FIRST PITCH

- Kansas plays rival Missouri at Kauffman Stadium, home of the Kansas City Royals on Wednesday night.
 - Kansas and Missouri have met at Kauffman Stadium four times in program history (2008-11). Kansas is 4-0 in those meetings.
 - The last time Kansas played in a Major League Baseball ballpark was at Kauffman Stadium on April 27, 2016 vs. Nebraska (L, 1-3).
 - Kansas is 10-6 all-time playing at MLB ballparks.
- Kansas is 17th in the nation and 1st in the Big 12 in fielding percentage (.981).
- OF **Chase Jans** has an active 14-game hitting streak and OF **Mike Koszewski** has reached base safely in 16 consecutive games.
 - Jans: .370/.444/.593 (20-for-54), 4 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 13 RBI, 10 R, 6 BB during 14-game streak
 - Koszewski: 13 hits, 6 2B, 7 RBI, 5 R, 9 BB during 16-game stretch
- The Kansas pitching staff has recorded four saves this season. All four saves have been multi-inning efforts.
 - LHP **Gavin Brasosky** - 4.0 IP vs. Valparaiso 2/17/23 & 4.0 IP vs. Oakland 2/25/23
 - RHP **Thaniel Trumper** - 4.0 IP vs. Oakland 2/24/23
 - LHP **Stone Hewlett** - 3.0 IP vs. Valparaiso 2/19/23
- Dan Fitzgerald** was named Head Coach on June 15, 2022, following the retirement of the all-time winningest coach in program history, Ritch Price.
 - Fitzgerald assembled the staff of:
 - Brandon Scott** - Asst. Coach/Pitching Coach
 - Tyler Hancock** - Asst. Coach/Hitting Coach
 - Jon Coyne** - Asst. Coach/Recruiting Coord.
- Fitzgerald and his staff announced the addition of 18 transfers on August 24, 2022.
 - Eleven transfers were from Division I institutions and seven were from junior colleges.
 - D1 Baseball ranked the transfer class No. 24 in the nation, while Baseball America ranked the class No. 25.
 - Seventeen of the 18 transfers are on the 2023 roster.

TEAM NOTES

IRELAND GOES CG

Junior pitcher Sam Ireland threw a complete game shutout on March 4 at Belmont in a 5-0 KU victory. Ireland, a transfer from Minnesota, was the first Jayhawk to throw a complete game shutout since the 2021 season. He struck out five batters and walked one, while only allowing four hits in his brilliant, 104-pitch, nine-inning gem.

As a pitching staff, Kansas has three shutouts, which is the most in the Big 12 and tied for 8th in the country.

SERIES WINS

Kansas won each of its first two series to start the season. The Jayhawks took two out of three from Valparaiso in Corpus Christi, Texas, and three out of four from Oakland in Cleburne, Texas.

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION

Kansas defeated Oakland 26-3 on Feb. 26. The victory came with several offensive notes that included:

- Most runs in a game since March 28, 1997 vs. Howard (26).
- Hit seven home runs, which tied the program record set on April 23, 1984 vs. Kansas State.
- A 12-run sixth inning, which were the most runs in an inning since scoring 16 runs in the 6th inning at Kansas State on May 22, 2004.
- A total of 13 extra-base hits, which were its most in a game since at least the 2003 season.
- The 22 hits were the most since March 23, 2016 vs. Baker (22) and the most against a Division I opponent since March 13, 2005 vs. North Dakota State (22).
- The 46 at-bats, which marked its most in a 9-inning game since April 30, 2010 at Oklahoma State (46).
- The 49 total bases by Kansas were its most in a game since March 5, 2004 vs. Wisconsin-Milwaukee (52).

ONE LAST RIDE

Senior C **Cole Elvis** and graduate RHP **Collin Baumgartner** each transferred to Kansas with one year of eligibility remaining. Elvis came from Cal and Baumgartner arrived from SIU-Edwardsville, where he worked with new Pitching Coach Brandon Scott.

Elvis served as Cal's primary catcher for the last three seasons and had his best year offensively in 2022. He set career highs in hits (59), RBI (41), runs scored (24) and walks (27), while having 21 extra-base hits, including 17 doubles, one triple and three home runs. Elvis was ranked the No. 28 MLB Draft prospect for 2023 in the Big 12 by Perfect Game and the No. 33 catcher for 2023 by D1 Baseball.

Baumgartner worked with Scott all five years he spent in the SIU-Edwardsville program. A Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference selection in 2021, Baumgartner is ranked as the No. 18 MLB Draft prospect for 2023 in the Big 12 by Perfect Game, No. 39 MLB Draft prospect for 2023 in the Big 12 by D1 Baseball and the No. 40 senior prospect by Perfect Game.

ROAD TRIPPIN'

Kansas will play 21 of its first 22 games away from Lawrence in 2023. This includes an 11-day, 8-game road trip from March 9-19. The Jayhawks will play in eight states this season (Kansas, Alabama, Missouri, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, West Virginia).

