

THE LOSS...

- Ended a seven-game winning streak against Iowa State
- Made the Kansas-Iowa State series 189-67 all-time in favor of Kansas
- Made Kansas 4-3 in true road games this year and 7-4 in games not played at Allen Fieldhouse
- Made Bill Self 574-129 while at Kansas, 777-234 all-time and 34-11 against lowa State
- Made Kansas 2,375-882 all-time

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas dropped to 13-2 on the season when holding its opponent under 70 points.
- The nine free throw attempts by Iowa State tied the season low by a Kansas opponent. Texas Southern also attempted nine free throws on Nov. 28, 2022.
- Kansas had eight assists on eight made baskets in the first half.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Redshirt junior Jalen Wilson finished with 26 points, including three three-pointers, nine rebounds and two assists in 39 minutes. Wilson has scored 20+ points in six straight games and 14 times this season (21st career). He is the first Jayhawk with at least 20 points in six consecutive games since Dedric Lawson scored 20+ in six straight games (Nov. 21-Dec. 15,
- Wilson has now scored in double figures in 25 straight games, which is the third-longest active streak in the six major Division I conferences, behind Purdue's Zach Edev (39) and Indiana's Travce Jackson-Davis (32). The 25-game streak is the 12th longest by a Kansas player since the 1996-97 season.
- Wilson has scored 159 points over his last six games, which marks the most points by a Kansas player in a six-game stretch since the inception of the Big 12 in 1996-97. Wayne Simien held the previous high with 156 points.
- Wilson now sits in 36th on the Kansas all-time career scoring list with 1,247 points, passing Steve Woodberry (1,240).
- Redshirt senior Kevin McCullar Jr., pulled down 11 rebounds against Iowa State and now has double-figure rebounds in four straight games. He's the first Jayhawk with four straight games with double-digit rebounds since Jalen Wilson did it during the 2022 NCAA Tournament against Creighton, Providence, Miami (Fla.), and Villanova.
- Junior guard Joseph Yesufu finished with eight points against lowa State, marking his most points in a conference game since scoring nine against Kansas State last season on Feb. 22, 2022.
- Yesufu connected on multiple 3-pointers for the fifth time this season.
- Freshman Gradey Dick has connected on 21 straight free throw attempts. His last miss came on Jan. 17 at Kansas State.
