the sixth inning to overcome a three-run deficit and defeat Wichita State 9-5 on Tuesday. Trailing 5-2, the Sooners strung together four hits, four walks and five stolen bases during the bottom half of the sixth to go ahead 9-5.
- ▶ Diego Muniz drove in three runs and Tanner Tredaway went 2 for 4 with an RBI and a run scored. Blake Robertson, Jimmy Crooks and Cade Horton also drove in runs for the Sooners. Jaret Godman earned the win with a relief inning and Trevin Michael got the final out with two runners on base to pick up his sixth save of the season. Colton Sundloff, Javier Ramos. Chazz Martinez. Nicholas Andrews and Jett Lodes combined for 6.0 scoreless relief innings.
- ► Cade Horton made his first career start in the weekend opener last Thursday, earning the victory. David Sandlin struck out five over 6.0 innings and earned the win vs. Pacific on Saturday.

NOTING THE SOONERS

- ▶ During the first 10 games of the season, Oklahoma scored a total of 35 runs (average of 3.5 per game) and did not score more than six runs in any game. The Sooners have scored 198 runs during the last 25 games (7.9 per game). OU has scored at least seven runs in 20 of those 25 games.
- ▶ OU is 63 for 81 on stolen base attempts in the last 25 games (average of 2.5 steals per game). Over the last 25 games, **Peyton Graham** leads the Sooners with 11 steals while **Tanner Tredaway** has nine steals.
- ▶ **Blake Robertson** leads the Sooners with a .357 batting average (45 for 126), 34 walks and 12 doubles. Graham has team bests of nine home runs and 35 runs scored while batting .311 (42 for 135) with 28 RBIs. Tredaway is batting .326 (45 for 138) with a team-high 31 RBIs, nine doubles, two homers and 25 runs scored and **Jimmy Crooks** is hitting .311 (37 for 119) with 26 walks, 20 RBIs and 21 runs scored.
- ▶ During a nine-game stretch over two weeks (March 29-April 12), the Sooners played eight games against opponents ranked among the top-8 nationally. OU went 5-4 overall during that stretch (4-4 vs. ranked foes Oklahoma State, Texas and Texas Tech).

Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (3/14)

- ▶ During its 12-game homestand (9-3 record at L. Dale Mitchell Park from March 8-27), Oklahoma turned up the offense. The Sooners batted .336 with 40 extra base hits (average of 3.3 per game), 26 doubles, 12 home runs, 67 walks (5.6 per game) and 29 stolen bases. OU totaled 100 runs (8.3 per game) and registered 133 hits (11.1 per game).
- ▶ OU scored at least seven runs in eight straight games between March 8-19. The Sooners had a similar eight-game scoring run between March 9-21 of last season, but this was only the third occurrence in the last 11 years. Oklahoma opened the 2011 season by scoring at least seven runs in nine consecutive games.

THE "GRAHAM SLAM" VS. BAYLOR

- ▶ The Sooners called on a little "Sooner Magic" in the seriesclinching victory vs. Baylor on April 26. Peyton Graham hit a walk-off grand slam in the bottom of the ninth inning, and that was after **Tanner Tredaway** hit a game-tying grand slam in the eighth inning. The home runs were the first hit of the game for either player, and Graham's first hit of the series to that point.
- ► The "Graham slam" is believed to be the first walk-off grand slam for Oklahoma in at least 25 years, and potentially longer. It was OU's first walk-of home run since Renae Martinez beat TCU in 2017.
- ► "That was probably the coolest thing I've ever experienced here at OU," Graham said of his game-winning grand slam.

MARTINEZ EARNED NATIONAL, BIG 12 HONORS

- ▶ Chazz Martinez fanned 14 batters over 7.0 innings, while allowing only three hits and one walk, in OU's series-clinching 5-1 victory over Northwestern State on Sunday. As a result, he was named the the National Pitcher of the Week by the NCBWA, the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week and a national player of the week by Collegiate Baseball.
- ▶ Martinez struck out six consecutive batters across the second and third innings, then later retired nine in a row. The 14 strikeouts were the most by an OU pitcher since **Levi Prater** had 15 against Missouri State in 2019. It was also the first time a Sooner pitcher struck out six consecutive batters since Jake Irvin against Oklahoma State in 2018.
- ▶ Martinez was OU's first NCBWA national player of the week since **Dane Acker** on March 2, 2020, after his no-hitter vs. LSU. **Tyler Hardman** was one of Collegiate Baseball's national players of the week last season after hitting for the cycle in a game vs. Arkansas State.