COME ON ALONG

In addition to Baumgartner, INF **Collier Cranford** and INF/OF **Luke Leto** each followed their coach to Kansas. Cranford and Leto are both transfers from LSU, the same school Head Coach Dan Fitzgerald spent the 2022 season as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator.

BUILDING FOR THE FUTURE

For the first time in program history, Kansas received the No. 1-ranked junior college recruiting class by Perfect Game. On Nov. 17, 2022, less than five months after Fitzgerald was hired, his staff announced a signing class of 13 players, including eight junior college prospects.

The junior college prospects that garnered the No. 1 ranking included Devin Bennett (McLennan Community College), Cayden Collins (Scottsdale Community College), Cooper Combs (Johnson County Community College), Ben Hartl (Heartland Community College), Evan Shaw (Cochise College), Patrick Steitz (Central Arizona College) and Izack Tiger (Butler Community College).

UP NEXT

COACHING STAFF



DAN FITZGERALD,

an elite recruiter, player developer, coach and ascending figure in college baseball, was named the Kansas Baseball Head Coach on June 15, 2022.

Fitzgerald arrived at Kansas following one year at LSU, where he served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator, helping lead the Tigers to a 40-win season and an NCAA Regional final appearance. His time in Baton Rouge was preceded by a successful nine-year tenure at Dallas Baptist as both an assistant coach, associate head coach and recruiting coordinator.

At DBU, Fitzgerald had a major hand in bringing unprecedented success to the Patriots program. In his nine seasons with the program, Dallas Baptist played in seven NCAA Regionals, won three regular-season conference championships and won three conference tournaments.

Fitzgerald came to Lawrence with a sterling reputation in player development and recruiting, along with deep Midwestern ties, having served as a head coach at Des Moines Area Community College for five seasons and spending five seasons as an assistant in the region.

During his nine seasons at Dallas Baptist (2012-21), Fitzgerald played a major role in the Patriots developing and recruiting some of the top talent in the country. He helped recruit and develop 38 Major League Baseball Draft picks, 13 of those being Top-10 picks, nine All-Americans, eight freshman All-Americans, 78 all-conference selections and two conference players of the year.

Dallas Baptist tallied 270 victories from 2015-21, which was the fifth-most by a Division I baseball program during that span. The Patriots, known best for their explosive offense, ranked in the top 25 nationally in home runs in each season during Fitzgerald's time at Dallas Baptist. The team held a top 25 ranking in a total of 51 offensive categories across his nine seasons.

With the Patriots proving to be one of the top programs nationally, Fitzgerald was promoted from assistant coach to associate head coach in June 2016. Dallas Baptist posted a 341-168 (.670) record during his tenure with six seasons of at least 40 wins. Fitzgerald helped land some of the top prep players nationally, by

being able to recruit throughout the country, thanks to his trusted relationships and proven track record, which he now brings to Kansas.

Fitzgerald has earned respect among his peers. In a survey of 90 head coaches conducted by Baseball America in 2020, Fitzgerald was rated No. 7 on a list of assistant coaches from across the nation that will one day make the best head coach. Baseball America also rated Fitzgerald as the No. 7 assistant coach in the nation in 2018, while D1Baseball ranked him as the 17th-best recruiter in the country in 2016.

Prior to his time at LSU and Dallas Baptist, Fitzgerald was the head coach at Des Moines Area Community College (2008-12). In his five years at DMACC, Fitzgerald was awarded Coach of the Year honors by 13 different publications. His team's won five consecutive conference championships and advanced to the Junior College World Series on four separate occasions.

Fitzgerald also had 36 players sign with Division I programs, nine student-athletes be named Junior College All-Americans, including the 2009 National Player of the Year. His program finished with at least 40 wins in every season and compiled a 249-73 (.773) record over the five-year stretch.

Fitzgerald's coaching career began in 2000 at Iowa as a volunteer assistant coach. He then interned with the Minnesota Twins scouting department (2002) before returning to coaching as an assistant at North Iowa Area Community College (2003-04), Flagler College (2005-06) and Des Moines Area Community College (2007-08).

In addition to coaching at schools, Fitzgerald has spent time as a head coach in top summer leagues around the country. That includes a stint in 2004 as the Field Manager for Athletes in Action in Alaska, the sport ministry of Campus Crusade for Christ.

A native of Edina, Minnesota, Fitzgerald attended and played baseball at the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, Minnesota, and the University of Wisconsin-River Falls before graduating with a degree in English from the University of Minnesota in 2000. Most recently, he earned a Masters of Education in Kinesiology from Dallas Baptist in 2016. Fitzgerald and his wife, Kelly, have three sons – Will, Max and Ben.

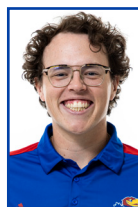

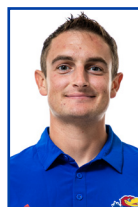
