SCENE SETTER: Wichita State makes the short trip north to Lawrence on Wednesday for the first road midweek game of the season against in-state foe Kansas. Wednesday's game is the 2023 home opener for Kansas. The Shockers are coming off a heartbreaking 6-5 loss at home against Oral Roberts on Tuesday; WSU trailed 5-0 into the bottom of the sixth but rallied, scoring twice in the bottom of the ninth and loading the bases with one out before ORU escaped with the victory. Wichita State enters play on Wednesday with a 6-5 record despite a run differential of +33. Midweek contests represent an opportunity for significant improvement after Wichita State went just 3-10 in Tuesday/Wednesday games in 2022. WSU aims to rebound from a 21-36 season a year ago, the second-most losses in program history. Interim head coach Loren Hibbs was appointed to lead the Shockers in December following the departure of Eric Wedge, who compiled a 65-61 record in three seasons at the helm. Wichita State is hunting their first appearance in the NCAA tournament since the 2013 season, a regional bid that was later vacated by the NCAA.

SHOCKER BASEBALL ON THE RADIO AND ESPN PLUS: KFH 97.5 FM/1240 AM will once again serve as the radio home for Wichita State baseball broadcasts in 2023. Former Shocker pitcher (1991-94) and Pizza Hut Shocker Sports Hall of Famer Shane Dennis will have the call of the action on Wednesday alongside Denning Gerig. Wednesday's game will also be streamed live on ESPN+ (\$) ; Steven Davis (play-by-play) and Kevin Wheeler (analyst) will have the call. Live audio, in addition to live statistics, will be available for all games at GoShockers.com/listen and ShockerStats.com.

SERIES HISTORY: The Shockers and Jayhawks have met 85 times, with Wichita State holding 51-34 lead in the all-time series. Kansas snapped WSU's six-game series winning streak last season with a 14-2 victory in Lawrence after Garrett Kocis launched a walk-off, two-run home run in the bottom of the tenth inning for a 7-5 WSU victory earlier in year. Lawrence was the site of one of the longest games in program history, a 16-inning affair on April 10, 2012 that lasted nearly four and a half hours. Wichita State was down to their final out in the ninth when Kansas centerfielder Dakota Smith lost a ball in the lights, allowing the tying run to score. Lawrence native Aaron Rea came off the bench to drive in the winning run with an RBI double in the top of the 16th, and another Lawrence native, Albert Minnis, closed out the win with four scoreless innings in relief. From 2013-2016, Kansas won seven consecutive games in the series.

SCOUTING KANSAS: Kansas enters play on Wednesday with a record of 6-4 following a series loss on the road at Belmont. The Jayhawks have not played a midweek game yet this season, taking two of three against Valparaiso in Corpus Christi and three of four from common opponent Oakland in Cleburne, Texas. Kansas boasts a roster loaded with Division I transfers, including expected starter Ethan Bradford, who pitched three seasons at Nebraska before coming to Lawrence. Impact transfers Luke Leto (LSU), Sam Ireland (Minnesota), Cole Elvis (Cal) and Collin Baumgartner (SIU Edwardsville) have all made immediate contributions in their first season with the program. Outfielder Janson Reeder was a member of the Shocker program in the fall of 2022 before transferring back to Cowley College. The Jayhawks boast a stellar defensive unit that has committed only four errors all season, good for a .989 fielding percentage that ranks top-10 nationally. Head coach Dan Fitzgerald is in his first season with the Jayhawks after one season as the recruiting coordinator at LSU. The Shockers are familiar with Fitzgerald, who previously spent nine seasons in the same capacity at Dallas Baptist, former Missouri Valley Conference foes. Former Wichita State volunteer assistant coach Jon Coyne is a member of Fitzgerald's staff.

CHARITY DECLINED: Wichita State drew a season-high seven walks and were hit twice on Tuesday against Oral Roberts. Combined with an ORU error, WSU received 10 baserunners from the Golden Eagles, but were only able to turn two of those free passes into runs.

