LONGHORNS NOTES

THE MATCHUPS—Texas hosts Kansas in the final series of the regular season ahead of the Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship. The Jayhawks make their first trip to UFCU Disch-Falk Field since the 2018 season when the Longhorns swept the series. Last season, Texas swept the series over Kansas in Lawrence.

A LOOK AT THE LONGHORNS—The Longhorns head into the final series of the regular season after a 9-2 midweek win over Sam Houston. Texas leads the Big 12 with a .319 team batting average and a program record 98 homers, while the pitching staff is first in the league with a 4.20 ERA. The Longhorns are also the league's top fielding team with a .986 fielding percentage.

BOMB SQUAD—Texas has broken the program record for most home runs in a season, smashing 98 bombs in 53 games this season. The home run total leads the Big 12 and ranks eighth nationally. Last season Texas hit 68 homers in 67 games, the fourth-most by a Longhorn team. Texas has 27 multiple-homer games, including 10 three-homer games, five four-homer games and three five-homer games.

HOME SWEET HOME—Texas has gone 21-7 this season at the friendly confines of UFCU Disch-Falk Field. Through the first 53 games of the season, Texas has played a total of 28 games at home and 25 games away from UFCU Disch-Falk Field. The Longhorns close out the regular season with four-straight home games before heading to the Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship. In home games, Texas has a team batting average of .334 and a .989 fielding percentage. The Longhorns have also averaged 6,791 fans in attendance at home this season, the fifth-highest average attendance in the country.

TITANIC—Ivan Melendez leads the country with a .421 batting average and 26 home runs this season, the second-most ever hit by a Texas player in a single season. Melendez now has 39 career home runs, which is the third-most in a career at Texas. Melendez also ranks in the top-5 nationally with 179 total bases (1st), a .942 slugging percentage (1st), 80 RBI (2nd) and a .537 on-base percentage (4th). With three regular season games left Melendez is on pace for the Big 12 Triple Crown.

MURPH DOG-Murphy Stehly has had an outstanding season at the plate, batting .380, ranking 10th in the nation with 81 total hits and 17th with 146 total bases. Stehly also has 18 doubles, one triple and 15 homers. He has a hit in 45 of his 52 games played and has 24 games with multiple hits, including just the sixth three-homer game in Texas Baseball history. He had a 20-game hitting streak earlier this season, which is tied for the fourth-longest in program history. His versatility has also been on display, playing first base, second base, third base and right field throughout the season.

IMMEDIATE IMPACT—Texas struck gold last season with the addition of graduate transfer Mike Antico from St. John's. The outfielder became the first player in Big 12 history to hit 10 homers and steal 40 bases in a season. This season the Longhorns added grad transfer Skyler Messinger from Kansas and he has produced. The similarities have been striking, as both players had a slow start to their Texas careers. Through Antico's first 26 games last season, he was batting just .202 before going on to bat .273 and landing on the All-Big 12 second team. For Messinger, he was batting just .192 after his first 16 games but over his last 33 games he has raised his batting average up to .366. Messinger has hit nine home runs this season, after having just six in his four years at Kansas. He has also been great defensively at third base with only two errors in 132 defensive chances this season.

LONGHORNS NOTES

BACK-TO-BACK JACKS—Texas has hit back-to-back home runs on eight different occasions this season. The power-hitting duo of Ivan Melendez and Murphy Stehly have gone back-to-back four times. The Longhorns have also hit three-straight homers in a game this season, on May 1 against Oklahoma State.

OWN THE DISCH—A large part of the Longhorns success under head coach David Pierce has come down to dominating at home. Since 2017 Texas has produced a 142-40 (.780) record at UFCU Disch-Falk Field, including an 20-7 mark this season. Since the stadium opened in 1975, Texas has gone 1573-400-3 at home for a .797 winning percentage. The fan base has also done a great job of making the Disch a difficult place to play. Through the first 27 home games this season Texas is averaging 6,808 fans in attendance, which would be a program record. With the exception of last season's limited capacity due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Texas has led the Big 12 in attendance for 15-consecutive seasons.

