CONFERENCE NOTES

XII The Big 12 has four teams in the DI Baseball Top 25. No. 5 Texas Tech, No. 8 Oklahoma State, No. 22 Texas and No. 24 TCU are the Conference's ranked teams.

XII The Big 12 has the nation's top mark with 44% of Conference schools ranked. The Big 12 is one of three conferences with at least four ranked schools.

XII Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, TCU and Texas Tech enter the final weekend of the regular season with Big 12 title hopes alive. TCU and Texas Tech can win the championship outright, while Oklahoma and Oklahoma State can clinch shares.

XII Oklahoma and Oklahoma State must sweep their weekend series to clinch a share of the Big 12 title (OSU requires a TTU loss as well). Texas Tech earns a share of the title with a series win, and TCU, who is playing non-conference, only needs Texas Tech to lose once to clinch a share.

XII Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas hosts the Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship, May 25-29. Tickets are on sale at TexasRangers.com/Big12. Baylor and Kansas are battling for the final bid in the event.

XII TCU's Luke Boyers (.412 avg, 8 RBI, 1.324 OPS) and Oklahoma's Brett Squires (.750 avg, 7 RBI, 1.950 OPS) were selected as Big 12 Co-Players of the Week, Baylor's Jake Jackson (1-0, 7.0 IP, 1 ER, 6 H) was Pitcher of the Week and Texas Tech's Owen Washburn (.400 avg, 7 RBI, 1.200 OPS) was Newcomer of the Week.

XII Baylor's Tre Richardson had three hits and two two-out RBIs in the Bears' 4-2 win over K-State on May 13.

XII Kansas' Maui Ahuna has a 17-game hit streak, tied for the longest active streak in the league and tied for the second-longest this season.

XII Kansas State's Nick Goodwin hit a go-ahead grand slam in the eighth inning May 15 against Baylor, clinching the Wildcats' second-straight series win.

XII Oklahoma scored 40 runs in a series win over West Virginia May 13-15. It is the third Big 12 series where OU scored at least 40 runs this season.

XII Oklahoma State's Griffin Doersching hit two home runs in the weekend series against Texas Tech May 13-15, including a 513-foot blast on Friday.

XII TCU's 30 runs on May 14 are the most in a Big 12 game since the 2008 season, and the most for a Big 12 team in any game since 2009.

XII UT had a season-high seven doubles in its win May 10 against Texas Southern.

XII Texas Tech swept then-No. 3 Oklahoma State May 13-15, the Red Raiders third straight sweep in Stillwater. The Red Raiders have won three straight Big 12 series.

XII West Virginia has now won 30-or-more games in five of 10 seasons under head coach Randy Mazey.