BIG LEAGUE BALLPARKS

► This is the fourth straight season in which Oklahoma has

played at least one game in a Major League Ballpark. OU has played nine games in big league ballparks this season the State Farm College Baseball Showdown at the Texas Rangers' Globe Life Field (Feb. 18-20), a three-game set vs. Northwestern State at Globe Life Field (Feb. 25-27) and the Shriners Children's College Classic at the Houston Astros' Minute Maid Park (March 4-6). The Sooners played two games at Globe Life Field in 2021, three at Minute Maid Park in 2020

(Shriners College Classic) and one contest against Minnesota at Target Field in Minneapolis (2019).

- ▶ In addition to the Red River Rivalry series at Globe Life Field, the 2022 Big 12 Championship, which will include the league's top eight teams in the standings, will be held at Globe Life Field May 25-29.
- ▶ The Sooners are 5-7 in games played at Major League ballparks this season (5-4 at Globe Life Field, 0-3 at Minute Maid Park). Over the last four years, OU is a combined 9-9 in games played at MLB ballparks.

PRESEASON HONORS

- ▶ Peyton Graham was named on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, awarded by USA Baseball. He was also recognized as a first-team Preseason All-American by Baseball America and named to the Preseason All-Big 12 team by the league's coaches.
- ▶ Jimmy Crooks earned third-team preseason All-America honors from the NCBWA and Collegiate Baseball.

SKIP JOHNSON

SIXTH YEAR AT OKLAHOMA, FIFTH AS HEAD COACH 560+ WINS AS A HEAD COACH • 134-93 OVERALL RECORD AT OU



idely regarded as one of the premier pitching coaches in the country, Skip Johnson has led the Oklahoma baseball program since June 2017. Since taking over the reins after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach, he has led the Sooners to a 134-93 record in four-plus seasons.

Johnson's influence on the program began immediately and has progressed each year. The OU pitching staffs posted a progressively lower ERA in each of his first four seasons in Norman. Oklahoma's 3.92 team ERA in 2019 was only the seventh team ERA under 4.00 since 1980, and the first since 2015. In his first two seasons, Sooners pitchers posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history. A total of 17 pitchers have heard their name called in the Major League Baseball Draft since 2017 and 23 Sooners overall have been drafted by MLB teams since 2018.

Johnson earned his 100th career victory at OU with a 10-4 victory over Kansas on April 9, 2021. First baseman Tyler Hardman earned second-team All-America honors from three outlets (ABCA, NCBWA and Perfect Game) and was selected in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft. Pitchers

Wyatt Olds (seventh round) and Jason Ruffcorn (eighth round) were also taken in the MLB Draft. Hardman won the Big 12 batting title with a .397 average — the highest by a Sooners since 2001 — and the pitching staff ranked 16th nationally by averaging 10.6 strikeouts per nine innings.

In the 2020 season shortened due to COVID-19, the Sooners compiled a 14-4 record and climbed as high as No. 9 in the national polls. In the process, OU turned in some historic performances. Dane Acker pitched Oklahoma's first individual no-hitter since 1989 against No. 11 LSU in the Shriners College Classic, and the pitching staff combined for a Big 12-record 21 strikeouts in one game against Arkansas-Pine Bluff. Cade Cavalli became OU's 10th first-round selection in the regular June Major League Baseball Draft when he was selected 22nd overall. A program-record four Sooners were drafted in the first four rounds, including all three pitchers in the weekend rotation (Cavalli, Levi Prater and Acker).

Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance in 2018. The Sooners posted a 38-25 record – the highest win total since 2013 – and reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional. In the process, Oklahoma pitchers set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Outfielder Steele Walker was named a Second-Team All-American by Baseball America and the NCBWA, and pitcher Levi Prater was selected as a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball. Outfielder Kyler Murray, who went on to win the 2018 Heisman Trophy with the OU football team, was the ninth overall selection in the 2018 MLB Draft. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds (Walker in the second round, pitcher Jake Irvin in the fourth round, pitcher Austin Hansen in the eighth round and outfielder Cade Harris in the 10th round).

Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings or more in 2017, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional. Three Oklahoma pitchers were selected in the 2017 MLB Draft. Sooner closer JB Olson was drafted in the 10th round to extend a string of seven straight years with an Oklahoma player chosen in the first 10 rounds. OU saw starter Devon Perez and reliever Vincenzo Aiello selected on day three of the draft.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido, who stepped down from his position as the winningest coach in college baseball in May 2016 to take on new duties in the UT athletics department. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three College World Series appearances.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 Texas pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson also oversaw the development of six Longhorn pitchers who have made it to the big leagues. The Texas pitching staff produced a team earned run average below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons. As Texas reached its second CWS with Johnson on staff in 2011, his pitchers led the Big 12 in ERA (2.35), batting average against (.198) and strikeouts per nine innings (8.28).

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has mentored a number of players outside of those he has coached at OU, UT and Navarro, regularly working with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers, Homer Bailey of the Kansas Oakland Athletics and Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.
