CONFERENCE NOTES

- The Big 12 has three teams in the DI Baseball Top 25. No. 3 Oklahoma State, No. 9 Texas Tech and No. 22 Texas are the Conference's ranked teams.
- This weekend's series between No. 3 Oklahoma State and No. 9 Texas Tech is one of two weekend series between top-10 teams nationally.
- Entering the week, the Big 12 has six schools ranked in the RPI Top 50, and eight programs in the RPI Top 100.
- Four Big 12 teams rank in the nation's top-20 for average attendance and seven Conference schools are in DI's top 55.
- Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas hosts the Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship, May 25-29. Tickets are on sale at TexasRangers.com/Big12. Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, TCU, Texas and Texas Tech have clinched berths for the event.
- UT's Ivan Melendez (.571 avg, 3 HR, 2.150 OPS) was selected as Big 12 Player of the Week, K-State's German Fajardo (1-0, 1 SV, 8.2 IP, 0 ER, 1 H) was Pitcher of the Week and Fajardo and West Virginia's Dayne Leonard (.400 avg, 6 RBI, 1.300 OPS) were Co-Newcomers of the Week.
- Baylor defeated Tarleton 8-2 on May 3, marking the Bears' 13th consecutive midweek home win. BU is 7-0 in home midweek games in 2022.
- Kansas' Daniel Hegarty has thrown at least eight innings in three of his last four starts, going 3-1 in that span. Hegarty's first career start came on Mar. 25.
- Kansas State beat Kansas in a three-game series May 6-8, marking the Wildcats' first series win over their in-state rivals since the 2018 season.
- Oklahoma has won three consecutive Big 12 series, taking two-of-three from then-No. 24 TCU May 6-8. It is Oklahoma's first ranked series win of the season.
- Oklahoma State has picked up back-to-back weekend series sweeps, defeating Texas (Apr. 29-May 1) in Big 12 play followed by Southeast Missouri State (May 6-8) in non-conference.
- TCU used a seven-run fifth to defeat Oklahoma 9-7 on May 6. Ten different Horned Frogs had a hit in the contest.
- UT's Ivan Melendez has tied the Big 12 record for career player of the week honors with five and single-season player of the week honors with four.
- Texas Tech was off May 6-8, but grabbed a 16-12 midweek victory over Abilene Christian May 3, which was the longest nine-inning game in program history at 4:42.
- West Virginia remains the only Big 12 team without a three-game losing streak this season after an 8-6 win against Texas May 8. WVU rallied from a sixth-inning deficit to win.