IT'S BEEN AWHILE: It took 46 plate appearances before Wichita State slugger **Garrett Pennington** earned his first walk of the season on Tuesday, a free pass that was aided by a pitch clock violation on Oral Roberts starter Joshua Carvalho. It was the first such violation in a Wichita State game this season. With just four strikeouts, Pennington has now put the ball in play in 47 of his 53 plate appearance thus far (89%).

BOMBS AWAY: Dating back to Wichita State's road series at Utah Tech, the Shockers have homered in seven consecutive games, totaling 15 home runs during that stretch. WSU has not homered in eight straight since March 18-30, 2018.

THREE TRUE OUTCOMES: WSU outfielder **Seth Stroh** had an interesting homestand statistically. In 19 plate appearances, the junior drew six walks, struck out five times, and three extra-base hits (two home runs). Only 4/19 trips to the plate produced a single or a putout on a ball in play.

BIG WEEK FOR THE BIG MAN: Wichita State sophomore sensation **Payton Tolle** had an impressive weekend series against Oakland, highlighted by one of the best individual performances in school history on Saturday. Starting on the mound and batting cleanup, Tolle fired six innings of two-hit ball with a career-high 10 strikeouts, allowing only a single unearned run. At the plate, the 6'6" slugger went 5-for-5 with a double, a home run, and six RBI as Wichita State rolled to a 17-5 victory. For the series, Tolle finished 9-for-14 with two home runs and nine runs batted in, earning AAC Player of the Week honors.

RED (HOT) HERRING: After a slow start on the season-opening road trip, Wichita State infielder **David Herring** looked right at home in his Eck Stadium debut. The Cowley College transfer blistered opposing pitching for nine hits in 19 at-bats, including three doubles and his first home run as a Shocker. Herring entered the weekend with two RBI through his first six games, then drove in nine runs over the next four.

DOUBLE VISION: In the third inning of Sunday's game against Oakland, the Shockers strung together four consecutive doubles (**David Herring**, **Kyte McDonald**, **Brock Rodden**, **Sawyre Thornhill**) the first time the Shockers have hit four straight two-baggers in a game since the 2018 season against Kansas. Wichita State finished the 16-2 win with six doubles, two shy of the program record set in the same game against the Jayhawks. WSU entered play on Tuesday 21st nationally with 2.70 doubles per game, led individually by **Mauricio Millan** with five.

BACK IN THE SADDLE: Interim head coach **Loren Hibbs** is in his first season leading the Shockers after taking over for Eric Wedge in December of 2022. Hibbs starred as a record-setting outfielder for the Shockers, helping WSU to the program's first-ever CWS appearance in 1982, and still holds the NCAA record for single-season runs scored with 125. He then served as an assistant under legendary Shocker head coach Gene Stephenson before moving on to Charlotte, where Hibbs guided the 49ers for 27 seasons and more than 800 wins. He returned to the Wichita State program following the 2019 season, joining the staff as Director of Baseball Operations.

HIGH PRAISE: The Shockers landed four players on the American Athletic Conference preseason all-conference team, most of any club in the league. Infielder **Brock Rodden**, outfielder **Chuck Ingram**, designated hitter **Payton Tolle** and right-handed pitcher **Cameron Bye** were all selected, with Rodden tabbed as the conference's Preseason Player of the Year. Despite the league-best four honorees, Wichita State was picked fifth in the eight-team American Athletic Conference preseason poll.

RODDEN RETURN: Infielder **Brock Rodden** burst on to the scene as one of college baseball's most impactful players in 2022. The Seminole State transfer led the Shockers in batting average (.338), on-base percentage (.441) and slugging percentage (.653) while launching 17 home runs, the most by a Shocker since Drew Moffitt hit 26 long balls in 2004. He was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 10th Round of the 2022 MLB Draft (pick 304 overall) but elected not to sign, one of just three players chosen in the top ten rounds to do so.