FLASHING THE LEATHER—Trey Faltine and Mitchell Daly have formed an incredible middle infield duo, anchoring the top defense in the Big 12 with a .986 fielding percentage. This season, Faltine leads the league with 154 assists and Daly is second with 153. Last season Faltine led the Big 12 with 203 assists, while Daly was second with 178.

INFIELD HIT MACHINE—Throughout his career on the Forty Acres, Eric Kennedy has used his speed as a means to get on base. With four infield singles (three bunt) this season, Kennedy now has 55 career infield singles (31 bunts). Last season he had 27 infield singles, including 16 bunt hits.

MARCH MADNESS—Texas Baseball started the month of March with a tough stretch of 11 games in the first 16 days of the month. Making it even tougher, the majority of those games were away from UFCU Disch-Falk Field, with 10 of 11 on the road. The road was grueling and the Longhorns started the month with a 6-5 record. The back end of the March schedule was tough as well, starting Big 12 Conference play by dropping the series at Texas Tech before falling to Texas A&M for a midweek game. In all, Texas went 11-8 in the month of March with 13 games away from home.

HEAR 'EM—In partnership with Learfield IMG College, Texas games will be broadcast on the Austin Radio Network, primarily on 104.9 The Horn and AM 1260. Craig Way handles primary play-by-play duties alongside Roger Wallace. This season fans will also hear analysis from Longhorn greats Keith Moreland, Ty Harrington and Nathan Thornhill throughout the season.

HEAD COACH **AVID PIERCE 22**

6th season at Texas | 11th season as head coach

HIGH SCHOOL St. Pius X High School JUNIOR COLLEGE Wharton County Junior College ALMA MATER University of Houston, 1988

A Texas native who has spent most of his 30-year career coaching in the state, David Pierce was named head baseball coach at The University of Texas on June 29, 2016. Pierce, just the fifth Longhorn head coach since 1911 (with the exception of the war years of 1943-

45 when Blair Cherry was at the helm), is the 13th head coach in 123 years of Texas baseball.

Entering his sixth season as the Longhorns' head coach in 2022, Pierce has an overall record of 172-94 at Texas and a 369-203 mark in 10 seasons as a Division I head coach.

The 2021 season saw Texas return to the College World Series and come just one game shy of the CWS Finals. Pierce guided the Longhorns to the Big 12 Championship and their first 50-win season since 2010, while being named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year for the second time.

the CWS Finals. Pierce guided the Longhorns to the Big 12 Championship and their first 50-win season since 2010, while being named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year for the second time. He was also recognized as the ABCA Central Regional Coach of the Year, a distinction he had not received since the 2012 season. The Longhorns had 13 total players recognized on the All-Big 12 teams, including the Big 12 Pitcher of the Year Ty Madden. Madden was also named a First Team All-American and became the highest drafted Texas player since Taylor Jungmann in 2011. Including Madden, seven total Texas players were selected in the 2021 MLB Draft. The 2021 Longhorns led the nation with a 2.93 ERA, the best mark for the program since 2014. The pitching staff also totaled 556 strikeouts, the most for a Longhorn pitching staff since 2011. Offensively the Longhorns blasted 68 home runs, the most since a program record 81 in 2010. The team not only hit for power, finishing with more stolen bases (92) than any Texas team in over 15 years.

