## CONFERENCE NOTES

- No. 14 Texas and No. 16 Texas Tech are in this week's DI Baseball Top 25. In addition, Oklahoma State, Texas Tech and West Virginia are ranked in at least one poll.
- Seven Big 12 teams rank in the top 100 of the April 17 NCAA RPI report. Texas, West Virginia, Oklahoma State and TCU rank inside the top-50.
- All nine Big 12 programs rank in the nation's top 75 for average attendance. The Big 12 and the SEC are the only leagues averaging at least 3,000 fans per game.
- Kansas and K-State combined for 39 runs on April 16, the most combined runs in a Big 12 game since a 43-run game in 2008. The Wildcats won, 21-18.
- West Virginia faces Pitt Tuesday at PNC Park, home of MLB's Pittsburgh Pirates. The Mountaineers are the seventh Big 12 team to play a game at a Major League park this season.
- After home teams started Big 12 play by winning 13 of 15 series, all four road teams won their series the weekend of April 14-16. Home teams have now won 13 of 19 series.
- TTU swept the Big 12's weekly awards as Gavin Kash (.450, 3 HR, 10 RBI, 1.470 OPS) was Player of the Week, Ryan Free (1-0, 6.2 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 11 K) was named Pitcher of the Week and Gage Harrelson (.480, 4 XBH, 5 R, 7 RBI, 1.220 OPS) was Newcomer of the Week.
- Baylor's Kolby Branch hit a go-ahead eighth-inning single as the Bears defeated Sam Houston 7-6. Hunter Teplanszky, who had a walk-off single against Texas on April 15, scored the winning run.
- Kansas' Chase Jans drove in nine runs in the April 16 game against Kansas State. It matches the KU single-game program record for RBIs and is the most for a Big 12 player this season.
- Kansas State's Kyan Lodice and Kaelen Culpepper each had 6 RBIs in the Wildcats' 21-18 win over Kansas (Apr. 16). K-State used a 13-run second inning to open up its lead.
- Oklahoma's Braden Carmichael tossed 7.1 innings, allowing just 1 earned run and striking out five to pick up the win on April 16 against Texas Tech.
- Oklahoma State's Juaron Watts-Brown is tied for second in Division I with 83 strikeouts this season, trailing only LSU's Paul Skenes. He ranks third among active pitchers with 14.1 strikeouts per nine innings in his career.
- TCU had a nine-run sixth inning against UNC Wilmington (Apr. 15), the most runs for the Horned Frogs in an inning since 2019.
- Texas' Lucas Gordon ranks fifth among Power 5 starters with a 1.92 earned run average. He is holding opponents to a .182 average.
- Texas Tech's Gavin Kash ranks second nationally with 68 RBIs and 19 home runs. In his last five games, Kash is 11-for-20 (.550) with 6 HR and 16 RBIs.
- West Virginia's JJ Wetherholt currently holds a .451 batting average, which would slot in second on the Big 12's single-season list. No Big 12 player has hit higher than .416 since 2001.
