THE RESULT...

Improves the Jayhawks to 18-10 overall and 8-9 in Big 12 conference play.
Snaps a 16-game winless streak against Iowa State.
Becomes KU's first victory over Iowa State since March 2, 2015 (68-64).
Is KU's first win over a ranked opponent at home since Feb. 21, 2018 (vs. #23 Oklahoma State; W, 66-59)
Increases the Jayhawk's win streak to two games.
Becomes Coach Brandon's 100th career win as the head coach of the Jayhawks.
Makes the Jayhawks 48-48 versus Iowa State all-time and 28-16 in Lawrence.

TEAM NOTES

Kansas has secured an overall record of 18-10 (8-9 in Big 12 play) with a final home record of 13-3 for the 2022-23 regular season. Brandon Schneider's picks up his 100th win as coach of the Jayhawks and the 501st win of his collegiate coaching career.

The Jayhawks hit 34-of-66 (51.5%) field goal attempts and hit a season-high 11 three-point field goals in the game. This is Kansas sixth time this season where they have shot 50% or better from the field.

Kansas scored a season-high of 98 points, which tops the previous high of 88 points vs. SEMO.

This is the fifth time that two Jayhawks have scored 20+ points this season, with Zakiyah Franklin setting a new career-high with 31 points, while Wyvette Mayberry had 22. Kansas is 5-0 in games with two players scoring 20+ points.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Senior guard Zakiyah Franklin moved into 15th place on KU's all-time scoring list with 1,417 points. She put up a career-high 31 points and added three assists. This is the eighth time this season and 15th time in her career that Franklin has scored 20+ points and her second game of 30+ points. Franklin has scored in double-figures for the 13th consecutive game, 24 times this season and the 69th of her career.

Junior guard Wyvette Mayberry scored 22 points with six assists. This caps off her fourth 20-point game of the season and the 11th in her career. Mayberry hit 4-of-7 three-point field goals, which ties her season-high for three-point field goals made in a game. This is Mayberry's sixth game this season where she has hit multiple three-point field goals.

Freshman Zsafia Telegdy set a new career-high with 10 points while hitting two three-pointers in 13 minutes of action.
