CONFERENCE NOTES

- The Big 12 has three teams in the DI Baseball Top 25. No. 3 Oklahoma State, No. 9 Texas Tech and No. 24 TCU are the Conference's ranked teams.
- Entering the week, the Big 12 has five schools ranked in the RPI Top 50, and eight programs in the RPI Top 100.
- Four Big 12 teams rank in the nation's top-20 for average attendance and seven Conference schools are in DI's top 50.
- Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas hosts the 2022 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship, May 25-29. Tickets are on sale at TexasRangers.com/Big12. Oklahoma State and TCU have clinched top-eight seeds for the event.
- KU's Caleb Upshaw (.500 avg, 9 RBI, 1.524 OPS) and OSU's Nolan McLean (.333 avg, 2 HR, 2 SV, 0.00 ERA) were selected as Big 12 Co-Players of the Week, OU's Jake Bennett (1-0, 7.0 IP, 2 H, 0 ER, 11 K) was Pitcher of the Week, plus Upshaw was Newcomer of the Week.
- Baylor's Kyle Nevin recorded a career-high five hits on Sunday becoming the first BU player to do so since Shea Langeliers did in the 2019 Los Angeles Regional.
- Kansas' Daniel Hegarty threw his second complete game in three starts on Apr. 29 in a 7-3 win over West Virginia. Hegarty's first career start came on Mar. 25.
- Kansas State scored six unanswered runs to cap a 8-7 win at Oklahoma May 1, snapping a streak of seven straight road losses to the Sooners.
- Oklahoma scored 43 runs in the series against Kansas State (Apr. 29-May 1) as the Sooners picked up their second consecutive Big 12 series win.
- Oklahoma State clinched their fourth series sweep over Texas in seven tries with a 10-run 7th inning May 1 to beat the then-No. 10 Longhorns 10-8.
- TCU has won the middle game in each of its six Big 12 series this season. The Horned Frogs have won four of their six Big 12 series.
- Texas head coach David Pierce collected his 400th career win on Apr. 26.
- UT's Ivan Melendez is leading the Big 12 in batting average (.411), home runs (22) and runs batted in (66). He is attempting to be the first Big 12 player to lead in all three categories since Tony Thompson (KU) in 2009.
- Texas Tech outscored Baylor 18-2 in the first two games (Apr. 29-30) to win their fifth Big 12 series in six tries this season.
- West Virginia hit four home runs on Apr. 30, and followed that effort with five blasts against the Jayhawks on May 1 to secure a series victory. The 5 home runs match the most for a team in a Big 12 game this season.