In just his second season at the helm, Pierce was named Baseball America's National Coach of the Year after guiding the Longhorns to a 42-23 record and back to the College World Series for the first time since 2014. With a 17-7 mark in league play, Pierce, who was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year, led his team to the Big 12 Conference title—the first conference title for Texas since 2011—and hosted both an NCAA Regional and an NCAA Super Regional. In the Austin Regional, Texas dropped game one to Tennessee Tech before taking games two and three to send Pierce to Omaha for the first time as head coach. The Longhorns finished ranked in the top eight in every major poll to close out the season and finished first in the nation in double plays (73) and ninth in triples (22). Under Pierce and his staff's tutelage, second baseman Kody Clemens completed one of the best offensive seasons in Texas history. A third-round draft pick by the Detroit Tigers, Clemens was named a unanimous firs

ranked nationally in total bases (second, 180), slugging percentage (fifth, .726), and RBI (12th, 72). In his first season leading the Longhorns, Pierce led Texas to a 39-24 record, a 14-win improvement from the 2016 campaign. Texas came within one win of taking the Big 12 Conference tournament title before earning a No. 2 seed in the Long Beach Regional. Texas won its first two games of the regional before its season came to a close at the hands of LBSU. As a team, the Longhorns finished in the top 10 nationally in several statistical categories including double plays turned (fourth, 65), fielding percentage (fourth, 982), earned run average (ninth, 3.15), and hits allowed per nine innings (ninth, 7.60). Right-handed pitcher Morgan Cooper, a third team All-America selection, was taken in the second round of the MLB Draft, the first of 11 Longhorns to be selected in 2017, the most for any school. In Pierce's two seasons, a total of 16 Longhorns have been chosen in the draft.

The 56-year-old Pierce came to Texas from Tulane, where he spent the previous two seasons as head coach following a three-year stint at Sam Houston State in the same role. Pierce's teams have qualified for the NCAA tournament in seven years with him at the helm, and including his time as an assistant, Pierce was a part of programs that advanced to the postseason in 18 consecutive years, played in eight Super Regionals and reached five College World Series, winning a title in 2003 with Rice. In the summer of 2016, he was also named an assistant coach with the U.S. Collegiate National Team. Joining the Tulane Green Wave in 2015, the Houston native guided the school into its first season in the American Athletic Conference. His team posted a school-record nine shutouts, which ranked fourth in the nation, en route to a 35-25 record and the program's first regional appearance

since 2008.

Pierce's second season at Tulane brought even more success as he led the 2016 Green Wave to a 41-21 record, a regular season AAC championship and a second-consecutive regional appearance. The 41 wins were the most for the program since 2006. The team led the nation with 13 shutouts and ranked in the top 25 in both ERA (23rd/3.24) and WHIP (25th/1.24), while belting out 66 home runs, which was tied for 13th nationally. Tulane produced two third-round picks in the 2016 Major League Baseball Draft in catcher Jake Rogers and shortstop Stephen Alemais with Rogers becoming Tulane's highest draft pick since 2008. Seven players earned All-AAC honors, including four first-team selections, while starting pitcher Ross Massey was named freshman All-America after leading the conference and tying for 18th in the nation in victories (10).

In three seasons as head coach at Sam Houston State, Pierce compiled a record of 121-63 (.658). During his tenure, the Bearkats made three straight NCAA Regional appearances for just the second time in program history. Sam Houston State was crowned Southland Conference champions in each of his three seasons (the program's only previous league title came in 1989), and Pierce was named

of his three seasons (the program's only previous league title came in 1989), and Pierce was named the conference coach of the year in both 2012 and 2013. The recognition in back-to-back years made him the first Southland Conference coach to earn consecutive honors since UTSA's Sherman Corbett

In his first season as head coach in 2012, the Bearkats were ranked in each of the major Division I polls for the first time in program history. He was honored as an American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Regional Coach of the Year that season. In 2014, his final season in Huntsville, Pierce guided SHSU to a 43-19 record, the second-highest single-season win total for the Bearkats since they joined Division I in 1987. The team ranked in the top 25 in the nation and second in the conference in both ERA (17th/2.73) and hits (25th/610). It also led the conference in scoring (5.7)

A native of Houston, Pierce was born on October 13, 1962. He and his wife, Susan, have two children and one grandchild. Pierce's daughter, Chelsea, graduated from The University of Texas in 2012 is married to husband Bryan Caffey, and the couple have two daughters, Beckett and Lochlan. David and Susan's son, Shea, played for his father at both Sam Houston (2012-15) and Tulane (2016).
