### **THE RESULT...**

Makes the Jayhawks 14-7 on the year and 4-6 in Big 12 play.  
Is the third-straight loss against Texas.  
Drops the Jayhawks record to 10-2 at home on the season  
Makes KU 12-34 all-time against Texas and 7-14 versus the Longhorns in Lawrence.

### **TEAM NOTES**

Kansas shot 26-of-52 (50%) for the game, marking the fourth time this season and second time during Big 12 play that the Jayhawks have shot 50% or better from the field.  
The Jayhawks outrebounded 37-33 and KU is now 13-3 this season when outrebounding the opponent.

### **INDIVIDUAL NOTES**

Senior center Taiyanna Jackson scored 21 points with 13 rebounds in the game today for her 14th double-double of the season and 18th of her career. Jackson surpassed the 500-rebound milestone in the game and recorded her third game with 20+ points this season.

Playing in her 106th game in a Kansas uniform, senior guard Zakiyah Franklin made her 100th start as a Jayhawk. With 20 points, Franklin surpassed Angel Goodrich (1,262) and Sade Morris (1,276) to move into 18th place on KU's all-time scoring list. Franklin had her 5th 20-point game of the season and 12th of her career and currently has 1,277 points to her credit.

Senior guard Holly Kersgieter scored five points and secured six rebounds in today's game. She passes Lisa Braddy (1,387) for 14th place on KU's all-time scoring list and ties Erica Hallman (181) for fourth in career three-point field goals made.

Junior guard Wyvette Mayberry scored 12 points and dished out a season-high with 8 assists.