JUCO INFLUX: The Wichita State 2023 roster features eight junior college transfers, several of which have stepped in as immediate contributors. Former Mississippi State outfielder **Kyte McDonald** brings elite speed out in centerfield, and former St. Mary's righty **Clark Candiotti** has entrenched himself at the front of the weekend rotation. Two members of Cowley College's NJCAA runner-up team play major roles, as infielder **David Herring** is the everyday starter at shortstop and right-handed pitcher **Grant Adler** has grabbed the Sunday starter role. Righties **Matt Wilkinson**, **Colton Vercoe** and **Carter Rost** were added to solidify the bullpen, and catcher **Mauricio Millan** is off to a strong start offensively while catching 10 of the first 11 games.

CUTTING DOWN ON THE K'S: If Wichita State is to take a major step forward offensively in 2023, a key metric to monitor will be the Shockers contact rate. WSU struck out 514 times last season, the most in a single campaign in program history. 10 different Shockers fanned more than 30 times. Through 11 games, Wichita State is averaging 7.6 strikeouts per contest, down from 9.0 a year ago.

**Interim Head Coach
First Season**

Former Wichita State standout outfielder and assistant coach Loren Hibbs was named Interim Head Coach in December of 2022.

Hibbs, who starred as a player for the Shockers from 1982-84 and then served as assistant coach at WSU from 1985-92, returned to his alma mater in June of 2019 as Director of Baseball Operations. He was previously the head coach at Charlotte for 27 seasons (1993-2019).

At Charlotte, Hibbs posted an impressive 819-682-5 record and guided the 49ers to seven conference regular season championships, four conference tournament titles and five NCAA tournament appearances. He is the program's all-time winningest coach, having achieved that milestone back in 2002.

Before becoming the head coach for the 49ers, Hibbs assisted College Baseball and Pizza Hut Shockers Sports Hall of Fame head coach Gene Stephenson to seven Missouri Valley Conference regular season titles, five MVC tournament crowns, seven NCAA regional appearances, four College World Series berths and the 1989 national championship.

He coached six former Shockers who went on to play in the majors, including Wedge (1987-89), P.J. Forbes (1987-90), Mike Lansing (1987-90), Pat Meares (1988-90), Darren Dreifort (1991-93) and Doug Mirabelli (1990-92).

An outfielder for the Shockers from 1982-84, he was a three-time All-Missouri Valley Conference and All-District honoree, and was selected to the 1982 College World Series all-tournament team. He still holds the NCAA single-season record for runs scored with 125 during the 1982 campaign.

Hibbs captured two regular season conference titles and one conference tournament crown, going along with two NCAA regional showings, and was a member of the 1982 College World Series runner-up team.

He was inducted into the Kansas Baseball Hall of Fame in 2018.

Hibbs and his wife, the former Lisa Helms, have three children, Tyson, Erin and Lanie.

Pitching Coach Fifth Season

Former Wichita State All-American and 12-year major leaguer Mike Pelfrey was named the program's pitching coach in January of 2019.

Pelfrey, who is a member of the Pizza Hut Shocker Sports Hall of Fame and was an All-American for Wichita State, joined the Shockers after spending the previous two seasons as the pitching coach for the Newman University Jets.

During his career with WSU from 2003-05, Pelfrey went an impressive 33-7 on the mound and compiled a 2.18 ERA, which still ranks second in program history. He also finished second in career strikeouts with 366.

In 2005, he was named a first team All-American by Collegiate Baseball, American Baseball Coaches Association and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association after going 12-3 with a 1.93 ERA and 143 strikeouts.

A three-time first-team All-MVC honoree, he was also the Valley's 2004 and 2005 Pitcher of the Year after 2003 Freshman of the Year honors. He was also a three-time ABCA all-region selection and was named to the Valley's 2007 All-Centennial team.

Pelfrey was drafted ninth overall by the New York Mets during the first round of the 2005 MLB Draft, and went on to pitch in the majors for 12 years with the Mets (seven seasons), Minnesota Twins (three seasons), Detroit Tigers (one season) and Chicago White Sox (one season). In total, he appeared in 275 major league contests.

