### THE WIN...

- Made Kansas 21-5 overall and 9-4 in Big 12 play
- Gave Kansas 21 wins for the 34th consecutive season, a streak which started in 1989-90 and is the longest active streak in NCAA Division I
- Was Kansas' fifth-straight win against Oklahoma State
- Made Kansas 6-3 in true road games this season and 9-4 in games not played in Allen Fieldhouse
- Made Bill Self 577-129 while at Kansas, 780-234 all-time and 27-14 vs. Oklahoma State, 26-11 while at KU
- Give Bill Self 21 wins for the 25th-straight season, including all 20 while at Kansas, and the 26th time in 30 years as a head
- Made Kansas 2,378-882 all-time.

#### **TEAM NOTES**

- Kansas dished out a season-best 26 assists, beating previous bests of 24 vs. Omaha (11/7) and at Missouri (12/10).
- The 26 assists are the most in a conference game since March 2, 2013 vs. West Virginia (29) and the most on the road in a conference game since having 26 assists on Feb. 11, 2002 at Texas (OT). It was also the most in a conference game on the road in regulation since Feb. 4, 2002 at Kansas State (26).
- The Jayhawks shot 53.8 percent (35-of-65) from the floor, shooting 65.5 percent (19-of-29) in the second half. The 53.8 shooting percentage gives the Jayhawks back-to-back road conference games shooting at least 50 percent.
- Kansas is 20-0 when leading at the half this season.
- KU swiped 11 steals from the Cowboys, marking the second-straight game Kansas has come away with 10 or more steals.

## **INDIVIDUAL NOTES**

- Freshman Gradev Dick scored a career-high 26 points shooting 58.8 percent (10-of-17) from the floor. Dick has made threeplus three pointers 10 times this season and has scored 20 or more points seven times this season, including twice in his last three games and four times in Big 12 conference play. With his 26 points, Dick now has 381 points this season and moves into 11th on the KU freshman all-time scoring list, passing Nick Collison (357), Jeff Boschee and Darell Arthur (361), J.R. Giddens (374) and Mario Chalmers (379).
- Redshirt senior Kevin McCullar Jr. finished with 15 points and a career-high 8 assists, also shooting a perfect 3-of-3 from the charity stripe.
- Sophomore KJ Adams Jr. scored 15 points (6-of-9) in only 20minutes in the contest. Adams has scored in double-figures 16 times this season.
- Redshirt junior Jalen Wilson finished the game with 14 points and four rebounds in 27 minutes.
- Junior guard Joseph Yesufu had a season-high three steals, which establishes a new Kansas career-high. He had four steals in a game once while at Drake. Yesufu had eight points and now has had at least eight points in three of his last four games after having just three such games in his first 21 contests of the season.
