THE LOSS...

- Made Kansas 16-4 overall and 5-3 in league play.
- Marked the third straight conference loss for KU and the first time since the 2020-21 season (1/12 at OSU, 1/18 at BU, 1/23 at OU). The three-game losing streak is tied for the longest in the Bill Self era.
- Made Kansas 2,373-881 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas shot a perfect 16-of-16 from the free throw line. That marks the third game this season shooting 100 percent from the charity stripe. The Jayhawks have not had three games in a single-season with a perfect free throw percentage since at least the 1996-97 season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Freshman Gradey Dick posted a game-high 24 points on 8-of-13 (61.5 percent) shooting and four rebounds in 31 minutes. Dick has finished with 20+ points in five contests this season.
- Redshirt junior Jalen Wilson contributed 23 points on 10-of-16 (62.5 percent) shooting, five rebounds and two assists in 38 minutes. Wilson has scored at least 20 points in 11 games this season.
- Wilson has scored 1,179 points in his career, moving him into 43rd on the Kansas all-time scoring list, passing Milt Newton (1,166).
- Redshirt senior Kevin McCullar Jr. recorded his fifth double-double of the season (eighth career), finishing with 14 points, a game-high 12 rebounds, a game-high-tying four assists and two steals in 35 minutes. He has 11 double-digit scoring games this season.