From 2008-11 with New York, he started at least 31 games each season, totaling 45 wins, 435 strikeouts and just 263 walks in 782 2/3 innings.

Pelfrey earned a bachelor's degree in sport management from Wichita State in May 2019.

He and his wife, Angela, have a son, Chase, and two daughters, Avery and Madison.

Assistant Coach/ Recruiting Coordinator Fourth Season

Mike Sirianni was named the Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator for the Wichita State baseball program on June 27, 2019.

Sirianni was the volunteer assistant coach for the Shockers from 2015-16 and comes back to Wichita State after head coaching stints at Tarleton State and Regis University.

While at Regis, a Division II school in Denver, Colo., Sirianni made an immediate impact. He took over the reins of a program that was 21 games under .500 over the previous three seasons combined (60-81) and led the Rangers to 26 victories in his debut season in 2017. Over the next two seasons, Sirianni added 47 more victories to his ledger. In 2018, the Rangers recorded their first winning season in five years with Sirianni at the helm.

In 2018, Sirianni coached the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Year Brad Thoutt. He also had 20 all-conference selections in his three seasons with the Rangers and boasted the highest team GPA in the RMAC in 2017.

Prior to his time at Regis, Sirianni spent two seasons as a volunteer assistant coach for the Shockers where he assisted with the offense and helped coach three Freshman All-Americans, two all-region selections, one Missouri Valley Conference Freshman of the Year, eight all-conference performers and nine MLB draft picks.

From 2011-14, Sirianni was the assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Newman University. He helped lead the Jets to the conference tournament two out of the three seasons and to the highest conference finish in school history. He also helped guide the offense to several school records and the team to the best finish in school history.

Sirianni recruited and coached six Gold Glove winners and 14 all-conference position players. He also recruited and coached the Freshman of the Year in the Heartland Conference.

During the summer in 2009, 2010 and 2011, he was the Head Coach for the Jonesboro Ricemen, an American Legion team. He led the team to the Arkansas State Legion Championship in 2009. During his time with the Ricemen, he led the team to four conference championships and guided 19 players to go on to play college baseball.

Prior to coaching at Newman, he had stints with Valley View High School in Arkansas, Iowa Western Community College, Arkansas State and the Cleveland Indians.

Sirianni, who is a native of Indianola, Iowa, earned a bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies from Arkansas State in 2006. In 2017, he earned a master's degree in health, physical education and recreation from Emporia State.

He was a two-year starter at Arkansas State in 2004-05 and set the single season record for runs scored in 2004. He also played two years at Creighton from 2002-03.

Volunteer Assistant Coach Second Season

Conor Behrens enters his second season as a volunteer assistant coach for the Shockers in 2023.

Behrens (pronounced BEAR-enns) comes to Wichita from Point Loma Nazarene University, where he served as the infield and hitting coach for the Sea Lions. Prior to his time in San Diego, the native of Lincoln, Neb., spent two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Central Missouri, helping the Mules to a national runner-up finish and a 46-8 record in 2021.

Working primarily with the hitters at UCM, Behrens helped engineer an offense that ranked top-10 nationally in a litany of offensive categories, including batting average (.341), hits [620], home runs, [86], runs [478], slugging percentage [.579], stolen bases [91] and hit by pitch [109].

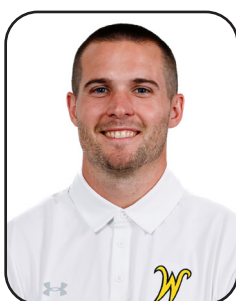
Over Behrens's two seasons in Warrensburg, the Mules went 66-11 (.857), producing seven all-conference players, five all-region hitters, and three All-Americans. UCM was off to a 20-3 start in 2020 before the remainder of the season was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Behrens played collegiately at Kansas City Kansas Community College and Lindenwood University, where he hit a combined .304 over two seasons. As a junior in 2017, he helped the Lions to their first-ever appearance in the Division-II World Series.

Behrens began his coaching career the following year as an assistant for his alma mater, Lincoln Southwest High School, where he was an all-state performer as a player.
